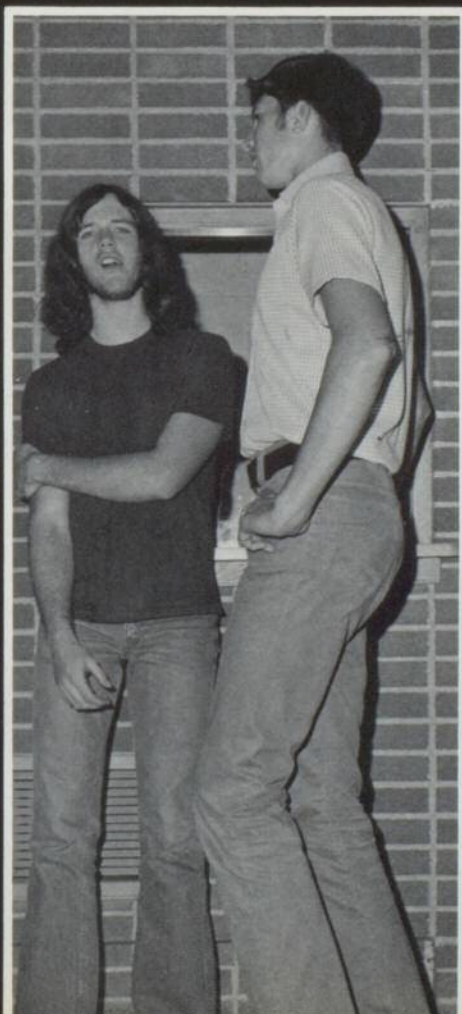
Argos is a wonderful place to be--whether supporting the mighty Dragons, making money for your class, being hung up on crutches, or learning how to use machines.

