

Blood donations are in great demand and as Rotarians, we want to show our support by rolling up our sleeves and getting the job done. We want to fill every one of the 32 available slots! We need two volunteers per shift to volunteer the day of the event taking temperatures and checking in blood donors. Shifts are 10:30-12:30; 12:30-2:30; 2:30-4:30; 4:30-6.

The need for blood is constant and only volunteer donors can fulfill that need for patients in our community. Nationwide, someone needs a unit of blood every 2 to 3 seconds and most of us will need blood in our lifetime.
