

Worksheet One: Building Your Own Rule of Faith (chapters 1-6) Who Does God Say He Is?

Use your journal to complete the following:

Step One: How to personalize scripture

1. Write out verse you want to commit to your heart.
2. Personalize the verse so it becomes a conversation or prayer between you and God.
3. Read the verse again and then speak it out loud. Repeat several times during the day.

“I have hidden your word in my heart that I might not sin against you.” Psalm 119:11

Step Two: Who does God say He is?

There are many names in the Bible that God uses to describe who He is. The name is sounded out in the in the parenthesis. (The capital letters designate the accented syllable)

After reviewing the names, pray and ask God to show you which are most important for you. Underline the ones that stick out to you.

1. God is Elohim (Ell-oh-HEEM), The Creator.
2. God is El-Elyon (el-el-YAWN), God Most High
3. God is El-Roi (el-roe-EYE). The God who sees me
4. God is El Shaddai (El-shah-DIE) The all-sufficient one
5. God is Adonai (AH-doe-nie) The Lord and Master
6. God is Jehovah (Jeh-HOE-vah) Who was, Who is, and Who is to come. The self-existent One.
7. God is Jehovah Jireh (Jeh-HOE-vah-JIE-rah) The Lord who provides.
8. God is Jehovah Rapha (Jeh-HOE-vah-rah-Fah) The Lord who heals me.
9. God is Jehovah Nissi (Jeh-HOE-vah-nee-SEE) The Lord my banner who leads me into war
10. God is Jehovah Mekodishkem (Jeh-HOE-vah-mek-oh-DISH-kem) The Lord who sanctifies me and declares me holy
11. God is Jehovah Shalom (Jeh-HOE-vah-shah-LOME) The Lord is peace.
12. God is Jehovah Sabboath (Joh-HOE-vah-sah-bah-OATH). The Lord of hosts (angel armies)
13. God is Jehovah Tsidkenu (Jeh-HOE-vah-SID-ken-oo) the Lord my righteousness
14. God is Jehovah Shammah (Jeh-HOE-vah-shah-MAH) The Lord is here (there)
