Discussion was had as to the nature of the current budget revenue stream and how that might be analyzed by a regular report showing the shortfall resulting from expenditures on the GSP renewal.
- d. GSP Implementation Items
 - i. Boundary Adjustments it was concurred that Bulletin 120 boundaries will not be done as there are substantial barriers. Recommendations were made to make agreements with landowners appurtenant to the edge of the B120

- EKGSA boundaries. Additionally, modification to boundaries that simply make sense should be done as soon as administratively feasible.
- ii. City of Farmersville Mitigation Water Connection Limited discussion was had on this topic. Mark Larsen noted that the project will proceed and may be less that anticipated.