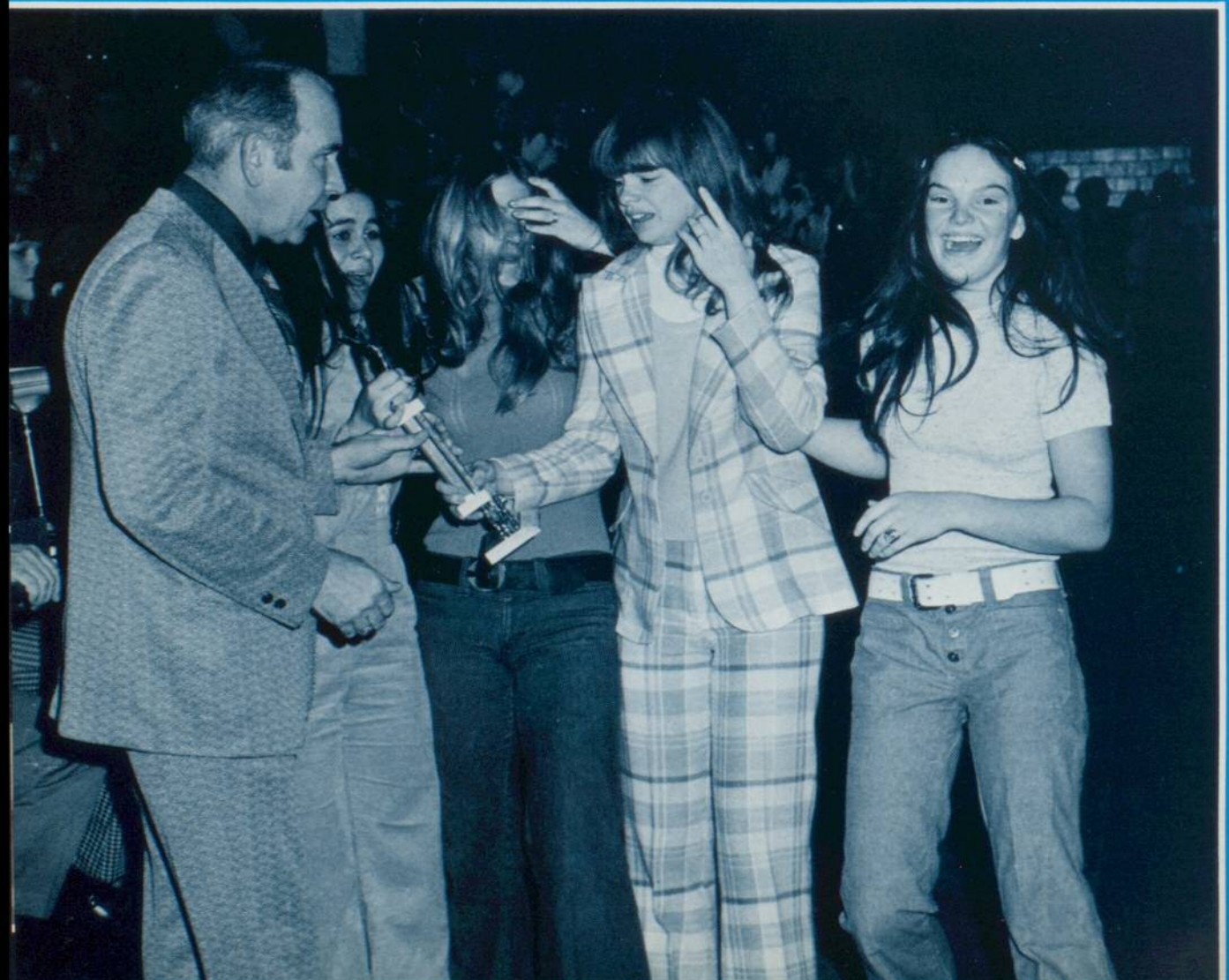

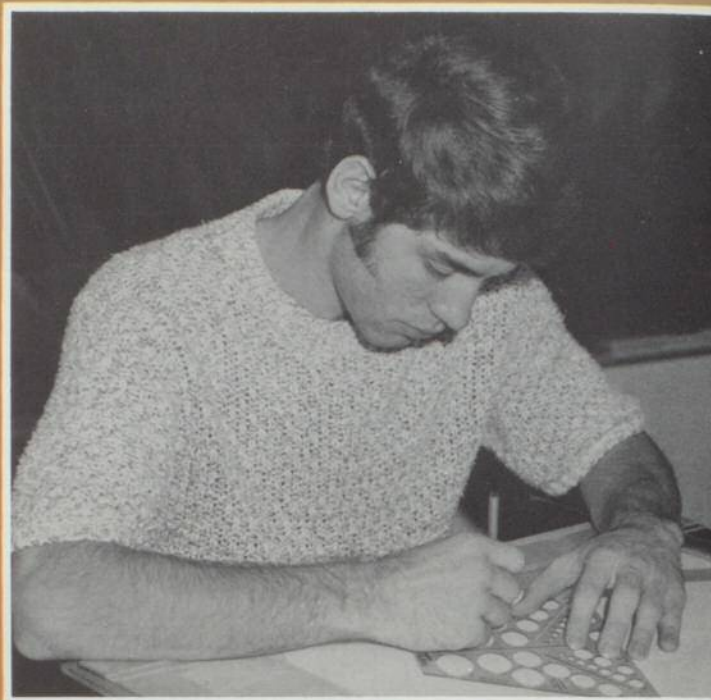

