## Guidelines for Sonographers (Non-Physicians) to Claim CME Credit

**SDMS-Approved CME Activity**

*The Society of Diagnostic Medical Sonography (SDMS) designates this activity for a maximum of **56** CME credits.*

# Instructions to Claim SDMS CME Credits

To receive the appropriate CME credits, please follow the steps below:

## **Step1: Participate in Eligible Sessions**

Attend all sessions for which you intend to claim sonographer CME credits.

### **In-Person Attendees:**

If you are attending the Live Conference in person, you must **check in and check out each day** to receive the appropriate contact hour credit.

### **Virtual Attendees:**

If you are attending virtually, your participation will be recorded automatically. However, we strongly recommend keeping a personal list of the sessions you attended for your records.

## **Step2: Complete the Required SDMS CME Evaluations and Quizzes**

### **Live Conference attendees:**

Complete the **SDMS CME Evaluations** for the sessions you attended.

**Note: For any session attended during the Live Conference—whether in person or virtually—the corresponding session evaluation must be completed within two weeks of the conference (by June 20, 2026) in order to receive CME credit for the live event.**

### **Enduring Conference attendees:**

Complete **both the SDMS CME Evaluations and the CME Quizzes** for the sessions you watched.

*Note: To receive CME credit, you must complete the full session content before submitting the SDMS CME Evaluation and CME Quiz (if applicable).*

## **Step3: Submit the 2026 SDMS CME Reporting Form**

Please include your **SDMS Member Number** or applicable registry number (**ARDMS, CCI, Sonography Canada, or ARRT**) when submitting the form.

## Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

- **Q: I am a sonographer and am also interested in the non-SDMS-accredited courses offered by the conference. May I attend those sessions?**

A: Yes. You are welcome to attend any sessions offered during the conference. However, only sessions accredited by the SDMS are eligible for CME credits for sonographers.

- **Q: What is the difference between the Live Virtual Conference and the Enduring Conference?**

- **Q: Can I attend both live and enduring sessions to maximize my CME credits?**

A: Yes. You may participate in both the live and enduring components, and your CME record will reflect credits earned from each.

- **Q: Do I need to record or list which sessions I attended?**

A: No. Attendance is automatically tracked by our platform or through onsite check-in/check-out. However, we recommend keeping a personal record of the sessions you attend for your reference.

- **Q: What qualifies as a “completed” session?**

A: A session is considered completed when at least 90% of its total duration has been viewed.

- **Q: Can I earn CME credits for sessions that were free?**

A: No. CME credits are not granted for sessions accessed through free registration unless the applicable registration fee has been paid.
