

Sergeants - 1 1/2" taping of worsted wool on the leg in Branch of Service color)

**Acceptable:**

- All Branches: Sky Blue Wool

**Improper:**

- Anything that is not listed above, ie: Blue Jeans

**Trousers- Officer**

**Preferred:**

- Dark Blue Wool for Junior or Senior Officers with proper Branch of Service piping on the leg

Infantry - Sky Blue

Cavalry - Yellow

Artillery - Red

General and General's Staff - Gold

**Acceptable:**

- Sky Blue Wool with or without piping
- Dark Blue Wool without piping

**Improper:**

- Anything that is not listed above ie: Blue Jeans

Notes on Trousers:

- *Civil War Era Trousers were designed to be worn at the natural waist, which means the top button of the closure should be at your navel*
- *This event is an entire day longer than you are used to. Leave the gym shorts at home; silky gym shorts do not breath like the cotton drawers of the period. This will cause excess moisture and very uncomfortable chaffing.*

**Preferred and Acceptable**

- Period Correct Civilian Styles and Patterns
- White Cotton or Muslin
- Federal Issue Gray Flannel

**Unacceptable:**

- T- shirts
- Modern Flannel Shirts