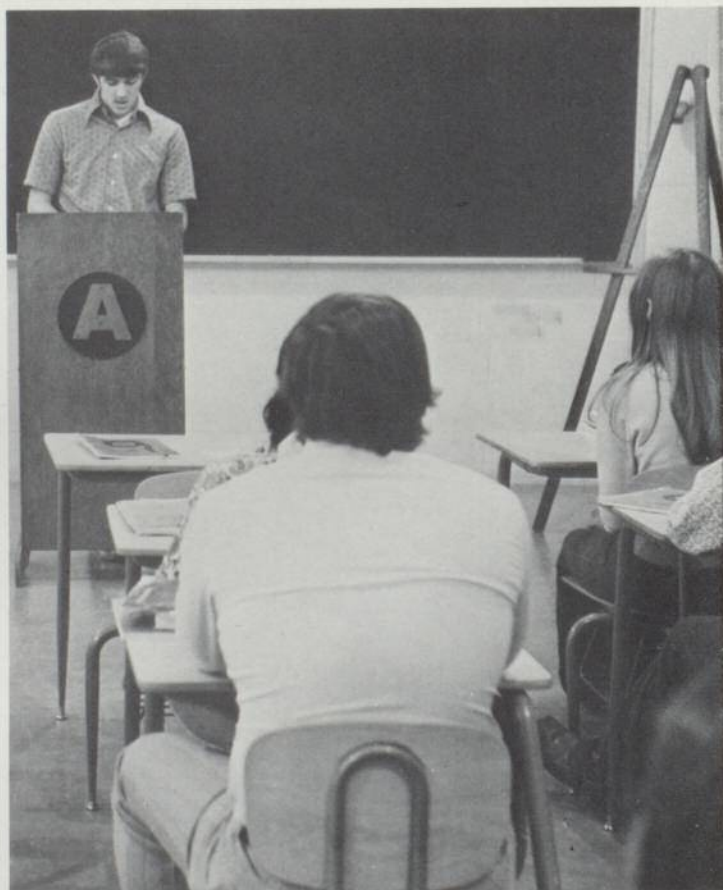

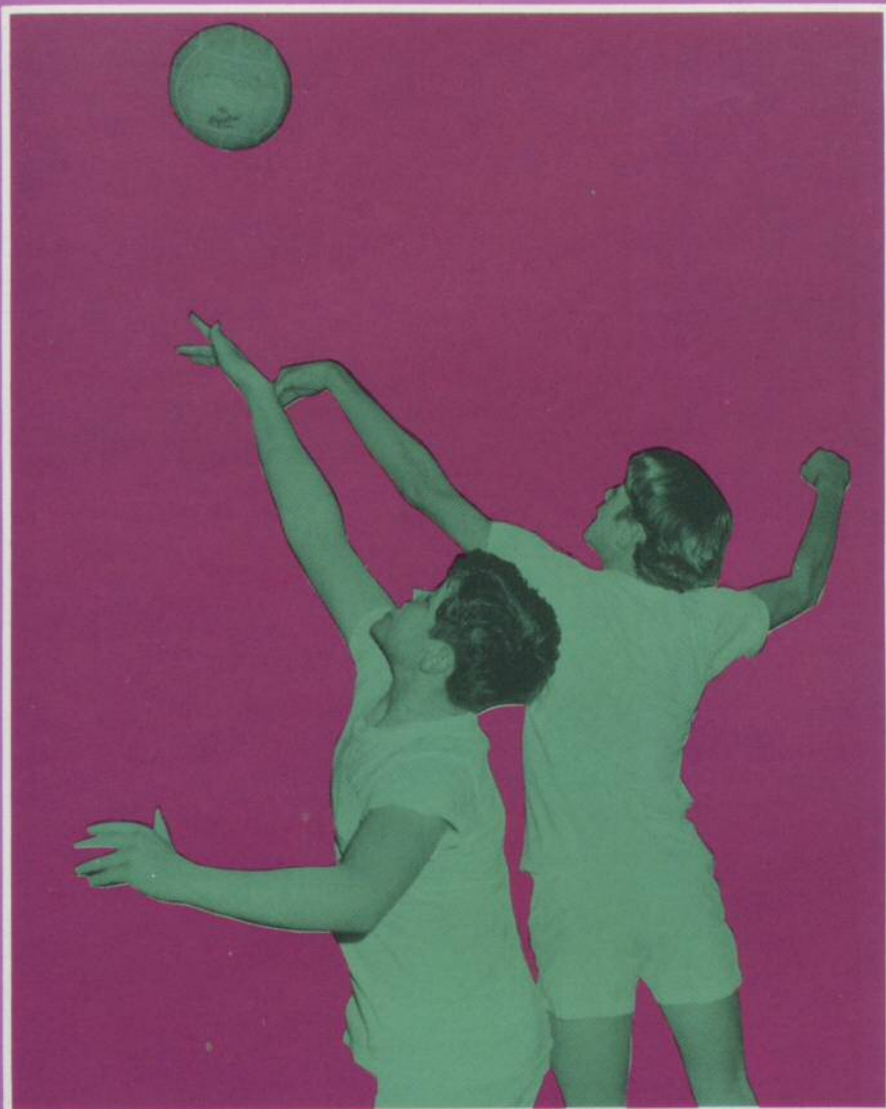

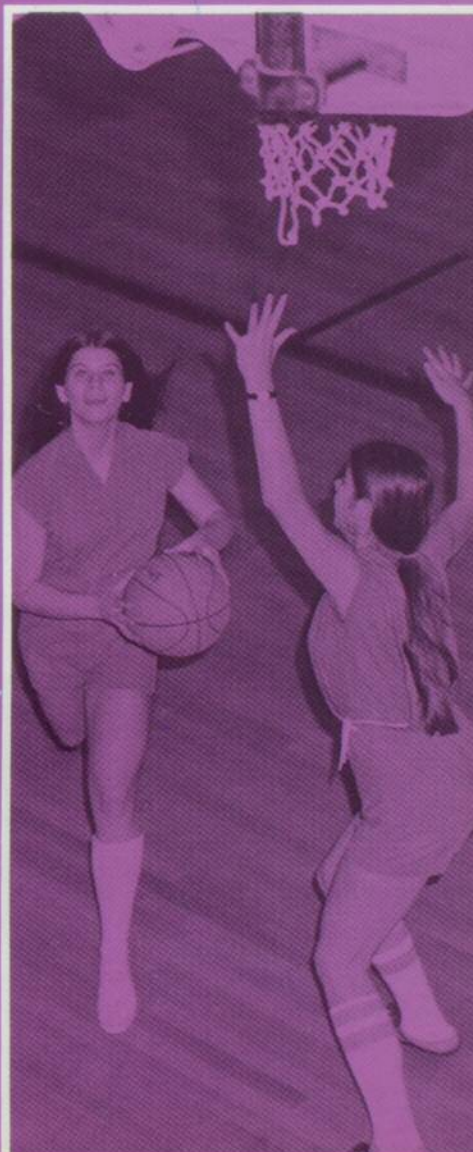

