Guidelines for Sonographers (Non-Physicians) to Claim CME Credit

SDMS-Approved CME Activity

*The Society of Diagnostic Medical Sonography (SDMS) designates this activity for a maximum of **38.75** CME credits.*

Instructions to Claim SDMS CME Credits

To receive the appropriate CME credits, please follow the steps below:

Step1: Participate in all the sessions you intend to claim the sonographer's CME credits for.

Note: *If you are attending the **Live Conference in person**, you must **check in and check out each day** to receive proper contact hour credit.*

Step2: Complete the Required SDMS CME Evaluations and Quizzes

--Live Conference attendees:

Complete the **SDMS CME Evaluations** for the sessions you attended.

** For any session you attend at the Live Conference—whether in person or virtually—you must complete the corresponding session evaluation within two weeks (by June 20, 2025).*

--Enduring Conference attendees:

Complete **both the SDMS CME Evaluations and the CME Quizzes** for the sessions you watched.

Note: *To receive CME credit, you must complete the session content before submitting the SDMS CME Evaluation (and the SDMS CME Quiz, if applicable).*

Step3: Submit the [2025 SDMS CME Report Request Form](#).

Note: *Include your SDMS Member Number or relevant registry number (ARDMS, CCI, Sonography Canada, or ARRT).*

Step4: Your credits will be reported to SDMS after review. Certificates will be available at the SDMS portal: <https://www.sdms.org/>

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

- **Q: I am a sonographer and also interested in the non-SDMS accredited courses provided by the conference. Can I join those sessions?**

A: Yes. You can join any courses provided by the conference. However, only the courses accredited by the SDMS will provide the CME credits for the sonographers.

- **Q: What is the difference between the Live Conference and the Enduring Conference?**

- **Q: Can I attend both live and enduring sessions to maximize my CME credits?**

A: Yes. Your CME record will reflect participation in both the live and enduring components.

- **Q: Do I need to record or list which sessions I attended?**

A: No. Attendance is automatically tracked by our platform or by check-in/check-out onsite.

- **Q: What qualifies as a “completed” session?**

A: A session is considered completed if you view at least 90% of its total duration.

- **Q: Can I earn CME credits for sessions that were free?**

A: No. CME credits are not granted for sessions with free registration unless the registration fee is paid.
