

Malus - Apple

BATTLEFORD APPLE

Malus x 'Battleford'

PARENTAGE: Russian seedling FRUIT COLOUR: Red over pale yellow
FRUIT SIZE: 6 - 7.5 cm HARDINESS: Zone 2

Large fruit, striped red over light yellow. Excellent for cooking. Matures in mid-September. Tree is very cold hardy. Introduced by Boughen Nursery, Valley River, Manitoba in 1934.

GEMINI® APPLE

Malus x 'Jefcoutts'

PARENTAGE: Norland x Haralson FRUIT COLOUR: Red over pale yellow
FRUIT SIZE: 7 - 8 cm HARDINESS: Zone 2

A crisp, juicy and medium sweet apple, that is best eaten fresh. Medium to large apples are ripe in late August and store well until the New Year. Developed by Art Coutts of Unity, SK.

GOODLAND APPLE

Malus x 'Goodland'

PARENTAGE: Patten Greening seedling FRUIT COLOUR: Green with red blush
FRUIT SIZE: 6 - 8 cm HARDINESS: Zone 3

Large apple, creamy yellow with a splash of red, flesh is white. Excellent for eating fresh and cooking. Fruit ripens in mid-September and stores well. Morden Research Stn. introduction.

HONEYCRISP APPLE

Malus x 'Honeycrisp'

PARENTAGE: Macoun x Honeygold FRUIT COLOUR: Red over yellow
FRUIT SIZE: 7 - 8 cm HARDINESS: Zone 4

Medium to large-sized apple, with exceptionally crisp and juicy texture. Outstanding flavor and texture can be maintained in storage for 6 months. Matures in late September.

NORKENT APPLE

Malus x 'Norkent'

PARENTAGE: Haralson x Rescue FRUIT COLOUR: Red over pale yellow
FRUIT SIZE: 7 - 8 cm HARDINESS: Zone 2

Fruit has a distinct apple/pear taste similar to 'Golden Delicious'. Fruit matures in late August.

ODYSSEY® APPLE

Malus x 'Jefsey'

PARENTAGE: Unknown FRUIT COLOUR: Red blush on yellow
FRUIT SIZE: 7 - 8 cm HARDINESS: Zone 3

Odyssey boasts a sweet flavour comparable to the 'Gala' apple. The fruit ripens in mid-September and stores well. Introduced by Jeffries Nurseries.

PRAIRIE MAGIC® APPLE

Malus x 'Jefdale'

PARENTAGE: Goodland x Mantet FRUIT COLOUR: Red blush on yellow
FRUIT SIZE: 7 - 8 cm HARDINESS: Zone 3

The medium to large-sized fruit matures in mid-September and is crisp and delicious. Developed by Wilfred Drysdale of Neepawa, Manitoba and introduced by Jeffries Nurseries.

RED GEMINI APPLE

Malus x 'Jefcoutts2'

PARENTAGE: Unknown FRUIT COLOUR: Red
FRUIT SIZE: 7 - 8 cm HARDINESS: Zone 2

New listing for 2018. Medium to large apples are ripe in late August and store well until the New Year. Developed by Art Coutts of Unity, SK.

RED SPARKLE APPLE

Malus x 'Red Sparkle'

PARENTAGE: Trail x McIntosh FRUIT COLOUR: Dark red over green
FRUIT SIZE: 6 - 7.5 cm HARDINESS: Zone 3

A medium sized fruit, with a nutty/fruity taste. Apples matures in early September and is an excellent dessert apple.

SEPTEMBER RUBY APPLE

Malus x 'September Ruby'

PARENTAGE: Rescue x Haralson FRUIT COLOUR: Dark red
FRUIT SIZE: 6 - 7 cm HARDINESS: Zone 2

Medium sized fruit and light green flesh colour. Excellent eating fresh and in cooking. This vigorous grower ripens in early September and stores well.

WINTER CHEEKS APPLE

Malus x 'Winter Cheeks'

PARENTAGE: Unknown FRUIT COLOUR: Red over pale yellow
FRUIT SIZE: 6 - 7.5 cm HARDINESS: Zone 3

A medium-sized, crisp, eating apple that matures in early September. Excellent eating fresh and in cooking.