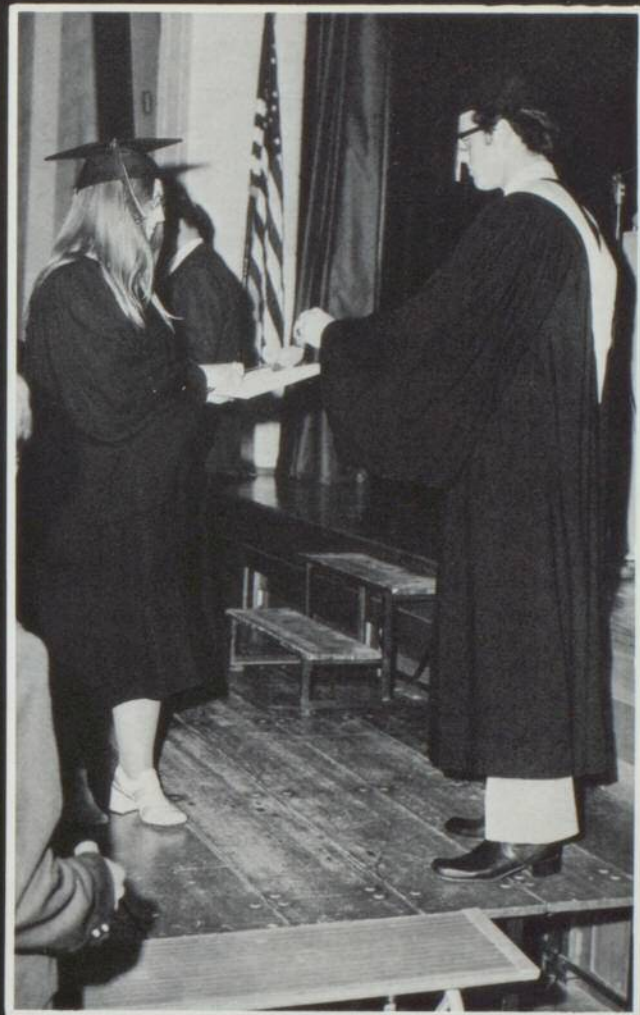

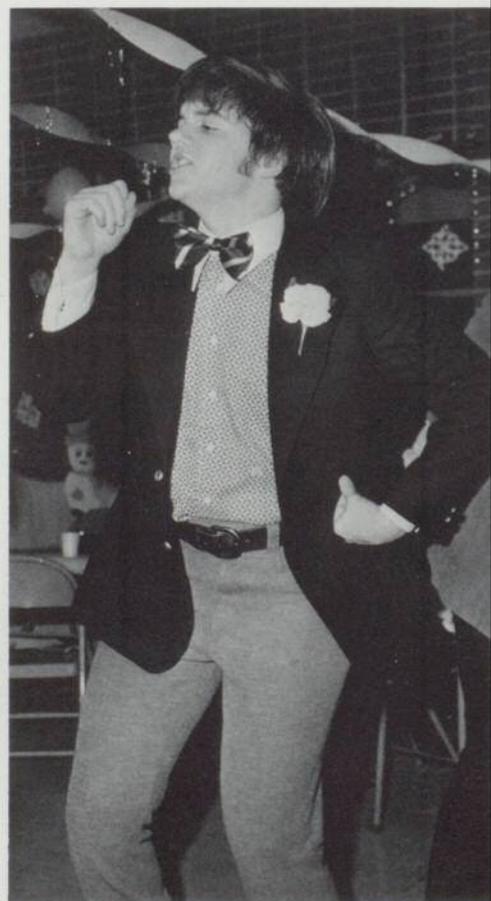

