

Yummy Cinnabon Cinnamon Roll Cake

Ingredients

3 cups flour
 1/4 teaspoon salt
 1 cup sugar
 4 teaspoons baking powder
 1 1/2 cups milk
 2 eggs
 2 teaspoons vanilla
 1/2 cup butter, melted

Topping:

1 cup butter, softened
 1 cup brown sugar
 2 tablespoons flour
 1 tablespoon cinnamon

Glaze

2 cups powdered sugar
 5 tablespoons milk
 1 teaspoon vanilla

Directions

Preheat oven to 350F. Prepare a 9 x 13 baking pan (buttered).

Mix all of the base ingredients together, with the exception of the butter. Slowly stir in the melted butter last, and then pour into your prepared pan,

Mix all of the topping ingredients together in a separate bowl. Mix well. Drop by tablespoons over the main ingredients, as evenly as you can over the entire base mix.

Take a butter knife and marble/swirl the topping into the base mix. Bake at 350 degrees for 25-30 minutes or until toothpick comes out clean from center. While the cake is baking, prepare the glaze, whisk until smooth and set aside. Remove from oven and drizzle over warm cake. Serve warm straight out of the oven! Yum Yum!

Excerpts from our New Executive Director

Whew! What a saga my life has been since taking over July 7. Mom was on her third day in the hospital from atrial fibrillation problems from her hip surgery the week before, the Oklahoma State LTC Survey team walked in that morning, then Dad started having stroke-like symptoms and had to go to ER. All in the first day! Now - since then, Mom has moved to GOV SNF, fell, broke her hip again, had surgery, returned to GOV SNF again, and discovered she was Covid positive the day after returning from the hospital. Dad has moved to GOV Studios, became Covid positive three days after Mom, went to ER, admitted to GOV SNF also, had 2 infusions, and went to the ER again. I've also been to a meeting in OKC, had a GOV Board Meeting, had TOO many teleconferences, and had the Shemmer engineers and architect in for the physical plant study. If any of you have seen me gimping around, you know that I'm also having some back issues. All that to say this:

I'm learning a LOT about aging! Hopefully this will make me an even better advocate for all our seniors and their families going through these processes themselves.

I am VERY thankful for the staff we have in place at GOV who keep things running daily to make your lives better and to encourage me. We have a great core staff and supervisors who care about you and the future of GOV. Sometimes we all are run a little ragged, and none of us are perfect, but we are trying to serve you well!

I am thankful for YOU. Many of you have also been very encouraging, not only to me but to our other staff as well. You may not realize how an encouraging word may help one of us through the day, but it does. So, THANK YOU.

I apologize if you have tried to see me, and I've been tied up or gone. For those who have brought issues to me, please know I still have your issues on my "to do" list. For now, the immediate, urgent needs have had to take precedence, but I haven't forgotten you!

As far as the next couple of weeks are concerned, these are some things to be aware of:

MEALS: If you have not come to the dining room and noticed the information, we will be having a meal increase effective September 15. The new meal prices are posted in the dining area and will also be included with your monthly statements. Of course, no one ever wants to experience increases, and we feel our individual meal prices are modest compared to actual cost increase, but it is essential at this point. Individual meals make up a small portion of our overall meal costs at our facility, so keep in mind that increases in Assisted Living and the Health Care Center will be on the horizon soon as well. As always, those increases will be communicated at least 30 days in advance.

POOL: The swimming pool will be closed the first week of October. The pool inspection indicated the water has become very hard primarily due to it not being drained routinely. The first week of October, Maintenance will be draining, scrubbing, and refilling the pool. We anticipate this to be an annually scheduled service.

POND: Just in the last days, the north portion of the pond began to emit quite a noxious odor. We do have a contract with a pond specialist; however, this person was ill and missed the last visit. He came out Thursday, August 25, and treated half the algae on the small pond and the north side of the big pond. He could not take too much oxygen out of the water, so he intends to be back again in a week. The heat and lack of wind is a major factor right now in the algae growth, so please be patient as he works on this issue.

NEW STAFF: I'm sure you've noticed the two new faces at the front desk! We are thankful for Erin and Teresa filling those positions. There will be a new face in our financial office with Monica this week. Her name is Oanh (pronounced Wahn). We are excited to welcome her, as well.

Please remember your friends who are not feeling well and those who are getting closer to meeting the Lord. Each of us know someone in our lives facing these difficulties.