DOLGO CRABAPPLE

Malus x 'Dolgo'



PARENTAGE:	Russian seedling	FRUIT COLOUR:	Dark red
FRUIT SIZE:	2 - 3 cm	HARDINESS:	Zone 2

An edible crabapple with many ornamental features. Well known for its showy white blooms in spring followed by brilliant crimson fruit.

Malus - Applecrab

KERR APPLECRAB

Malus x 'Kerr'



PARENTAGE:	Dolgo x Haralson	FRUIT COLOUR:	Dark purple-red
FRUIT SIZE:	4 - 5 cm	HARDINESS:	Zone 2

Good for eating fresh, canning, jelly or juice. Ripens in late September and stores well. Resistant to fireblight. Developed at the Morden Research Station in 1952.

RESCUE APPLECRAB

Malus x 'Rescue'



PARENTAGE:	Blushed Calville OP	FRUIT COLOUR:	Yellow, red stripes
FRUIT SIZE:	3 - 4 cm	HARDINESS:	Zone 2

Small fruit is very sweet for eating fresh and good for canning. Ripens in late August. The tree is very productive. Developed at the research station in Scott, Saskatchewan in 1936.

Dwarf Odyssey Apple

These prairie apple cultivars are grown on Bud 9 dwarfing rootstock. Mature plants will be approximately 50% smaller in size than apple trees growing on standard rootstock. Fruit production on dwarfing rootstock can be up to 2 years earlier than apple trees on a standard rootstock.

Prunus - Apricot

Due to their early bloom time, apricot blossoms are susceptible to spring frost damage. Planting apricot trees in a site with limited afternoon heating (e.g. east side of an evergreen shelterbelt) will postpone flowering and increase the probability of fruit set.

DEBBIES GOLD APRICOT

Prunus x 'Debbies Gold'



PARENTAGE:	Manchurian seedling	FRUIT COLOUR:	Golden yellow
FRUIT SIZE:	3 - 4 cm	HARDINESS:	Zone 3

Produces freestone, orange-yellow fruit that are slightly sweeter than Westcot. Excellent for eating fresh or canning. Blooms several days later than other cultivars.

MANCHURIAN STRAIN APRICOT

Prunus manschurica



PARENTAGE:	Seedling	FRUIT COLOUR:	Golden yellow
FRUIT SIZE:	3 - 4 cm	HARDINESS:	Zone 3

A cold hardy seedling strain grown from local seed. Suitable pollinator for apricot cultivars.

WESTCOT APRICOT

Prunus x 'Westcot'



PARENTAGE:	Scout x McClure	FRUIT COLOUR:	Golden yellow
FRUIT SIZE:	3.5 - 4.5 cm	HARDINESS:	Zone 3

This prairie cultivar has hardy flower buds and produces large, golden, freestone fruit. Excellent for eating fresh or canning. Introduced by Morden Research Station in 1982.



POLLINATION REQUIRED

All fruit tree and small fruit varieties that require a different pollinizer cultivar have been marked with this symbol.

Cross pollination refers to the transfer of pollen between flowers of genetically-distinct plants. Pollinators, usually insects, are vectors for pollen movement

For apples and pears, two different cultivars must be growing in close proximity for successful fruit production. Plums and apricots have strong preferences for certain pollinizers. Pure wild plums or the cultivar Toka are the best pollinizers for hybrid plums.

Prunus - Tree-Form Tart Cherry

Carmine Jewel / Crimson Passion / Cupid / Juliet / Romeo / Valentine

These sour cherry cultivars are grown as small trees. See cultivar descriptions on page 56.

Prunus - Cherry Plum

MUSTANG CHERRY PLUM

Prunus x 'Jefchum'



PARENTAGE: Complex hybrid
FRUIT SIZE: 2.5 - 3 cm

FRUIT COLOUR: Purple
HARDINESS: Zone 3

Small tree with very fragrant, white blossoms in spring. Produces purple fruit with purple flesh in mid August. Useful pollinizer for Sapalta. Jeffries Nurseries introduction.

