- 1. Request for scholarship applications must be made to and only distributed by the members of the D.C.A.M.W.M.W**
- 2. Application forms and all required information must be received by May 10th.**
- 3. Scholarship requestors must be directly recommended by an active member of the D.C.A.M.W.M.W**
- 4. Applicants must have a grade point average (GPA) of at least 2.50. A transcript must accompany this application and or accreditation documentation. Certification enrollment for career training paths of a profession.**
- 5. Applicant must be a direct descendent of a current member or an active member of a church that is affiliated with D.C.A.M.W.M.W. member also belongs to a church.**
- 6. There will be 3 scholarships awarded of \$350.00 each. An additional \$150.00 will be awarded to the student who has the highest GPA of the three scholarship recipients. (The amount of the scholarship is subject to be changed by the State President.)**
