"The Grandest Charge of the War" -

Barksdale's Brigade Crushes Sickle's Salient

Under a blazing sun on July 2, 1863, Confederate General William Barksdale led his Mississippi brigade in a fierce charge against Union lines near the Peach Orchard. Barksdale's men surged forward through smoke and artillery fire, crashing into Union troops and breaking their position. The attack created chaos across the battlefield as Confederate soldiers pushed deep into Union territory, capturing cannons and forcing a retreat. But the momentum came at a terrible cost—Barksdale himself was mortally wounded while rallying his men, and the Confederate advance eventually stalled under mounting Union resistance.

Battlefield 2:00

"A Determination Never Equaled" - The Pickett - Pettigrew - Trimble Assault

During the climactic assault of July 3, 1863, the Confederate brigades of John M. Brockenbrough and Joseph R. Davis advanced on the left flank of Longstreet's Assault across the open fields toward Union positions on Cemetery Ridge. As the Confederate line moved forward under heavy artillery fire, the Union 8th Ohio Infantry moved to the Confederate left and struck Brockenbrough's exposed flank with devastating volleys. The attack shattered the brigade's formation, sending many Confederates fleeing to the rear and exposing Davis's brigade to intense pressure. The collapse of the Confederate left weakened the assault before it could fully reach the Union center and the Bryan Farm.

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
