Our equipment, Class A and Class B, is available for rent for an additional charge or you may bring your own equipment.

Scheduling Requirement: All persons interested in testing need their CDL permit, driver's license and DOT medical card.

Courses meet the Federal ELDT requirements.

Training Courses Offered

Class A

150 Clock Hours

Tuition - \$6,000

Class B

115 Clock Hours

Tuition - \$4,500

Program length is approximately 7 weeks, first two weeks are in classroom instruction from 7am-3:30pm Monday-Friday for a total of 80 hours. The remaining hours are scheduled for behind the wheel in four hour blocks of time from either 7am-11am, or 11:30am-3:30pm .
