

## Acer | Maple

### CLUMP-FORM AMUR MAPLE

*Acer ginnala*

MATURE SIZE: 20' x 15' (6 m x 5 m) CROWN SHAPE: Rounded  
 FALL FOLIAGE: Red EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ○ Zone 2

Multi-stemmed specimen of this cold hardy species. Recognized for its deep-green, three-lobed leaves. Produces red samaras in late summer and scarlet leaves in fall.

### FLAME AMUR MAPLE

*Acer ginnala* 'Flame'

MATURE SIZE: 20' x 15' (6 m x 5 m) CROWN SHAPE: Rounded  
 FALL FOLIAGE: Bright-red EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ○ Zone 2

A popular cultivar of Amur Maple with three-lobed leaves with bright-red fall colour. Summer samaras are also a pleasant red colour, adding interest to any yard or garden.

### ROYAL CROWN® AMUR MAPLE

*Acer ginnala* 'JefUM'



MATURE SIZE: 20' x 15' (6 m x 5 m) CROWN SHAPE: Rounded  
 FALL FOLIAGE: Burgundy-red EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ○ Zone 2

An alkali-resistant selection of Amur Maple from research done at the University of Manitoba. Three-lobed leaves with burgundy-red fall colour. Consistently maintains a three-stem clump.

### RUBY SLIPPERS® AMUR MAPLE

*Acer ginnala* 'Ruby Slippers'

MATURE SIZE: 20' x 15' (6 m x 5 m) CROWN SHAPE: Upright, rounded  
 FALL FOLIAGE: Orange-red (late) EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ○ Zone 3

Selected for a straight trunk, dense canopy and bright red samaras in early summer.

### TREE-FORM AMUR MAPLE

*Acer ginnala*

MATURE SIZE: 20' x 15' (6 m x 5 m) CROWN SHAPE: Upright, rounded  
 FALL FOLIAGE: Red EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ○ Zone 2

Single stem, tree-form specimen of this hardy species. Recognized for its deep-green, three-lobed leaves. Our seed source produces red samaras in summer and scarlet leaves in fall.

### BARON BOXELDER MAPLE

*Acer negundo* 'Baron'

MATURE SIZE: 50' x 30' (15 x 9 m) CROWN SHAPE: Rounded  
 FALL FOLIAGE: Bright-yellow EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ○ Zone 2

A seedless selection from this rugged native species. Attractive emerald-green, compound foliage turns yellow in the fall. Well adapted to a wide range of growing conditions.

### BOXELDER MAPLE

*Acer negundo*

MATURE SIZE: 50' x 30' (15 x 9 m) CROWN SHAPE: Rounded  
 FALL FOLIAGE: Bright-yellow EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ○ Zone 2

A native tree species found throughout southern Manitoba and Saskatchewan. Attractive, green compound foliage. Adapted to a range of growing conditions including difficult sites.

### AUTUMN BLAZE® FREEMAN MAPLE

*Acer x freemanii* 'Jeffersred'

MATURE SIZE: 40' x 30' (12 x 9 m) CROWN SHAPE: Dense oval  
 FALL FOLIAGE: Bright-red (late) EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ○ Zone 4

A hybrid between Red and Silver Maple with red fall colour in mid October. Requires a well-drained, sheltered site in the prairies. Collector tree for the prairie gardener.

### REGAL CELEBRATION® FREEMAN MAPLE

*Acer x freemanii* 'Jefcel'



MATURE SIZE: 45' x 30' (12 x 9 m) CROWN SHAPE: Broad oval  
 FALL FOLIAGE: Bright-red EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ○ Zone 3

A seedless hybrid between Red and Silver Maple with outstanding red fall colour in late September. Prefers soil pH of less than 7.5, soil amendment required in high pH soils.

### FREEMAN SELECT FREEMAN MAPLE



*Acer x freemanii* 'Select'

MATURE SIZE: 40' x 30' (12 x 9 m) CROWN SHAPE: Broadly oval  
 FALL FOLIAGE: Bright-red EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ○ Zone 3

**New listing for 2024.** Unique seedling strain arising from a cross between Freeman maple and Silver Cloud silver maple. These seedlings feature red fall colour and improved winter hardiness over Autumn Blaze.