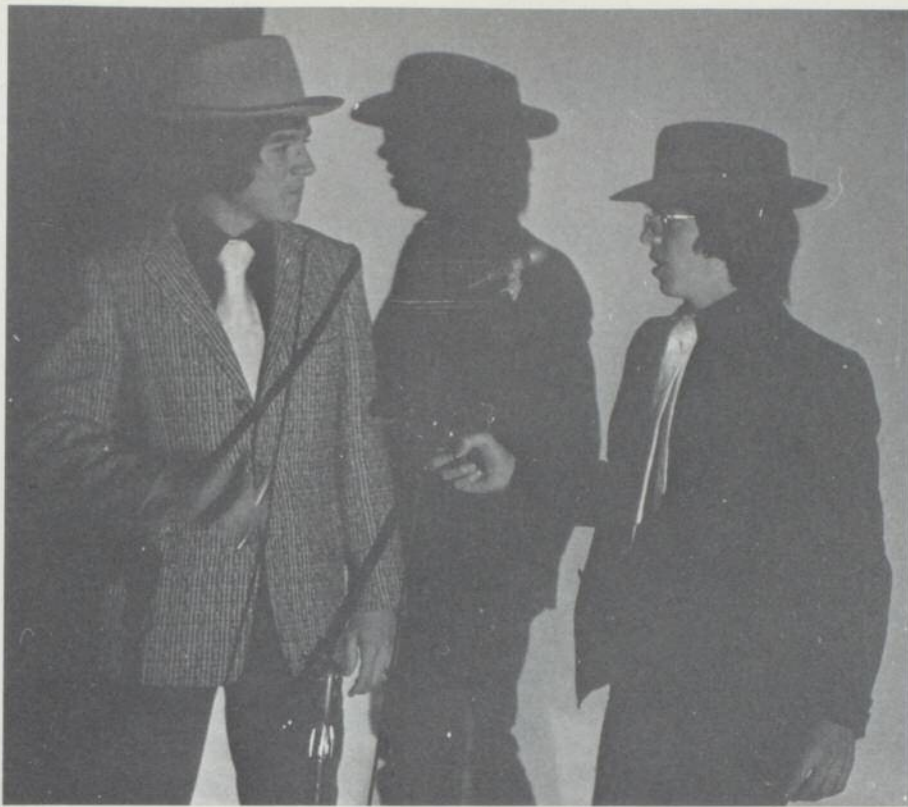

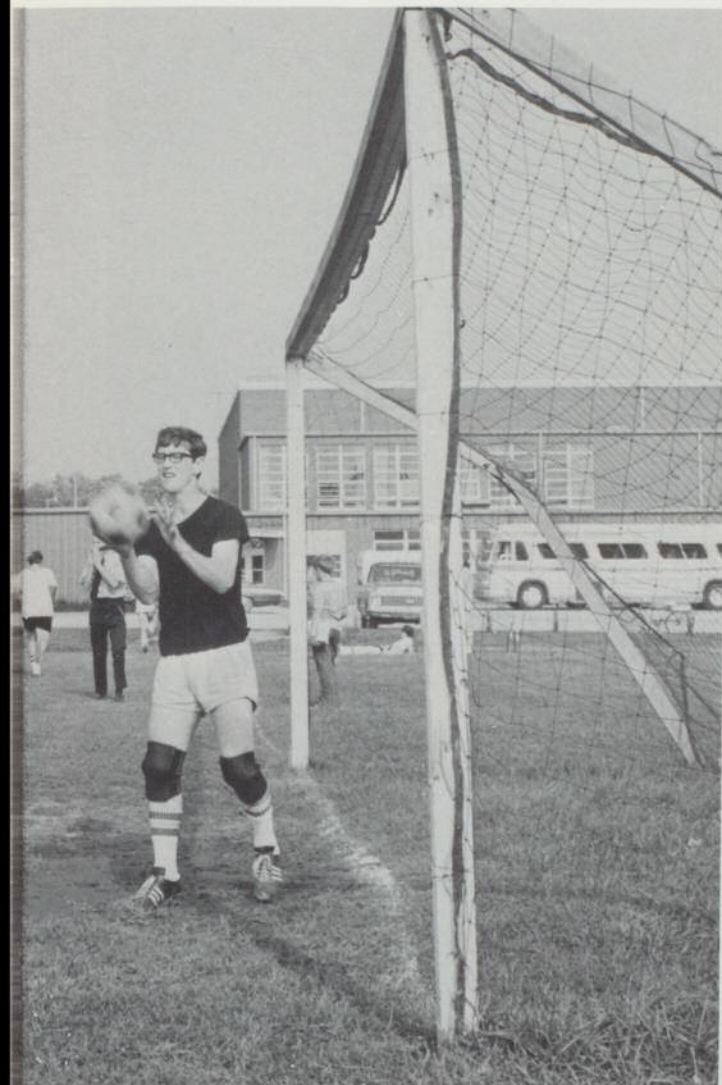

