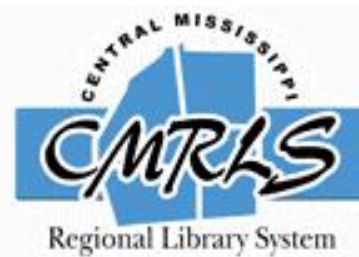

- **Morning session:** 9:30 a.m. until 11:30 a.m.
  - The morning session will include all age groups for basic instructions on the game of chess.
  - Some actual playing time will be included near the end of the morning session.

- **12:30 p.m. until 12:45 p.m.:** Pairings of players for competition *if not already done.*
- **12:45 p.m. until 2 p.m.:** Miniature mock tournament play.
  - This will be an unrated tournament where players will be paired with others in their age group.
  - Players may ask questions of tournament director during play.
  - We will try to get in as many rounds as we can play.
