

ABOUT THE KAWEAH SUBBASIN

Greater Kaweah, Mid-Kaweah, & East Kaweah Groundwater Sustainability Agencies (GSAs)

- Sustainable Groundwater Management Act (SGMA) signed into law in 2014 mandates groundwater sustainability by 2040
 - Grants local control to GSAs
- Each GSA is required to develop a Groundwater Sustainability Plan (GSP)
- CA Department of Water Resources (DWR) looks at entire subbasin for sustainability
- Current status: amended inadequate GSPs to keep in right standing with the State

IF STATE BOARD DESIGNATES KAWEAH SUBBASIN AS PROBATIONARY

- State manages groundwater resources (Interim Plan)
 - Additional to local management; lasts until GSAs demonstrate they can adequately manage their respective areas
- Groundwater pumpers must submit groundwater extraction report to State
- Landowners pay additional fees to the State

GSAs keep local control over groundwater management

Implement supply-side projects, not just demand management

WHERE WE GO FROM HERE

DWR found GSPs inadequate due to:


- Lack of coordination of the Sustainable Management Criteria (goal-posts/benchmarks)
- Discrepancies in subsidence analysis
- Insufficient clarity in Mitigation Framework and Plan
- Failure to consider how sustainable indicators affect one another
- Kaweah Subbasin amended their GSPs and are leading the area with demand management and new water supply projects




TECHNICAL TEAMS & SYTEMS IN PLACE

AGREE ON THE APPROACH:

Balancing Sustainability

Efforts

Revised GSPs show coordinated efforts to address State's concerns, while balancing impacts to groundwater users

SUSTAINABLE MANAGEMENT CRITERIA

These are the benchmarks set by GSAs to ensure the sustainable management of groundwater across Kaweah Subbasin (the State looks closely at these)

Address all DWR deficiencies

Use best available data and analytic tools

Revise to be even more protective of all beneficial users, uses, and property interests

Capture input from stakeholders & build support

Coordinated Subbasin-wide

MITIGATION PROGRAM

Coordinated Mitigation Framework and Plan across Kaweah Subbasin

- The State needs to see that during the period before sustainability is achieved (now - 2040), the impacts of groundwater overdraft are "mitigated"
- Mitigation services and technical assistance for those impacted by groundwater overdraft conditions funded by the GSAs
- Partnership with Self-Help Enterprises to administer the new Mitigation Program



ADDRESSING DWR DEFICIENCIES

A total of **108 public meetings** took place to coordinate revisions across all three Kaweah Subbasin GSPs

State Board added comments for additional revisions in May 2024. While some overlap with DWR comments, there are some items remaining for the next round of GSP amendments.