SAPALTA CHERRY PLUM

Prunus x 'Sapalta'



PARENTAGE: Seedling of 'Sapa'
FRUIT SIZE: 2.5 - 3 cm

FRUIT COLOUR: Purple
HARDINESS: Zone 3

Small tree with very fragrant, white blossoms in spring. A seedling of 'Sapa' with medium-sized purple fruit in mid August. Canadian introduction.

Prunus - Plum

BROOKGOLD JAPANESE PLUM

Prunus x 'Brookgold'



PARENTAGE: *Prunus salicina* seedling
FRUIT SIZE: 3 - 4 cm

FRUIT COLOUR: Golden yellow
HARDINESS: Zone 2

Small tree with fragrant, white blossoms in spring. Medium-sized plum; golden-yellow, free-stone fruit with tender skin. Good for eating fresh or cooking. Ripens early making it a good choice for colder climates. Pollinate with Brookred.

BROOKRED HYBRID PLUM

Prunus x 'Brookred'



PARENTAGE: *P. nigra x P. salicina*
FRUIT SIZE: 3 - 4 cm

FRUIT COLOUR: Dark red
HARDINESS: Zone 2

Small tree with fragrant, white blossoms in spring. Produces medium-sized, dark red plums that ripen in late August. Pollinate with Brookgold.

MOUNT ROYAL EUROPEAN PLUM



Prunus x 'Mount Royal'

PARENTAGE: *P. domestica*
FRUIT SIZE: 4 cm

FRUIT COLOUR: Blue
HARDINESS: Zone 3/4

New listing for 2018. White blossoms in spring are followed by blue fruit with yellow flesh that is delicious. Self-pollinated. Requires a well-drained, sheltered site in the prairies.

PEMBINA HYBRID PLUM

Prunus x 'Pembina'



PARENTAGE: *P. nigra x P. sal. 'Red June'*
FRUIT SIZE: 4 - 5 cm

FRUIT COLOUR: Red with blue hue
HARDINESS: Zone 3

Small tree with fragrant, white blossoms in spring. Large fruit has dark red, firm skin with yellow flesh that is delicious. The finest plum that can be grown on the prairies.

TOKA HYBRID PLUM

Prunus x 'Toka'



PARENTAGE: *P. americana x P. simonii*
FRUIT SIZE: 3 - 4 cm

FRUIT COLOUR: Dark red
HARDINESS: Zone 3

Small tree with fragrant, white blossoms in spring. An excellent pollinizer that produces medium sized, rich flavored fruit. Fruit ripens in late-August.

Pyrus - Pear

EARLY GOLD PEAR

Pyrus x 'Jefgold'



PARENTAGE: Seedling of 'Ure'
FRUIT SIZE: 5 cm

FRUIT COLOUR: Golden
HARDINESS: Zone 2

A seedling of 'Ure' with improved vigour, chlorosis resistance and cold hardiness. Fruit is similar in taste to 'Ure' but matures 10 to 14 days earlier. A Jeffries Nurseries introduction.



Amelanchier - Saskatoon

A native shrub on the prairies producing unique, tasty fruit. Self-pollinating.

HONEYWOOD SASKATOON *Amelanchier alnifolia* 'Honeywood'

MATURE HEIGHT: 15 Feet (5 m) FRUIT COLOUR: Purple-blue
 FRUIT SIZE: 16 mm EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ○ Zone 2

A selection that has large fruit of excellent quality. Flowers 4-8 days later than other cultivars.

MARTIN SASKATOON *Amelanchier alnifolia* 'Martin'

MATURE HEIGHT: 15 Feet (5 m) FRUIT COLOUR: Purple-blue
 FRUIT SIZE: 17 mm EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ○ Zone 2

A great tasting saskatoon with more uniform ripening of the berries. This seedling of 'Thiessen' was selected by Dieter Martin of Langham, Saskatchewan.

NORTHLINE SASKATOON *Amelanchier alnifolia* 'Northline'

MATURE HEIGHT: 10 Feet (3 m) FRUIT COLOUR: Purple-blue
 FRUIT SIZE: 16 mm EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ○ Zone 2

A seedling strain grown for its excellent flavour and outstanding productivity.

PARKHILL SASKATOON *Amelanchier alnifolia* 'Parkhill'

MATURE HEIGHT: 5 Feet (1.5 m) FRUIT COLOUR: Purple-blue
 FRUIT SIZE: 16 mm EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ○ Zone 2

A dwarf cultivar grown for fruit of mild flavour, even ripening, and ornamental characteristics. Resistant to Entomosporium leaf and berry spot.

