Okay, just a few comments on that one. helping the poor, inner city and indigenous populations. How do we know a person is poor, that makes a person may think that they're very wealthy when they've got \$10 in their pocket. And for those who have more than that, then they're not so special, but a person who we determined is poor. It's in my mind is not really an honor to that person, calling them poor and they may have a very loving relationship and full of love at that. that that means that they're not poor, the financial part of it could be a problem. So what I like to look at is everybody has their own set of circumstances in their financial, financially in their lives. And we're here to help everybody, not just the poor, or the inner city or indigenous people, or any other group of people called middle class, lower class will ever class. Ring the bell, and let's get out of here class. Well, I'm talking about here is that we're, we're here for everybody. And we'll find that the people who are wealthy will also be come beneficiaries. And because there's no reason to turn down 26,000 or \$20,000 a month. So anybody is going to do everybody can do this. Anybody can do this. And I'd like to get away from the idea that we are just working to help the poor. Because if we just help the poor, then they're, then they're getting singled out. And that's not appropriate. Why would you turn, why would you not let somebody in the middle class, who's having struggles financially, it may be a different struggle, but struggles financially, it's for everybody to green, the abundance mentality. So just a little bit, there might be of help for us to move forward, as we look at our people that we're going to be helping some communities, we'll get into the inner city, some communities will be in the indigenous populations and where they live. And some are going to be in the poorer areas of town, and, but they're all God's children, and they all get a chance to be who they are and, and have their life experiences and their life purpose fulfilled. And if we can help them do that, that's going to be really good for all of us. So I helping the poor inner city and indigenous people. It solves the problems of not having funding to do this type of work. If we're humanitarian, we want to get in and help where the pavement meets the ground. If you got a flat tire, that's not going to be very good. So we're going to be there where their their actual lives are touching the ground. And that's where their help is going to be. So looking at it from that point of view, doesn't matter where they work. Now, as we get into the CAC, we're looking at no more delayed for local projects, we can make projects happen quicker, yes, absolutely. Governments have to go through a budgetary process. And they project their income for the year and they create a budget so that that, then everybody gets a certain amount of that. And then that's what they have to work with. And they can't do any more than they are getting. So if there's a number of like, bridges or roads that need to be fixed, then there's only so many roads that can be fixed within the budget for that year, we come along and money is not the problem. If people to get to do the work is our will be our biggest problem. And, you know, we want, we want the work to be done very well. And so there's inspectors and people like that that helped to come out. And be sure that when you're laying concrete, if you don't do it right the first time, you got to tear that out, it's very, very expensive to do. So we want to be sure that everything's is really good in in good shape. The government's have people to come out and inspect jobs like that. And so you get a permit. And then to build something here, put sidewalk there, whatever, and then you're going to they're going to give you permission to do that, or a permit to do that. And they will send out the

people at the right time. And you'll have to coordinate with with their office to be sure that somebody comes out and takes a look at your what you've built to pour your concrete. Yeah. Be sure that it's the right thickness and all that sort of thing. So they're they're there to help and you need to use that. Now, those are the kinds of people that we get off the government and start working our them ourselves. And they get a chance to go out and take a look at things because they know what's going on there. have been trained to do that. So give them a an employment contract and have them work for us. Create future for the Create futures for the children of those communities. Let us understand for sure that the children who are coming down now who are being born into this third dimension, have bodies that are a little bit different than ours. And indeed, when you call them, indigo children or whatever, I don't care what you call them, they are special people. And they came with a purpose. And that purpose is to help us. Children can't help us unless they have a solid foundation upon which full of love and acceptance. The worst way to kill a child is to say, having the shoulder danger, Oh, you're too stupid to do something like that, you know, figure out something else, go be a policeman or get a job at the waste recovery store thing. Appear parents can destroy and kill children. But the new children are coming out. And they're going to start talking to the parents and teaching the parents a different way of learning. So we create a set of circumstances where that can happen. That's means we have they have a whole they have income, they