## Acer | Maple

### DEBORAH NORWAY MAPLE

*Acer platanoides* 'Deborah'

MATURE SIZE: 40' x 30' (12 x 9 m)  
 SPRING FOLIAGE: Purple

CROWN SHAPE: Broadly oval  
 EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ☉ Zone 3b

The hardiest Norway maple cultivar in our testing program. Purple spring foliage followed by dark green summer foliage. Requires a well-drained, sheltered site in the prairies. Collector tree for the prairie gardener.

### PRAIRIE ROUGE® RED MAPLE

*Acer rubrum* 'Jefrouge'

MATURE SIZE: 30' x 15' (9 x 5 m)  
 FALL FOLIAGE: Bright, red

CROWN SHAPE: Narrow, upright  
 EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ☉ Zone 2

Selected from NW Ontario, Prairie Rouge is a narrow tree with outstanding red fall colour in September. Prefers soil pH of less than 7.5, soil amendment required in high pH soils.

### SILVER CLOUD® SILVER MAPLE

*Acer saccharinum* 'Silver Cloud'

MATURE SIZE: 60' x 30' (18 x 9 m)  
 FALL FOLIAGE: Yellow

CROWN SHAPE: Upright, oval  
 EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ☉ Zone 3

A fast-growing shade tree for the southern prairies, this seedless selection has improved cold hardiness, upright crown and symmetrical branching. Prairie Shade Nursery introduction.

### LORD SELKIRK SUGAR MAPLE

*Acer saccharum* 'Jefselk'

MATURE SIZE: 40' x 30' (12 x 9 m)  
 FALL FOLIAGE: Orange-yellow

CROWN SHAPE: Upright  
 EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ☉ Zone 3

A northern seed source of Sugar Maple with good adaptation to conditions in the southern prairies. Named in honor of the 200<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Selkirk settlement.

### INFERNO® SUGAR MAPLE

*Acer saccharum* 'Jeferno'

MATURE SIZE: 40' x 30' (12 x 9 m)  
 FALL FOLIAGE: Orange-red

CROWN SHAPE: Upright, rounded  
 EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ☉ Zone 2

Our most recent selection of Canada's national tree with exceptional orange-red fall colour. Prefers rich, well drained soil and a sheltered location. Jeffries Nurseries introduction.

### HOT WINGS® TATARIAN MAPLE

*Acer tataricum* 'GarAnn'

MATURE SIZE: 20' x 18' (7 x 6 m)  
 FALL FOLIAGE: Yellow (late)

CROWN SHAPE: Upright, spreading  
 EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ☉ Zone 2

An excellent small tree, this recent selection of Tatarian Maple offers dark green foliage and bright red samaras. Tolerant of drought and alkaline soils. USPP #15,023

## Aesculus | Buckeye

### OHIO BUCKEYE

*Aesculus glabra*

MATURE SIZE: 40' x 30' (12 x 9 m)  
 FALL FOLIAGE: Orange-red

CROWN SHAPE: Rounded  
 EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ☉ ● Zone 2

Long lived, slow-growing tree with globe-shaped head. Unique compound foliage develops excellent orange-red fall colour in mid September. Nuts attract wildlife.

## *Alnus* | Alder

### **PRAIRIE HORIZON® MANCHURIAN ALDER** *Alnus hirsuta* 'Harbin'

MATURE SIZE: 35' x 20' (11 x 7 m) CROWN SHAPE: Upright  
 FALL FOLIAGE: Yellow EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ☉ Zone 2

A fast-growing, cold hardy tree for difficult, dry locations. Dark green foliage, purple catkins followed by brown strobiles (resembling tiny pine cones) in fall. NDSU introduction.

## *Betula* | Birch

### **CUTLEAF WEeping BIRCH** *Betula pendula laciniata*

MATURE SIZE: 40' x 25' (12 x 8 m) CROWN SHAPE: Weeping  
 FALL FOLIAGE: Bright-yellow EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ☉ Zone 2

A graceful, white barked tree with fine, lacy dark-green foliage on long, drooping branches.

