

Promising Pages is a non-profit organization that collects new and donated books and shares them with children living in the Charlotte Area Book Desert: those with few, if any, books at home.






#### Last week's program – Bob Wilson

#### **Community Service - Catawba Riversweep**

**Saturday October 3**, 8 members of our club participated in a one day clean up event. They joined more than a thousand volunteers spread out over the entire Catawba River. Tailrace Marina supplied the kayaks, the bags and the dumpster. Afterwards a cookout was enjoyed by many. #### **Community Service - Hinds Feet Farm**

Hinds Feet Farm is a resident (and day patient) facility that treats patients with traumatic brain injuries.

Our club installed pavers around the gardens and provided an even walking surface for the patients as they are having therapy-based walks and outside time. Rotary themed benches will also be installed to allow for rest areas and areas of repose for the patients, staff, and volunteers. Huntersville Happy Hour Rotary club will raise \$4,000 of the approximately \$8,000 in total cost. The other \$4,000 comes from a matching district grant.