have food and proper food and clothing, and opportunities for in life where they can create a dancer theater, recreation, all kinds of paintings, all of that stuff that we just put aside because it doesn't make enough money to live on. We can appreciate those kinds of things, because now people will have enough money to do that sort of thing. So yes, the communities will grow and develop in support of our children. And let's just be sure that our children are the ones that we want to be sure taken care of. And I think with the education system that's coming, we'll get away from the curveballs thing where you memorize for a test and take the test. And then you're a wonderful person, if you pass and all that garbage, it's going to be different than the future, the future is going to be learning who you are and how to become the child of God with full capacities. And that means you get all of your DNA put together, and you get all of the information that's coming from God on a normal basis. And then those are things that are going to happen for our children. And so we just to create a set of circumstances where that can happen. That's our job. And we support the children as they come along. And, and be sure that they understand that this life is for them to live and to choose and to do the things that they want to do. And mom and dad don't get to get involved unless they ask for it. So okay, best assistant directors will come from this area. Yeah. So the directors, yes. There's all kinds of different ways to find them. So if we could offer it in our CICS, it might spark that creativity or that idea for them. It's like, oh, well, I never had the opportunity. The reason why it's it's very dear to my heart is because a lot of friends have homeschool their children, because they were Christian. Yes, nicely put is good, these are good ideas. Managing Directors are going to need a lot of help. We're training the directors in the CAC program, we're getting a big push for what what do we call it the director, Academy. So these people could get the they can be educated on things and there's be a common course of information. So that we're on the same at least is

starting out on the same sheet of music. And then from there, you get to use your own discretion and your own talents and uniqueness and bring that to your work. So the directors need to have the Managing Directors need to go put their people through and support the director training. And in doing so they'll they'll get opportunities to manifest what they did. You know, how much do you want a lot of money spent on on infrastructure, you want a lot of them in some of the larger communities, they don't need so much of that and some of the smaller ones smaller meaning more population crammed together. There's other opportunities that are available there. So and understand that as we get things going better, then people will be moving and houses will be made available for them and our whole programs will really come to Okay, so that's that's going to be good. So managing directors you can't do at all, so you're gonna have to find the good people to do that. And hiring an accounting firm is a good way to get to get the reports that you need to analyze. And they'll help you with that. What is this, I'd like a report that tells me how many persons, how many small businesses, the, the director and his assistants have done for this week or this month, whatever, that's a good way to know. And then do you have an idea how much money is going out, and you can plan for the next week or two, and so on. And that's all part of the managing of the funds. So you can do a good job. tracking spending is essential. I think every person, every director that I have, and even perhaps if the director thinks that his assistant directors need a phones in a capital, excuse me and account in the quantum financial system, that they can use their money. Also have it associated with an accounting firm, so that you can get reports, those are the kinds of things that we're going to learn how to do as we move into the CAC. And I'm hoping that we can get all of the information ahead of time so that the training will be a very, very valuable thing for your directors. Okay, hire a common law team, I think that the lighting is is important. You won't need a law team in one CAC area, geographical area. But you might have a law firm for the team or wherever you want to call it for the whole city. And they can be in charge of helping you with contracts. Because sometimes there might be somebody that I want, I'd like to do this and this and can we do that. And we say, well, let me check with my lawyer. And and that's just somebody there, that's a resource for them to check things out. So that's always a good idea. especially important if you plan multiple CSAs. And in different countries, the biggest problem we're going to have moving from English speaking or from here to other countries, English speaking or not, when you go into a country that doesn't speak English, then there's a whole set of circumstances that become a problem can be come a problem if not solved ahead of time. So are we going to get packet are translating devices that can be used for our people. And maybe there'll be a whole set of those going into the committee and into the directors Academy so that people in other countries with a different language can have their little device there with them, they can get the information that they need. And it's translated. So those are the kinds of things as we move into