



Dear Golden Oaks Resident:

Thank you for everything you continue to do to protect yourself and others during these challenging times. I am reminded of Psalm 46:1-3, which notes...“God is our refuge and strength, an ever present HELP in trouble...”. Throughout these uncertain times, we know that God is our Ultimate Strength, and it is with great excitement that we announce Golden Oaks participation in Operation WARP speed.

As a resident of Golden Oaks, you have exclusive access to the COVID-19 vaccine, which will be distributed to Independent Living Residents on **Wednesday, December 30th at 2:30 p.m. in the Atrium**. This on-site COVID-19 Vaccine Clinic will be offered for residents and staff free of charge.

We understand you may have questions about the vaccine, and we encourage you to reach out to your primary care physician with any specific health related questions. After getting vaccinated, you may have some side effects, which are normal signs that your body is building protection. The most common side effects are pain at the injection site, fever, and chills. These side effects tend to be mild to moderate and go away on their own within 1–2 days. Please see attached fact sheet regarding the COVID-19 Vaccine.

COVID-19 vaccines are an important tool to help stop the pandemic. However, even after vaccination, everyone will need to continue following all the current guidance to protect themselves and others, including wearing a mask, staying at least 6 feet away from others, following facility and community guidance on visitation and infection control, and cleaning hands often.
