

Instructions for Obtaining CE Credit: 15th Annual Philadelphia Prenatal Diagnosis Conference

Continuing Medical Education Credits

For Physicians

The **15th Annual Philadelphia Prenatal Diagnosis Conference** will be accredited for CME credit by The George Washington University Office of Continuing Education in the Health Professions. CME Certificates will be provided to registered attendees based upon verification of attendance via SMS text message and the completion of the online session evaluation.

How does this work?

- A unique session code will be announced daily before the lunch break and at the conclusion of the last session of the day.
- You will text the unique code to (202) 902-9966 and receive a text message reply confirming your attendance has been recorded.
 Recommendation: Save the number (202) 902-9966 in your cell phone contacts list so that you can easily identify the number for texting each day.

To Obtain Continuing Education Credit Via SMS Text Message

Please note: To claim CE credit for participating, you must have an EthosCE learner account with a registered mobile number. We strongly recommend that you update your account and register your mobile number before attending the conference.

If you would like to receive CE credit for attending, please follow the instructions below to create/update your EthosCE learner account and register your mobile number:

1: Create an EthosCE Learner Account

- Visit https://cme.smhs.gwu.edu
- Click "Register" in the upper right-hand corner of the screen.
- Complete all required profile fields (marked with a red asterisk).
- Click "Create New Account" when complete.

2: Register Your Mobile Number

- Click the <u>"Mobile"</u> tab.
- Enter your 10-digit mobile phone number (excluding any dashes, parentheses, or spaces) Do not exit this page!
- A confirmation code will be sent to your mobile phone.
- Enter the Confirmation Code.
- Click "Confirm Number" and click the "Save" button.

3: Record Your Attendance via SMS Text Messaging

- Open the text messaging app on your mobile phone.
- Text the code to (202) 902-9966.



After texting the code, you will receive a confirmation text indicating that your attendance has been recorded.

4: Complete the Activity Evaluation

Important: After texting the codes, you have 30 days to access the evaluation and claim CE credit.

- Upon recording your attendance via text message, you can access the evaluation via the "Pending Activities" tab in your learner account.
- Click on the title to go to the course landing page. •
- Click "Start."
- Complete the course evaluation under the "Course Progress" bar. •

5: Review the total CE Hours Awarded

- Under the course progress, choose "CE Credit" and select "Review." •
- The system will display the credit type and total number of credits awarded.
- If the system is not displaying the correct credit type, please make sure that your "Learner Profile" is updated.

6: Download the CE Certificate

- Once you have completed all of the session activities, you can access your CE certificate in your • learner profile via the "Completed Activities" tab.
- Click the "Download Certificate" link, this will generate a pdf file (most often found in the bottom left corner of your screen).
- At this point you can open, then print or save the certificate on your computer.

What are the differences between the Live Conference and the Enduring Conference?

- I am not able to join the entire Live Conference, can I attend the Enduring Conference and continue with the educational courses to achieve the maximum CME credits I registered for? Yes.
- Do I need to write down the courses I attend to claim the CMEs?
 No. If you attend the conference in-person, you need to check in and check out daily. If you join virtually, our conference platform automatically tracks your participation and keeps a record.
- What is considered as 'completion' of a lecture? When the participation time of a lecture achieves 90% and above, the lecture is considered completed.
- Can I claim the CME credits for sessions which were registered for free?
 CME/CE credits will NOT be granted to attendees who register for free. If you wish to claim the credits, you will have to register and pay for the registration fee.
- I am a physician, am I able to get the AIUM (The American Institute of Ultrasound in Medicine) certification from this conference?

Our conference provides up to a maximum of 37.75 hours of ultrasound course credits for physicians including OB Ultrasound, Fetal Anatomy and Fetal Echo. Upon completing of the courses, you need to send an email request to prenataldiagnosis.conference@gmail.com for the AIUM report. We will issue you the participation record of the ultrasound courses. Together with the CME certificate, you can certify with the AIUM.
