Welcome to the first ever edition of the Caversham Kitties Mewsletter!


Every month, you will receive an update on our local kitty pals, look ahead to what's coming up soon, as well as a few other bits and pieces!

Dalton has been with us for six weeks now, and we couldn't imagine our home without him!




Welcome to the Club

This month we welcomed two new members to the Caversham Kitties Club! Say a big hello to Orla and Millie, we hope we get to see them both again very soon.



Coming up soon

In case you hadn't noticed, autumn is well and truly here! We've already seen a lot of wet weather over Caversham, which puts a lot of cats off from going outside. We definitely recommend you keep a stocked litter tray on standby for your kitties (ideally one per cat, plus one!) for those days when they'd rather stay indoors!


October is of course the month of Halloween, and while we all love our black kitties, they can be a target at this time of year. Maybe consider keeping your monochrome moggies indoors at night towards the end of the month.

Bonfire night may typically be in November, but we know that fireworks aren't limited to the 5th! Fireworks can be very scary for our feline friends, so again you may want to consider keeping them inside during this time. Here are our top tips for keeping your kitty safe and happy during fireworks season:

- Keep cats indoors during the hours of darkness
- Close your curtains and put the lights on
- Put on the TV or some calming music to drown out the bangs. Classic FM always play a programme of relaxing music especially for pets during fireworks season!

- Provide some hiding spots for your cat in case they do get scared: drape a blanket over a chair, or pop one of their beds underneath a table so they feel secure
- Try a pheromone plugin or spray which could help your cat remain calm
- Don't fuss them! Try to act as normally as possible to keep your cat as relaxed as possible




Daisy


Cleo