### **CLUMP PAPER BIRCH** *Betula papyrifera*

MATURE SIZE: 40' x 30' (12 x 9 m) CROWN SHAPE: Oval, rounded  
 FALL FOLIAGE: Golden-yellow EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ☉ Zone 2

An attractive native tree grown as a 3-4 stemmed specimen. Prefers abundant moisture.

### **SINGLE-STEM PAPER BIRCH** *Betula papyrifera*

MATURE SIZE: 40' x 30' (12 x 9 m) CROWN SHAPE: Oval, rounded  
 FALL FOLIAGE: Golden-yellow EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ☉ Zone 2

An attractive native tree grown as a single stem specimen. As the tree matures the brown bark peels off and a chalk-white coloured bark appears. Prefers abundant moisture.

### **NORTHERN TRIBUTE® RIVER BIRCH** *Betula nigra* 'Dickinson'

MATURE SIZE: 35' x 30' (12 x 10 m) CROWN SHAPE: Upright oval  
 FALL FOLIAGE: Golden-yellow EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ☉ Zone 3

The parent tree in Dickinson, N.D. is the largest of this species observed in the upper Northern Plains. Ivory colored bark with striking coppery-bronze exfoliations. Resistant to bronze birch borer. NDSU introduction.

### **PARKLAND PILLAR® ASIAN WHITE BIRCH** *Betula platyphylla* 'Jefpark'

MATURE SIZE: 30' x 9' (10 x 3 m) CROWN SHAPE: Columnar  
 FALL FOLIAGE: Golden-yellow EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ☉ Zone 2

A columnar selection of Asian White Birch selected by Dwayne Beck of Parkland Nurseries in Red Deer, Alberta. Jeffries Nurseries introduction. CPBR #4513, USPP #25,468

### **PRAIRIE DREAM® PAPER BIRCH** *Betula papyrifera* 'Varen'

MATURE SIZE: 50' x 35' (15 x 11 m) CROWN SHAPE: Broad oval  
 FALL FOLIAGE: Golden-yellow EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ☉ Zone 2

A stress tolerant selection of Paper Birch from North Dakota. Deep green foliage & exfoliating, snow-white bark. NDSU introduction. USPP #15,768

### **ROYAL FROST® HYBRID BIRCH** *Betula x* 'Royal Frost'

MATURE SIZE: 40' x 20' (12 x 6 m) CROWN SHAPE: Upright  
 SUMMER FOLIAGE: Purple EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ☉ Zone 3b

A hybrid between cultivars 'Whitespire' and 'Crimson Frost'. Royal Frost offers burgundy foliage from spring through summer. White bark develops with maturity.

## *Caragana* | Caragana

### **GREEN SPIRES® HYBRID CARAGANA** *Caragana x* 'Jefarb'

MATURE SIZE: 12' x 8' (4 x 2.5 m) CROWN SHAPE: Upright, rounded  
 FALL FOLIAGE: Golden-yellow EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ☉ Zone 2

A seedless hybrid from a cross between *Caragana arborescens* and *C. frutex*. Dark green foliage is resistant to insects and disease. Resistant to urban conditions including salt and drought. Selected by Greg Morganson of Bismarck, N.D.

## Celtis | Hackberry

### DELTA HACKBERRY

*Celtis occidentalis*

MATURE SIZE: 50' x 40' (15 x 12 m)  
FALL FOLIAGE: Golden-yellow

CROWN SHAPE: Spreading, rounded  
EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ☉ Zone 2

A rare, native species sourced from a population at Delta, Manitoba. Hackberry has a growth form similar to American Elm and is a suitable tree for extreme city conditions. Bark is corky and rough.

## Cornus | Dogwood

### PAGODA DOGWOOD TREEFORM

*Cornus alternifolia*

MATURE HEIGHT: 15 Feet (5 m)  
BARK COLOUR: Green

MATURE SPREAD: 15 Feet (5 m)  
EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ☉ Zone 3

Native to southern Manitoba, this large shrub offers unique horizontal, tiered branching. White flowers produce blue fruit in fall. Pruned to a single stem to make an accent tree.

