## **Del Norte Healthcare District**



Concerns have been raised regarding whether or not non-profit hospitals are meeting their mission to provide charity care in exchange for their tax exemptions. A recent study published in *Health Affairs* indicates that non-profit hospitals are spending less on charity care than for-profit hospitals. Specifically, it was found that for every \$100.00 in total spending, nonprofit hospitals provided \$2.30 in charity care; for-profit hospitals provided \$3.80; and government-run hospitals provided \$4.10.

As a result of Sutter Coast Hospital's "non-profit" tax exemption, Del Norte County loses hundreds of thousands of dollars in tax revenue every year. The Del Norte County Tax Assessor's Office reported to the Healthcare District that Sutter Coast Hospital's property is valued at approximately \$53,561,286.00. If Sutter Coast did not have a "charity" tax exemption, it would owe Del Norte County 1% of its property value every year, plus the bond rate. Based on that 1% alone, Del Norte County is losing approximately \$535,613.00 per year in property taxes. To maintain public services, that \$535,613.00 that Sutter does not pay in taxes every year must be paid by someone else - individuals, homeowners, families, and businesses.
