### SOLEMNITY OF CHRIST THE KING

#### World Youth Sunday

24<sup>th</sup> November 2024

Year B (Psalter Week 2)

When Pope Pius XI established the feast of Christ the King in 1925, he wrote that "it must be clear that not one of our faculties is exempt from Christ's empire." Jesus must reign in our hearts, minds, wills, and bodies. Whatever love and loyalty we have for our country, the values we ultimately choose to espouse must be those of the kingdom of God.

The church is a global family that unites people beyond national borders. As Saint Paul reminds us in his Letter to the Philippians: "Our citizenship is in heaven."
