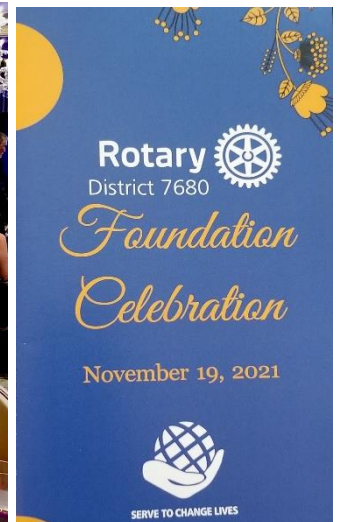
PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

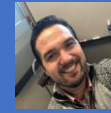
Saturday October 23 & November 20 - Community Service - Dellwood Center
