If arriving after the Gospel reading, we have missed too much of the Mass to worthily receive Holy Communion. Please avoid chatting, playing with phones and any other inappropriate behaviour. Our children are very precious to us, but please supervise and control them as far as possible. If struggling it is fine to step outside for a little while. Both children and adults can join in the songs and prayers and also pray silently with the priest as he prays directly on our behalf. We should dress modestly in the church building. When receiving Holy Communion please stand still and do not walk away with or consuming the host. If receiving on the tongue please open your mouth and present your tongue properly. Mass has a beginning and an end - we need to be at both - the end is when the final song has finished!