SMOKY SASKATOON *Amelanchier alnifolia* 'Smoky'

MATURE HEIGHT: 12 Feet (4 m) FRUIT COLOUR: Purple-blue
 FRUIT SIZE: 16 mm EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ○ Zone 2

A large fruited selection from Alberta, known for excellent flavour and yield.

THIESSEN SASKATOON *Amelanchier alnifolia* 'Thiessen'

MATURE HEIGHT: 15 Feet (5 m) FRUIT COLOUR: Purple-blue
 FRUIT SIZE: 17 mm EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ○ Zone 2

A columnar plant that produces a large fruit of outstanding quality. Uneven fruit ripening characteristic. Selected near Hepburn, Saskatchewan.

Aronia - Black Chokeberry

VIKING ARONIA *Aronia melanocarpa* 'Viking'

MATURE HEIGHT: 6 Feet (2 m) FRUIT COLOUR: Black
 FRUIT SIZE: 16 mm EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ○ Zone 3

Developed in Eastern Europe, this "Superfruit" has outstanding levels of vitamins and antioxidants. Attractive white flowers in late spring give rise to large clusters of black fruit.

Asparagus

JERSEY GIANT ASPARAGUS *Asparagus* 'Jersey Giant'

A male hybrid that yields 2-4 times more spears than female asparagus. Resistant to rust and tolerant of fusarium and crown rot.

MILLENIUM ASPARAGUS *Asparagus* 'Millenium'

A male asparagus hybrid from the University of Guelph noted for rust tolerance, high yield and excellent cold hardiness.

Fragaria - Strawberry

Day Neutral: These varieties produce fruit throughout the growing season.

Cultivar:	Description:
Tribute	The fruit is very sweet, firm and has an excellent flavour.
Seascape	Another excellent tasting strawberry that has very large berry size.

June Bearing: These varieties produce fruit during a 2-3 week period in spring.

Cavendish	Ripens in early midseason, yielding large, bright red, flavorful berries.
Kent	The fruit is produced in the mid-season and is of high quality and yield

Hippophae - Sea Buckthorn

ASKOLA SEA BUCKTHORN *Hippophae rhamnoides* 'Askola'

MATURE HEIGHT: 6 Feet (2 m) FRUIT COLOUR: Orange
 FRUIT SIZE: 1 cm EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ○ Zone 2
 Female shrub with silvery foliage, yellow flowers and orange fruit. Drought and salt tolerant.

LEIKORA SEA BUCKTHORN *Hippophae rhamnoides* 'Leikora'

MATURE HEIGHT: 6 Feet (2 m) FRUIT COLOUR: None
 FRUIT SIZE: 1 cm EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ○ Zone 2
 Female shrub with silvery foliage, yellow flowers and orange fruit.

ORANGE SEPTEMBER SEA BUCKTHORN *H. rhamnoides* 'Orange September'

MATURE HEIGHT: 6 Feet (2 m) FRUIT COLOUR: None
 FRUIT SIZE: 1 cm EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ○ Zone 2
New listing for 2018. Female shrub with silvery foliage, yellow flowers and orange fruit with higher sugar content. AAFC introduction.

POLLMIX SEA BUCKTHORN *Hippophae rhamnoides* 'Pollmix'

MATURE HEIGHT: 6 Feet (2 m) FRUIT COLOUR: None
 FRUIT SIZE: None EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ○ Zone 2
 Male shrub with silvery foliage and yellow flowers. Serves as a pollinizer for Askola & Leikora.

Lonicera - Honeyberry (Haskap)

Honeyberries are an exciting addition to the prairie fruit palette. With flower buds that can withstand -7 C without damage and ripe fruit by mid to late June, they are truly unique.

AURORA HONEYBERRY *Lonicera caerulea* 'Aurora'

MATURE HEIGHT: 5 - 7 Feet (2.25 m) FRUIT COLOUR: Blue with blush
 FRUIT SIZE: 2.2 grams EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ○ Zone 2
 This recent introduction from the University of Saskatchewan features fruit that is large and sweeter than Borealis. Fruit has a pointed pear shape and matures in late June.

