

Footsteps and Floorboards

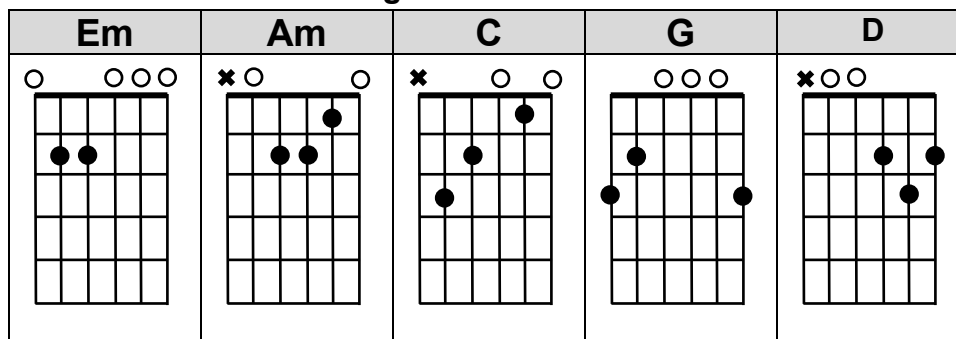

The simple music can be omitted but was added to create somewhat of a song. The song style and Footsteps and Floorboards was inspired by the Cowboy Junkies and their take on Robert Johnson's Floorboard Blues from their first album. But the song theme is very different. It is about the thought process of someone terminally ill in hospice waiting to die, and at first still somewhat in denial while also in great fear of what lies beyond, if anything. Fearing someone or something coming to get him, still hanging onto life and fighting to survive, not accepting his imminent fate. Eventually it yields to finding peace at the very end where that great monster behind the door, the demon, was really a spirit guiding you to the next stage. I'd like to think that terminally ill people do not die in fear and desperation but find, at least in their very last moments, some semblance of peace and acceptance. From the movie Jacob's Ladder: "If you're frightened of dying and you're holding on, you'll see devils tearing your life away. But if you've made your peace, then the devils are really angels, freeing you from the earth."
