** Players who have byes or finish a round early may request to play rated games on the side. Results will be sent to USCF, but not counted in tournament scores.

*** Ties will be settled by SwissSys computer program. Cash prizes will be split per USCF rules. Computer tiebreakers will determine trophy and medal recipients.

Roosevelt State Park enforces a daily admission fee of \$2 per person for entering the park. Children ages 5 and under are allowed free.

- *Registered players will receive a pre-event email* on Wednesday prior to tournament including important last-minute details.
