

Our Rotary Club and the American Red Cross hosted a blood drive from 11:30 am to 5:30 pm at Spare Time Bowling, 16317 Statesville Road, Huntersville.

Blood donations are in great demand and as Rotarians, we showed our support by rolling up our sleeves and getting the job done. **We filled every one of the 32 slots!** We had two volunteers per shift to volunteer by taking temperatures and checking in blood donors. **We collected 23 bags of whole blood for the ARC today.**

The need for blood is constant and only volunteer donors can fulfill that need for patients in our community. Nationwide, someone needs a unit of blood every 2 to 3 seconds and most of us will need blood in our lifetime. (Bonus to donating now is the ARC runs an antibody test on your blood donation and will let you know if you have developed antibodies to Covid-19.)