## Crataegus | Hawthorn

### SNOWBIRD HAWTHORN

*Crataegus x mordenensis* 'Snowbird'

MATURE SIZE: 20' x 15' (6 m x 5 m)  
FLOWERS: Double-white

CROWN SHAPE: Upright, rounded  
EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ☉ Zone 3

A seedling of 'Toba' with improved cold hardiness. Known for its double white flowers and sparse fruit. Introduced by the Morden Research Station in 1967.

### TOBA HAWTHORN

*Crataegus x mordenensis* 'Toba'

MATURE SIZE: 20' x 15' (6 m x 5 m)  
FLOWERS: White, then pink

CROWN SHAPE: Upright, rounded  
EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ☉ Zone 3b

Fragrant, double white spring flowers turn pink with time and are followed by showy red fruit in fall. Glossy, deep green, disease resistant foliage.

## Fraxinus | Ash

### MANCANA MANCHURIAN ASH

*Fraxinus mandshurica* 'Mancana'

MATURE SIZE: 40' x 35' (13 x 11 m)  
FALL FOLIAGE: Golden

CROWN SHAPE: Oval  
EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ☉ Zone 2b

The feather-like leaves, dense compact canopy and oval form make this one of our most attractive trees. Deep-green foliage turns golden-yellow in fall. A seedless cultivar, Mancana has shown a high level of resistance to Emerald Ash Borer in American research trials.

### NOBILITY® WHITE ASH

*Fraxinus americana* 'Jefwis'

MATURE SIZE: 50' x 30' (15 x 9 m)  
FALL FOLIAGE: Purple

CROWN SHAPE: Upright  
EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ☉ Zone 2

Nobility® is a seedless White Ash selection with upright branching, oval-shaped crown and clean foliage. Foliage turns a deep purple colour early in the fall. Resistant to cottony psyllid but susceptible to Emerald Ash Borer. A Jeffries Nurseries introduction.

### PRAIRIE SPIRE® GREEN ASH

*Fraxinus pennsylvanica* 'Rugby'

MATURE SIZE: 50' x 35' (15 x 9 m)  
FALL FOLIAGE: Golden

CROWN SHAPE: Upright, oval-shaped  
EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ☉ Zone 2

A seedless Green Ash selected by Dr. Dale Herman for cold hardiness and survival under harsh conditions. Attractive foliage is glossy and deep green. Resistant to cottony psyllid but susceptible to Emerald Ash Borer. NDSU Introduction.

## Gleditsia | Honeylocust

### NORTHERN ACCLAIM® HONEYLOCUST

*Gleditsia triacanthos* 'Harve'

MATURE SIZE: 40' x 35' (13 m x 11 m)  
FALL FOLIAGE: Golden

CROWN SHAPE: Open, spreading  
EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ☉ Zone 3b

A thornless, seedless cultivar from NDSU selected for superior winter hardiness. Fine, lacey dark-green foliage turns yellow in fall. Select a protected planting site for best success.

## Juglans | Walnut

### BLACK WALNUT

*Juglans nigra*

MATURE SIZE: 45' x 30' (15 x 9 m) CROWN SHAPE: Oval to rounded  
 FALL FOLIAGE: Light-yellow EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ○ Zone 3

An attractive tree whose natural range reaches central Minnesota, it is adapted to well-drained, sheltered locations in the prairies. Large compound leaves and round edible nuts.

### BUTTERNUT

*Juglans cinerea*

MATURE SIZE: 45' x 30' (15 x 9 m) CROWN SHAPE: Broad globe-shaped  
 FALL FOLIAGE: Light-yellow EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ○ Zone 2b

Differs from Black Walnut in that it has oblong fruit, and bark that is lighter in colour and much smoother. Well adapted to well-drained prairie soils.

## Malus | Spire Series Ornamental Crabapple

This exciting new series began with a controlled cross between 'Thunderchild' and 'Wijcik' made by Dr. David Lane of the Summerland Research Station. Further hybridization at Jeffries Nurseries has led to the development of a collection of cultivars which combine the unique columnar form with disease resistant foliage and proven winter hardiness. In the prairie landscape, Spire crabapples make an excellent choice for a summer privacy screen.