BERRY BLUE HONEYBERRY *Lonicera caerulea* 'Berry Blue'

MATURE HEIGHT: 4 - 5 Feet (1.5 m) FRUIT COLOUR: Blue with blush
 FRUIT SIZE: 1 gram EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ○ Zone 2
 The most vigorous honeyberry variety. Excellent pollinizer for other varieties.

BLUE BELLE HONEYBERRY *Lonicera caerulea* 'Blue Belle'

MATURE HEIGHT: 3 - 4 Feet (1.25 m) FRUIT COLOUR: Blue with blush
 FRUIT SIZE: 1 gram EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ○ Zone 2
 A moderately vigorous selection which is shorter than Berry Blue. Good pollinizer.

BOREAL BLIZZARD HONEYBERRY *Lonicera caerulea* 'Boreal Blizzard'

MATURE HEIGHT: 6 - 8 Feet (2.5 m) FRUIT COLOUR: Blue with blush
 FRUIT SIZE: 2.8 grams EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ○ Zone 2
New listing for 2018. The "game changer" in haskap production with the largest, sweetest fruit of any cultivar. Matures in early to mid July. University of Saskatchewan introduction.

BOREALIS HONEYBERRY *Lonicera caerulea* 'Borealis'

MATURE HEIGHT: 4 - 5 Feet (1.5 m) FRUIT COLOUR: Blue with blush
 FRUIT SIZE: 1.6 grams EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ○ Zone 2
 Recommended pollinizer for 'Aurora'. University of Saskatchewan introduction.

CINDERELLA HONEYBERRY *Lonicera caerulea* 'Cinderella'

MATURE HEIGHT: 3 - 4 Feet (1.25 m) FRUIT COLOUR: Blue with blush
 FRUIT SIZE: 1 gram EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ○ Zone 2
 Ideal size fruiting shrub for homeowners. It's fruit is considered the best for fresh eating.

BOREALIS / CINDERELLA HONEYBERRY *Lonicera caerulea* 'Combination'

MATURE HEIGHT: 3 - 4 Feet (1.25 m) FRUIT COLOUR: Blue with blush
 FRUIT SIZE: 1.6 gram EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ○ Zone 2
 For those with limited space. A combination of two exceptional varieties in a single pot.

INDIGO GEM HONEYBERRY (9-15)	<i>Lonicera caerulea</i> 'Indigo Gem'
MATURE HEIGHT: 3 - 4 Feet (1.25 m)	FRUIT COLOUR: Blue with blush
FRUIT SIZE: 1.3 grams	EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ○ Zone 2

Produces tasty fruit with a chewy texture. University of Saskatchewan introduction.

INDIGO YUM HONEYBERRY (9-92)	<i>Lonicera caerulea</i> 'Indigo Yum'
MATURE HEIGHT: 3 - 4 Feet (1.25 m)	FRUIT COLOUR: Blue with blush
FRUIT SIZE: 1.3 grams	EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ○ Zone 2

Fruit similar to 'Tundra' but more tangy in taste. University of Saskatchewan introduction.

TUNDRA HONEYBERRY	<i>Lonicera caerulea</i> 'Tundra'
MATURE HEIGHT: 4 - 5 Feet (1.5 m)	FRUIT COLOUR: Blue with blush

Tundra produces firm fruit that do not bleed from the stem when picked. It is suitable for mechanized harvest. Matures in mid to late June. University of Saskatchewan introduction.

A cross between the Tart cherry and Mongolian cherry. Fruit makes an excellent topping, jam, jelly, juice and pie filling. Self-pollinating. University of Saskatchewan introduction.

CRIMSON PASSION TART CHERRY	<i>P. x kerrasis</i> 'Crimson Passion'
MATURE HEIGHT: 4 - 5 Feet (1.5 m)	FRUIT COLOUR: Dark red
FRUIT SIZE: 3 - 4 cm (5.8 grams)	EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ○ Zone 2

Highest sugar content. Excellent fresh eating cherry. Fruit size is large at 5.8 grams per fruit. Self-pollinating. University of Saskatchewan introduction. Non-suckering.

Large fruit has good flavour; excellent for fresh eating or processing. Blooms one week later than other Saskatchewan cherries. Self-pollinating. University of Saskatchewan introduction.

