




Brandon, Jen & Mesha raced the last SCCA Autocross event at the IKE Hamilton Expo Center in West Monroe on the hottest day of the year in August.



PRE-TRIP Checklist

- 1. Complete registration at Hagerty Motorsports Reg HERE
- To do this you will have to;
- Complete an account registration
- Search for the event APEX HPDE Eagle's Canyon. The event you are looking for is APEX HPDE at ECR CCW on Nov 5th
- 2. Complete the online Tech Inspection if you are going to drive your car. You can do this or pay a shop to do it for you.
- 3. You will need a SNELL 2010 rated helmet or you can rent one on the form
- 4. Read and sign the waivers. These indemnify the track, event organizers and anyone who inspected your car against being sued
- 5. Checkout the cost for Novice Early Birds is \$275

TIP: Consider buying one day track insurance from Hagerty or similar company. This covers Your personal vehicle against damage while participating in an HPDE event Your car while on the track or in the paddock Physical damage to your vehicle incurred by you, one additional driver (if approved) and your driving instructor