### EMERALD SPIRE® ROSYBLOOM CRABAPPLE

*Malus x adstringens* 'Jefgreen'

MATURE SIZE: 20' x 8' (6 m x 2.5 m) CROWN SHAPE: Columnar  
 FLOWERS: Pink EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ○ Zone 3

A columnar selection related to 'Purple Spire'. Silver-green, disease-resistant foliage; abundant pink flowers in spring and red fruit in late summer. Introduced by Jeffries Nurseries. CPBR #4,684, USPP #23,863

### GREEN WALL® SPIRE FLOWERING CRABAPPLE

*Malus x* 'Jefwall'

MATURE SIZE: 20' x 6' (6 m x 2 m) CROWN SHAPE: Columnar  
 FLOWERS: White EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ○ Zone 2

This columnar cultivar offers outstanding glossy, green foliage and abundant white spring flowers. Tiny red fruit attract birds and provide winter landscape value. Introduced by Jeffries Nurseries. CPBRA# USPP #35,109.

### MIDNITE SPIRE® ROSYBLOOM CRABAPPLE

*Malus x adstringens* 'Jefnite'

MATURE SIZE: 20' x 6' (6 m x 2 m) CROWN SHAPE: Columnar  
 FLOWERS: Dark-Pink EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ○ Zone 2

The newest cultivar in the columnar Spire series, Midnite Spire offers outstanding glossy, purple foliage all summer long. Pink spring flowers give rise to medium-sized fruit. Introduced by Jeffries Nurseries. CPBRA# USPP #35,089.

### PURPLE SPIRE® ROSYBLOOM CRABAPPLE

*Malus x adstringens* 'Jefspire'

MATURE SIZE: 20' x 6' (6 m x 2 m) CROWN SHAPE: Columnar  
 FLOWERS: Rose-pink (few) EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ○ Zone 3

Purple Spire is outstanding for its compact, columnar form and showy purple foliage in late summer. A few pink flowers in spring are followed by purple fruit. Introduced by Jeffries and Bylands Nurseries.

## Malus | Ornamental Crabapple

### COURAGEOUS® ROSYBLOOM CRABAPPLE *Malus x adstringens 'Durlawrence'*

MATURE SIZE: 20' x 15' (6 m x 5 m) CROWN SHAPE: Rounded  
 FLOWERS: Pink EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ☉ Zone 2

This flowering tree produces masses of bright pink blooms that accent new bronze-red foliage in spring. Courageous is a seedless cultivar that rarely produces fruit. An excellent choice for smaller landscapes. Prairie Shade Nursery introduction.

### GLADIATOR® ROSYBLOOM CRABAPPLE *Malus x adstringens 'Durleo'*

MATURE SIZE: 20' x 9' (6 m x 3 m) CROWN SHAPE: Upright  
 FLOWERS: Pink EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ☉ Zone 2

An attractive rosybloom with glossy purple leaves, pink flowers, small purple ornamental fruit, and an upright crown form. Prairie Shade Nursery introduction. USPP #20,167

### ROYAL MIST® ROSYBLOOM CRABAPPLE *Malus x adstringens 'Jefmist'*

MATURE SIZE: 20' x 9' (6 m x 3 m) CROWN SHAPE: Upright  
 FLOWERS: Fuchsia-pink EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ☉ Zone 2

An upright Rosybloom resulting from a cross between 'Shaughnessy Cohen' and 'Thunderchild'. Outstanding deep-pink flowers in spring. Purple spring foliage turns bronzed-green in summer. Fruit fall is an issue so proper landscape location is important.

### SPRING SNOW FLOWERING CRABAPPLE *Malus baccata 'Spring Snow'*

MATURE SIZE: 25' x 20' (8 m x 6 m) CROWN SHAPE: Rounded  
 FLOWERS: White EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ☉ Zone 2

An attractive tree with fragrant, white flowers in the spring and glossy green foliage throughout the growing season. This cultivar does not produce fruit. Developed by Bruce Porter.

### STARLITE® FLOWERING CRABAPPLE *Malus baccata 'Jeflite'*

MATURE SIZE: 25' x 15' (8 m x 5 m) CROWN SHAPE: Upright  
 FLOWERS: White EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ☉ Zone 2

Derived from a cross between 'Spring Snow' and 'Rosthern', Starlite has upright branching. This cultivar also offers fragrant white flowers, glossy green foliage and tiny red fruit that are retained into winter. Excellent resistance to foliar diseases including apple scab.

