**WAITING LIST FOR COOPER GREEN HOMES  
OPENING MID-APRIL**

***BIRMINGHAM, AL, April 8, 2026*** – The Housing Authority of the Birmingham District (HABD) will open its project-based waiting list and begin accepting applications for Cooper Green Homes located at 1501 Arthur Shores Drive SW, in Birmingham. The upcoming announcement applies to three (3) bedroom, four (4) bedroom, and five (5) bedroom units only. **Applications will be accepted from Friday, April 17, 2026, beginning at 10:00 AM and closing on Friday, April 24, 2026, at 7:59 AM.**

Please note, applications must be postmarked by April 24, 2026, in order to be added to the waiting list. Paper applications cannot be hand delivered.

Under the Project-Based Housing Choice Voucher Program, the rental assistance is tied to the unit and is not portable like the regular “tenant” based Housing Choice Voucher Program. HABD will refer families from the project-based waiting list to Cooper Green to fill vacancies.

Since the assistance is tied to the unit, a family who moves from the project-based unit may not have any right to continued housing assistance like the regular tenant-based Housing Choice Voucher Program.