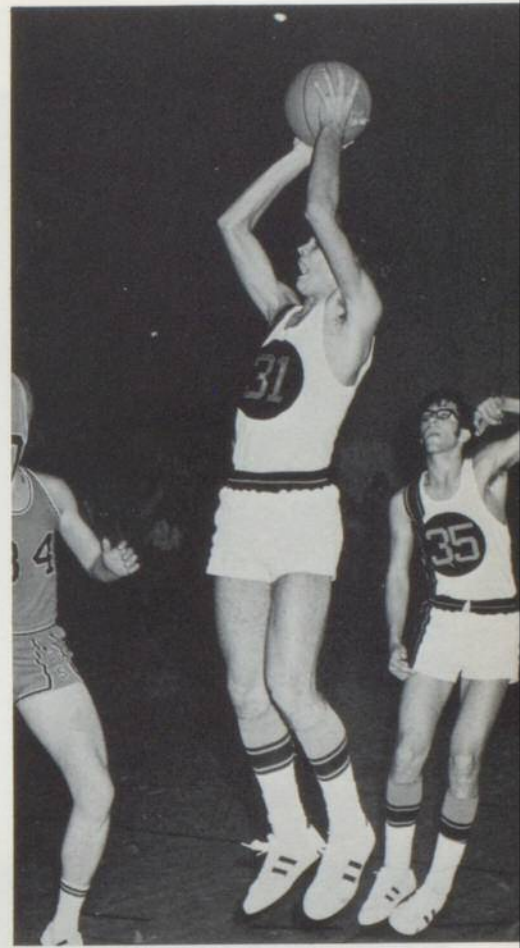

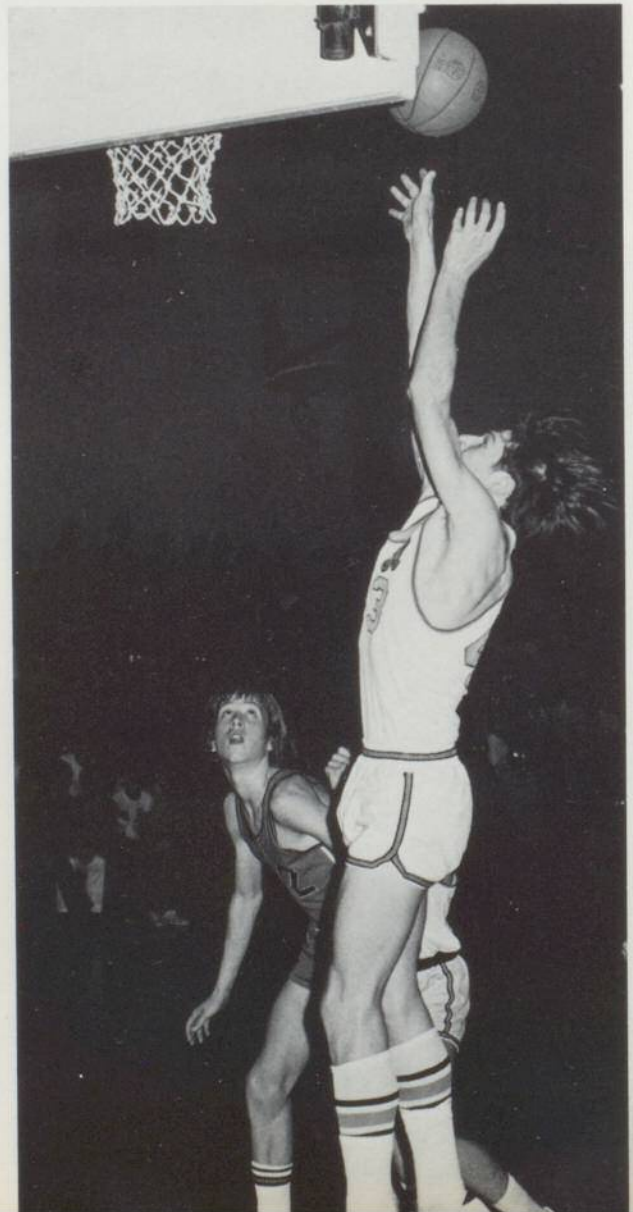

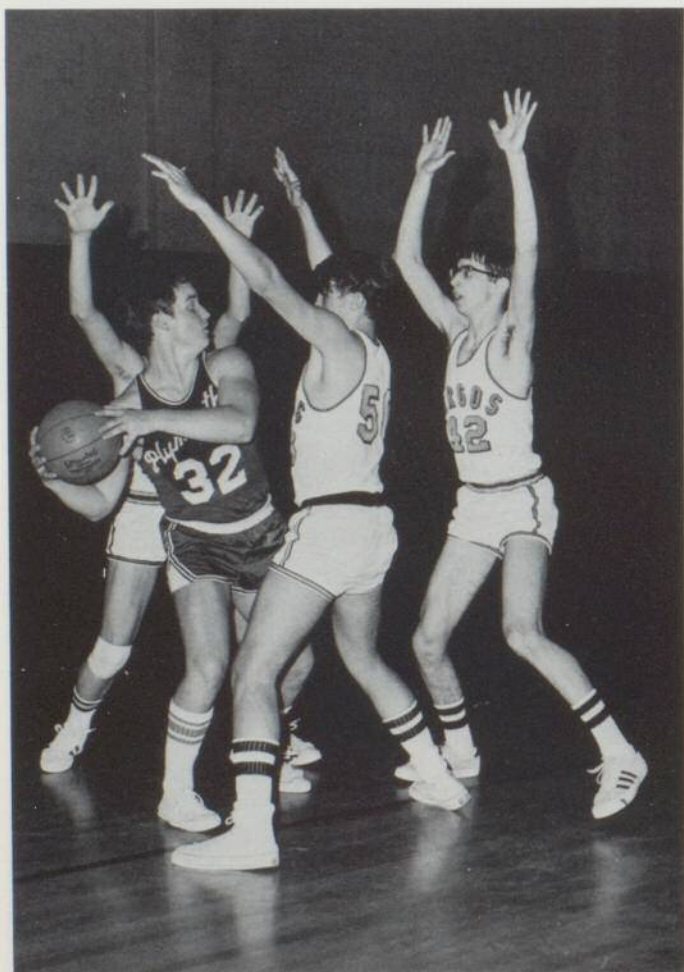