### THUNDERCHILD ROSYBLOOM CRABAPPLE *Malus x adstringens 'Thunderchild'*

MATURE SIZE: 20' x 15' (6 m x 5 m) CROWN SHAPE: Upright, spreading  
 FLOWERS: Rose-pink EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ☉ Zone 2

A flowering crabapple with oval crown and leaves that turn deep purple during the growing season. Small red fruit in late summer. Resistant to fireblight. Developed by Percy Wright.

## Ostrya | Ironwood

### IRONWOOD *Ostrya virginiana*

MATURE SIZE: 30' x 20' (10 x 6 m) CROWN SHAPE: Oval to rounded  
 FALL FOLIAGE: Golden-yellow EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ☉ Zone 3

A slow-growing, medium-sized tree with slender spreading branches. Hop-like fruits add interest in late summer. Leaves persist into winter. Minnesota seed source.

## Phellodendron | Amur Cork Tree

### AMUR CORK TREE *Phellodendron amurense*

MATURE SIZE: 40' x 30' (13 x 10 m) CROWN SHAPE: Broad, spreading  
 FALL FOLIAGE: Golden-yellow EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ☉ Zone 3

Unique medium-sized shade tree with compound leaves and spongy bark. Tolerates urban stresses and should be considered as a suitable substitute for ash species.

## Populus | Poplar / Aspen

### ASSINIBOINE HYBRID POPLAR

*Populus x 'Assiniboine'*

MATURE SIZE: 50' x 15' (15 x 5 m)  
FALL FOLIAGE: Yellow

CROWN SHAPE: Semi-upright  
EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ○ Zone 2

This seedless clone has a rapid growth rate and a fairly narrow crown. It is resistant to stem canker, leaf rust and poplar bud gall mite.

### BALSAM POPLAR

*Populus balsamea*

MATURE SIZE: 50' x 25' (15 x 8 m)  
FALL FOLIAGE: Yellow

CROWN SHAPE: Upright  
EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ○ Zone 1

Native tree found across Canada. Leaves are oval-shaped leaves and glossy in appearance.

### GRANDMONT® LARGE-TOOTHED ASPEN HYBRID *P. grandidentata* 'Jefmont'



MATURE SIZE: 40' x 20' (12 m x 6 m)  
FALL FOLIAGE: Yellow

CROWN SHAPE: Open, upright

### TRIUMPH ELM: THE JOURNEY TO MANITOBA

The story of Triumph elm begins at Morton Arboretum in Chicago, Illinois. In the 1980's George Ware made controlled crosses between elm cultivars Accolade™ and Vanguard™ (see photo on top right) resulting in a seedling known as Triumph elm. The first grafting of Triumph elm was carried out at J. Frank Schmidt Nursery in 1994.

In 2006, Jeffries Nurseries received special permission from CFIA to import new cultivars of DED-resistant elm from the United States. We planted an elm hardiness trial in April 2006 with the following test cultivars: 'Accolade', 'Cathedral', 'Triumph' and 'Vanguard'; as well as 'Brandon' and 'Discovery' as controls. Our evaluations showed that 'Triumph' possessed excellent winter hardiness, rapid growth rate and the vase-like habit needed for an American elm replacement (see photo on bottom right).

Today, Triumph elm is grown by many nurseries in western Canada and has been planted as a street tree in communities across the prairies. It represents a breakthrough in the battle against DED and provides a quality, durable elm cultivar that thrives under urban conditions.

**TIPS FOR MAINTAINING TOP-GRAFTS & TREE-FORMED SHRUBS**

The heads of top-grafted shrubs should be lightly pruned on an annual basis with a focus on keeping the top-graft rounded and neat.

Pruning the top-graft must be done with recognition of its effect on flower development. In the case of lilac, it is best to prune immediately after flowering so as to allow next years blooms to develop.

It is also critical to remove leafy shoots that arise from along the inter-stem and at its base. These sprouts and suckers can quickly overpower the top-grafted shrub (see adjacent photo), destroying the beauty of the grafted cultivar.