other locations. Obviously, if a CAC has been put together in a, in a country, everybody there speaks that language. So that should not be a problem. But in the training, if it's going to be a centralized training or standardized training, then those are the kinds of things that will have to take place, we plan on those, and we'll solve the problems. A problem comes with the solution. I don't know if you've ever realized that a problem, we'll come up with a solution, your job that have been identified, the problem is then to identify the solution. And we have that same problem. And that's why it's called revenue sharing solutions. There's a problem of how to get money out to people. Well, this is the solution that we have created for it. So those are the kinds of ways that things will happen. The problem comes with the solution. You'll find that out as you move into things and get involved. Those are some really good questions and they create a lot of flow of, of what I think would be some solutions or things that I perhaps would love to do. Are they their designated areas, a managing director can work in, we do not tell you where you can work, we do not limit you to where you want to work. And a CAC is boots on the ground, that's where humanitarian activities, start with boots on the ground in a local community. They'll be getting the funds because the RSS program will will go like wildfire. And so that's not going to be a problem. But Tacs we have no problems and people setting up. CAC is in the same community. Now, this one over here might be doing more than this one over there. And so we can help those people over there do more or whatever. It's not necessary to coordinate activities. But then is there a problem with that? No, I think it's a good idea. But you're not forced to do that. And we will certainly not be the ones to force it, nor to limit your activities. This is your work. This is your glory. This is what you present to God as a contributor as a tribute back to him for the things that you have been able to accomplish. This is your this is your stuff. And don't let anybody take it away from you. Certainly not Lavon says I would never do that. This wouldn't do it. So the managing director can work wherever they want. And if there's multiples there that would like to do CAC as well, some people might be some CAC's might be interested more in in small business owners and contracts for them. And others might be wanting to doing more involved in the housing and create condominiums and creating new homes that are being built and specialize in that everybody get a chance to do what they feel is important for that community. And it's hard to say from one community to the to the next, what is going to be a central idea or concept except for the fact that things can be different in every location that you go into. And you find the people that would help you do that. I think that Boys and Girls Clubs already have a lot of humanitarians who are working there. I want to be careful that we're not chasing people in boys and girls clubs who are preparing or whatever they call our word. To do stuff to the children, that's inappropriate. But there are those who have the good hearts. And they're out there doing it. They need the funds. So they can be a a source of directors or assistant directors in all kinds of that that committee might be one that you might want to be focusing on. After school activities course what school is going to happen, I don't know. But socializing,

we're going to have a lot of opportunities for that. But these are the kinds of people in my opinion, that would be good directors, especially if you get into the cities where they don't have so much help. These are the persons who are out there doing the work with very little means of support, put them on a contract, get them to work and doing stuff that they really want to do anyway. They go to work every day and think they're paying, they're dumb enough to pay. I used to go to the National Guard flying and they pay us to go fly. And I used to think how stupid or they would come out here and fly free if they would just let us well, no, they got to pay us so that's the idea then is that you're going to get paid for doing the things paying the people for doing the same things they're already loving and enjoying. And so there's a good source of people. Okay, let's go on to the next one. Does the managing director work with love won industries on the ESS or CAC progress cch program Yes. In order for us to fulfill the work What we intend to do with the economic stabilization system, which is also preparation for the International commodity clearing houses, commodity clearing houses are a pattern for us moving into the galaxy, and doing things over there that we have done here. And we've been successful here, we'll just do it, expand it. So those are the things that we are moving towards now the economic stabilization system. And for those who haven't really studied it, we buy all of the farmers produce ahead of time. If it's a car manufacturer, we buy all of the cars that they manufacture less the cost of labor, because we're paying their people the labor and benefits and so far. And what about tractors, what about other without washing machines and dryers, all of those are the kinds of things that are need the higher business oriented contracts to be able to function properly. And when I go in and buy all of the washing machines, and I want to put them in houses, as I'm doing in the real estate listing service, they will