Four people are needed to help guide members with food dishes when they arrive. Food will be organized by tables: Appetizer, Salads, Sides and Desserts.


Please, please...If you have not yet signed up for a dish to pass at the Holiday Party, please contact Kathy Girgen, as soon as possible to help her organize the food sign up.