An alternative to top-grafted shrubs are tree-formed shrubs. Tree-formed shrubs are produced by training up and retaining a single dominant stem for shrub cultivars. With a tree-formed shrub there is still the need for removing lateral sprouts and basal shoots.

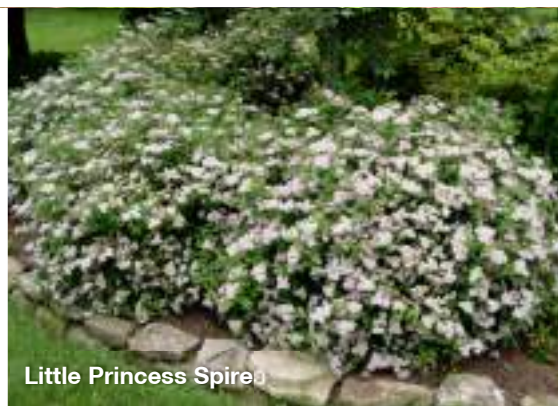

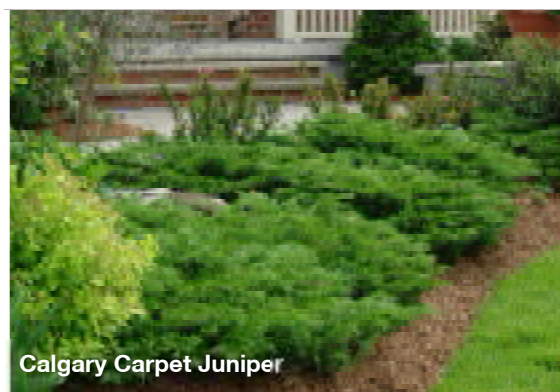

## TIPS FOR OVERWINTERING EVERGREENS

- Evergreens should receive abundant moisture in fall before freeze up. Remember that evergreens lose water from their foliage all winter, but are unable to take up replacement moisture from the frozen soil.
- Rather than wrapping an evergreen to protect it from winter sun and drying winds, install a burlap wall on either side of the plant. Ensure adequate air circulation; the burlap should not touch the foliage.
- Broad-leaved evergreen species such as Boxwood (*Buxus*) are subject to winter-kill in zones 2 and 3. Plant in a sheltered, partially shaded area that receives ample, lasting snow cover.

## POLLINATION REQUIRED

All fruit tree and small fruit varieties that require a different pollinizer cultivar have been marked with this symbol.

Cross pollination refers to the transfer of pollen between flowers of genetically-distinct plants. Pollinators, usually insects, are vectors for pollen movement

For apples and pears, two different cultivars must be growing in close proximity for successful fruit production. Plums and apricots have strong preferences for certain pollinizers. Pure wild plums or the cultivar 'Toka' are the best pollinizers for hybrid plums.

#### What is a superfruit?

The term "superfruit" is used to describe a class of fruits that have exceptionally high nutrient densities and antioxidant levels.

Superfruits for the prairie region include saskatoons, chokeberry, haskap, black currant, blueberry and grape.



## Fragaria | Strawberry

**Day Neutral:** Also known as “ever-bearing”, these varieties produce fruit throughout the growing season. They are self-fruitful and do not require cross pollination.

## Rubus | Red Raspberry

### Summer Bearing - Floricane (produce fruit on last season's canes)

**Boyne** - early-season raspberry with medium acid and aromatic flavor; excellent hardiness.

**SK Red Bounty** - Superior to Boyne for yield and winter hardiness with outstanding flavor.

**SK Red Mammoth** - Large fruit produced over a long season. University of Saskatchewan introduction.

**Souris** - an improved selection of 'Boyne' because it is better tasting, a heavier producer of fruit and has better spider mite resistance. Morden Research Station introduction.

### Fall Bearing - Primocane (produce fruit on current season's canes)

**Double Delight** - this hardy raspberry has large fruit with a delicious, sweet tangy taste. The height of this upright plant exceeds 4 feet. Morden Research Station introduction.

**Red River** - another delicious tasting raspberry that is slightly smaller than 'Double Delight'. Cascading plant form; height does not exceed 3 feet. Morden Research Station introduction.