JULIET TART CHERRY	<i>Prunus x kerrasis</i> 'Juliet'
MATURE HEIGHT: 6 - 8 Feet (2.5 m)	FRUIT COLOUR: Dark red
FRUIT SIZE: 2 - 3 cm (4.5 grams)	EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ○ Zone 2

Excellent fresh eating cherry. Fruit has high sugar content. Plant has moderate vigor with few suckers. Self-pollinating. University of Saskatchewan introduction.

ROMEO TART CHERRY	<i>Prunus x kerrasis</i> 'Romeo'
MATURE HEIGHT: 6 - 8 Feet (2.5 m)	FRUIT COLOUR: Dark red
FRUIT SIZE: 2 - 3 cm (4 grams)	EXPOSURE / HARDINESS: ○ Zone 2

Flavourful fruit is good for eating and processing. University of Saskatchewan introduction.

VALENTINE TART CHERRY	<i>Prunus x kerrasis</i> 'Valentine'

Rubus - Red Raspberry

Summer Bearing - Floricane (produce fruit on last season's canes)

Boyne - an early-season raspberry with medium acid and aromatic flavor; excellent cold hardiness.

SK Red Bounty - Superior to Boyne for yield and winter hardiness with outstanding flavor.

SK Red Mammoth - Large fruit produced over a long season. University of Saskatchewan introduction.

Souris - an improved selection of 'Boyne' because it is better tasting, a heavier producer of fruit and has better spider mite resistance. Morden Research Station introduction.

Fall Bearing - Primocane (produce fruit on current season's canes)

Double Delight - this hardy raspberry has large fruit with a delicious, sweet tangy taste. The height of this upright plant exceeds 4 feet. Morden Research Station introduction.

Red River - another delicious tasting raspberry that is slightly smaller than 'Double Delight'. Cascading plant form; the height does not exceed 3 feet. Morden Research Station introduction.

Rubus - Black Raspberry

Wyoming - A hardy disease-resistant variety producing black fruit with great aroma and flavor.

Honey Queen - *New listing for 2018.* this raspberry offers a sweet honey-like flavour and unique yellow colour. Honey Queen was developed in Rocky Mountain House by Robert Erskin and is very hardy.

Vaccinium - Blueberry

Blueberries require an acidic soil with pH in the range of 4.5 to 5.5 for best results. Prairie soils can be amended with peat to lower pH, but poorly-drained soils should be avoided.

Chippewa Blueberry *Vaccinium x 'Chippewa'*

Chippewa has large dark blue fruit that ripens a week earlier than cultivar Northblue.

Vitis - Grape

BLUEBELL GRAPE *Vitis x 'Bluebell'*

Resembles 'Concord' in size and colour but with more tender skin and greater hardiness. Fruit is excellent for juice and jelly. University of Minnesota introduction.

BRIANNA GRAPE *Vitis x 'Brianna'*

Grapes are greenish gold to gold when fully ripe in early to mid September. Can be used for wine making and also beautiful as a table grape; delicious eaten fresh

FRONTENAC GRAPE *Vitis x 'Frontenac'*

A red wine grape of very good quality introduced by the University of Minnesota in 1996. Produces large clusters of dark blue fruit. Good resistance to powdery mildew.

LOUISE SWENSON GRAPE *Vitis x 'Louise Swenson'*

A hardy white grape for fresh eating or wine making. Small clusters of medium berries are mature in mid-September. Elmer Swenson introduction.

MARECHAE FUCH GRAPE *Vitis x 'Marechael Foch'*

FRUIT SIZE:	Clusters (1 cm)	EXPOSURE / HARDINESS:	☉ ● Zone 4

One of the hardiest French hybrids. A red wine grape with early-ripening fruit. Resistant to common grape diseases. Requires winter protection in zones 2 and 3.

VALIANT GRAPE *Vitis x 'Valiant'*

FRUIT SIZE:	Clusters (1 cm)	EXPOSURE / HARDINESS:	☉ ● Zone 2

This prolific producer offers earlier fruit maturity and superior winter hardiness than all others. Blue fruit is free of astringency and excellent for wine, juice and jelly. SDSU introduction.
