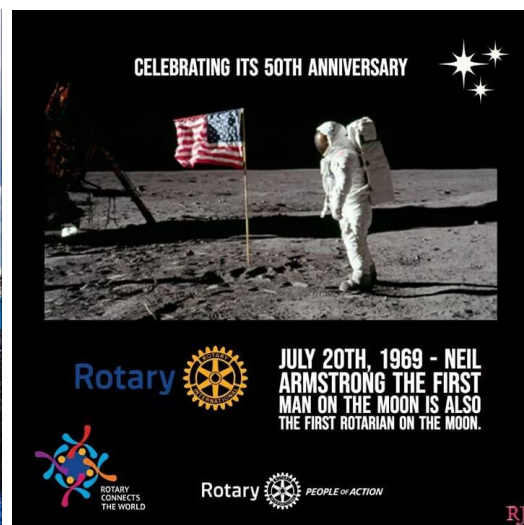

Neil Alden Armstrong was born August 5, 1930 on his grandparent's farm in Wapakoneta, Ohio. He took flying lessons in an Aeronca Champion and received his pilot license on his 16th birthday, before he had his driver's license. Rotarians from neighboring Rotary Clubs in Ohio: Wapakoneta and Lima, St. Marys, New Bremen New Knoxville, Bucyrus, Ada, and Sandusky were marching in the Neil Armstrong 50th Anniversary of the 1st Man on the Moon Parade. The Rotary float showed off the District 6600 collection of UN Flags.