## Vaccinium | Blueberry

Blueberries require an acidic soil with pH in the range of 4.5 to 5.5 for best results. Prairie soils can be amended with peat to lower pH, but poorly-drained soils should be avoided.

### CHIPPEWA BLUEBERRY

*Vaccinium x 'Chippewa'*

MATURE HEIGHT: 3 - 4 Feet (1.25 m)  
 FRUIT SIZE: 1 cm

FRUIT COLOUR: Dark-blue  
 EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ☉ ● Zone 3

Chippewa has large dark blue fruit that ripens a week earlier than cultivar Northblue.

### NORTHCOUNTRY BLUEBERRY

*Vaccinium x 'Northcountry'*

MATURE HEIGHT: 3 - 4 Feet (1.25 m)  
 FRUIT SIZE: 0.75 cm

FRUIT COLOUR: Dark-blue  
 EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ☉ ● Zone 3

The same exceptional flavor of a wild blueberry, early-mid season ripening.

### NORTHLAND BLUEBERRY

*Vaccinium x 'Northland'*

MATURE HEIGHT: 3 - 4 Feet (1.25 m)  
 FRUIT SIZE: 0.75 cm

FRUIT COLOUR: Dark-blue  
 EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ☉ ● Zone 3

Small, dark blue fruit with a wild berry flavour. University of Minnesota introduction.

### NORTHSKY BLUEBERRY

*Vaccinium x 'Northsky'*

MATURE HEIGHT: 12-18 Inches (0.3 m)  
 FRUIT SIZE: 1 cm

FRUIT COLOUR: Sky-blue  
 EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ☉ ● Zone 3

A producer of sky blue fruit with a sweet, mild flavour. University of Minnesota introduction.

## Vitis | Grape

### BETA GRAPE

*Vitis x 'Beta'*

MATURE HEIGHT: Climb to 6 Feet (2 m)  
 FRUIT SIZE: Clusters (1 cm)

FRUIT COLOUR: Blue-purple  
 EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ☉ ● Zone 3

A hybrid between Native Grape and the variety 'Concord'. Fruit is excellent for juice or jelly.

### BLUEBELL GRAPE

*Vitis x 'Bluebell'*

MATURE HEIGHT: Climb to 6 Feet (2 m)  
 FRUIT SIZE: Clusters (1 cm)

FRUIT COLOUR: Blue  
 EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ☉ ● Zone 3

Resembles 'Concord' in size and colour but with more tender skin and greater hardiness. Fruit is excellent for juice and jelly. University of Minnesota introduction.

### BRIANNA GRAPE

*Vitis x 'Brianna'*

MATURE HEIGHT: Climb to 6 Feet (2 m)  
 FRUIT SIZE: Clusters (1 cm)

FRUIT COLOUR: White  
 EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ☉ ● Zone 3

Grapes are greenish gold to gold when fully ripe in early to mid September. Can be used for wine making and also beautiful as a table grape; delicious eaten fresh

### KAY GRAY GRAPE

*Vitis x 'Kay Gray'*

MATURE HEIGHT: Climb to 6 Feet (2 m)  
 FRUIT SIZE: Clusters (1 cm)

FRUIT COLOUR: White  
 EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ☉ ● Zone 3

A hardy white grape for fresh eating or wine making. Elmer Swenson introduction.

### LOUISE SWENSON GRAPE

*Vitis x 'Louise Swenson'*

MATURE HEIGHT: Climb to 6 Feet (2 m)  
 FRUIT SIZE: Clusters (1 cm)

FRUIT COLOUR: White  
 EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ☉ ● Zone 3

A hardy white grape for fresh eating or wine making. Elmer Swenson introduction.

### VALIANT GRAPE

*Vitis x 'Valiant'*

MATURE HEIGHT: Climb to 8 Feet (2.5 m)  
 FRUIT SIZE: Clusters (1 cm)

FRUIT COLOUR: Blue-purple  
 EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ☉ ● Zone 2

This prolific producer offers earlier fruit maturity and superior winter hardiness than all others. Free of adstringency and excellent for wine, juice and jelly. SDSU introduction.
