SDMS-Approved CME Activity

The Society of Diagnostic Medical Sonography (SDMS) designates this activity for a maximum of **44.25** CME credits.

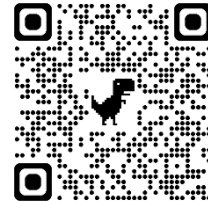
In order to receive the proper CME credits, please follow the following steps:

Step1: Complete the courses in each session.

Step2: Click the link for the SDMS CME Evaluation in each session and submit. You will also need to complete the SDMS CME Quiz if you attend that session at the Enduring Conference.

***In order to receive the proper CME credits, you must complete the session courses before you can submit the SDMS CME Evaluation (and the SDMS CME Quiz if applicable). Any Session you attend at the Live Conference (In-Person or Virtually), you must complete the Session Evaluation within 2 weeks (by 06/17/2024).**

▪ **I am a sonographer, how many CME credits I can claim per different registration types?**

	Sonographers (Non physician) - Feta ECHO Course ONLY (Two Full Days)	Sonographer - All Three days	Sonographers - Fetal ECHO & Ultrasound - 4 days (3+1)
CME accredited by the SDMS	Up to 18 credits	Up to 30.5 credits	Up to 44.25 credits

- **I am not able to attend the entire Live Conference, can I attend the Enduring Conference and continue with the educational courses to achieve the maximum CME credits I registered for?**
Yes. Your CME credits include the participation record both in the live conference and in the enduring conference.

- **Do I need to write down the courses I attend to claim the CMEs?**
No. If you attend the conference in-person, you need to check in and check out daily. If you join virtually, our conference platform automatically tracks your participation and keeps a record.

- **What is considered as ‘completion’ of a lecture?**
When the participation time of a lecture achieves 90% and above, the lecture is considered completed.

- **Can I claim the CME credits for sessions which were registered for free?**
CME credits will NOT be granted to attendees who register for free. If you wish to claim the CME credits, you will have to register and pay for the registration fee.