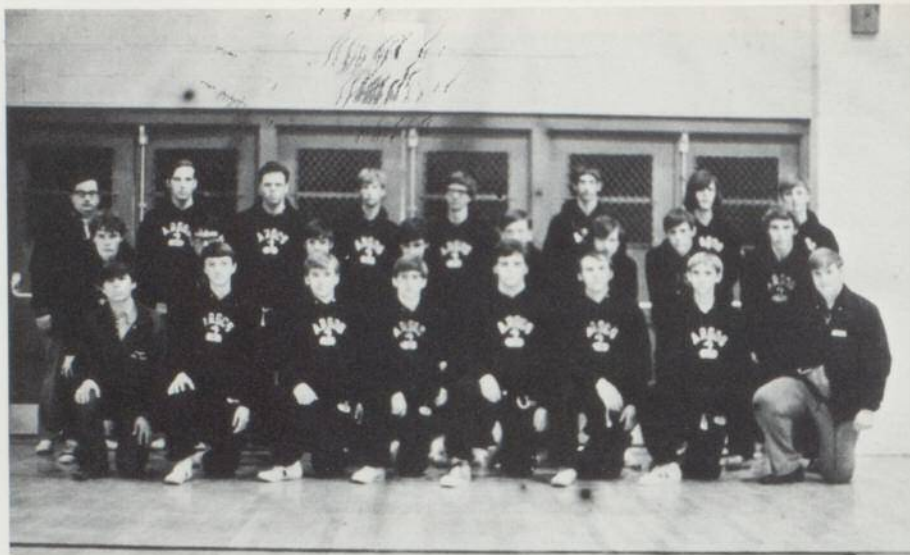

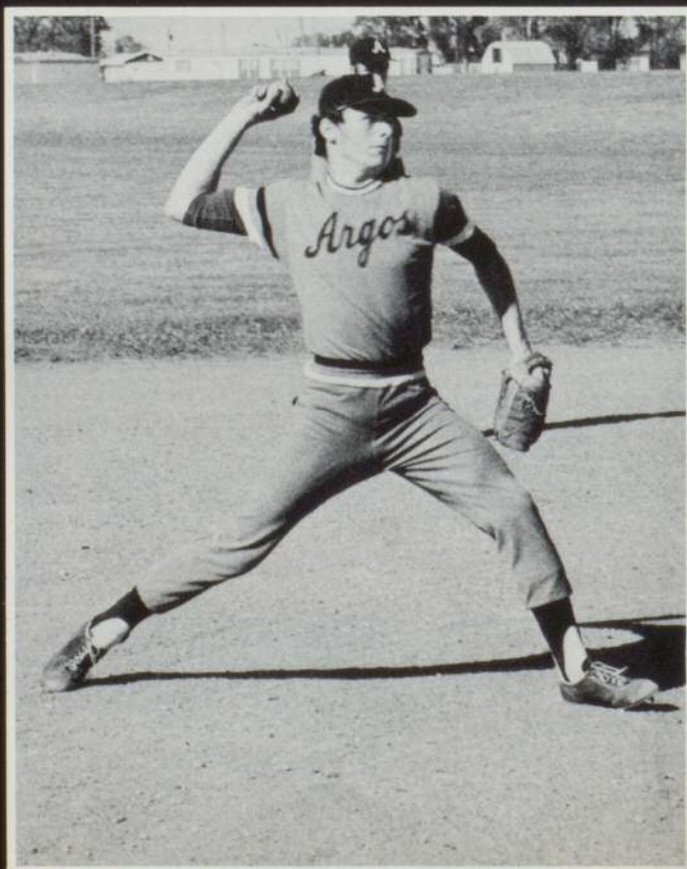


The year is over. I hope that the staff and I have captured the events as they happened.