go to the to the people who are distributors in that area. And we pay them well for the things that they're doing. And so we go there, we buy washing machines that we have already paid for, but put through the system, so everybody gets paid. And then we pay a nice price for them, then isn't that working out for the community, the economic stabilization system has to be in charge and has to be controlled by a central organization. And that's what love won industries is going to be. Because if we do it properly, there's no inflation, there's no increase in the cost of anything. And I don't know if you've thought about this, but as a managing director, you receive a quarterly payment, it's going to be very large. You You're investing that in the economy investing, you're helping the economy. And that money has to be getting cut out there. If it doesn't, you have to pull it in the bond account. And then there's other reasons for that, but you have that big amount of money each quarter to get, I'm gonna say get rid of, but that's not really the right words to use. But getting out into the, into the communities is the important thing. So we're getting the money out there. And we're getting the produce that we meet, we're getting the materials that we need. We're getting everything that we need in a way that is most beneficial for economic system. So the ESS economic stabilization system is designed so that every person in the world has a place in that economic system where they are financially viable. So we're not going to interrupt, we're going to buy everything and then put it through the distribution system at a price that we feel comfortable with. And if if we have 35,000 Managing Directors all out there doing the same thing and deciding that they want to put the price of this and that they can't, then we've created a set of circumstances that are competitive one with another, that's not going to work. That's not going to accomplish what we need to do. We will have the alliance and each person will have their counselor to be involved in these kinds of things. They are all by contract. You if you'd want to do something, then this is way to do it. Here's the contracts that you can sign that that are meaningful. And we will have that legal team, huge legal team to service everybody and all of the differences that they need in one contract for another to another. So a car company might have this contract for them. But what if it is our desire that that contract those people and they're their assembly process their plants? What if we want them to do antigravity machines it's already been I don't know for us. So the comp, the contract can be just a little bit different to include that. And those are the

kinds of things that we will have to work with. So at the level of ESS and ICCH, you've got to have a lot of business acumen, what does that mean? You need to know what's going on, and business people to know what's going on, so that they can be successful. Now we're going to be successful as not because we're making money, because we're not going to be making money, we're going to be successful because the, the the community needs to have the economics of success to be able to function properly. Because your heart is pulling those kinds of things into your mind. And it's just a simple way to figure out the rest of the best way to do it. Being prayerful, and all that sort of stuff is is essential. Are they trying to limit us? Is God trying to limit us? Is the Alliance trying to limit us in our thinking in the ways that we do think, no, there's supporting the greatest ideas that we have the greatest ways of doing things the best way, because it doesn't. If it takes money, you got all the money to do it the right way. But if your idea is to make money, you will go the shortest distance and make the most money. And that's what the economy has been doing. Now. That's why the Earth has been destroyed. And people's lives are being destroyed. The greatest source resource on this earth is being destroyed by the way that we're doing our interstate or our commerce. So we're all changing to letting God have his way with us. And that is for every person to prosper. So these are the kinds of things that we're looking at the ESS has a vision of what it can do. And so you have to be there by contract in order to for it to, to be a part of it. We'll go through all the training and everything that you need to know and understand to do that. It will work marvelously with the CAC is because the directors are the local people on the ground. And they can be the ones to go over to the farmer or wherever and do whatever they need to do to help and be a resource. They get into the manufacturing of things. What is the best way to do it? What are some of the newest way technology? What are some of the most safest ways of getting things done? What is it in the way that we're going to have antigravity machines? How would how are they going to work with all of us in the air at the same time? There'll be all kinds of crashes if there wasn't a technology to support it. So we're going to do things the appropriate way. We're under God's control. And with that, backing with that support with our counselors will get the job done in the best way that we possibly can. That's what I see. So, yes, by contract, anybody can be in there if they want to do it. And you just have to learn what's going on and then by contract Um, stay in line in line, meaning this is what I volunteer to do. We'll do this, you do that? The best source for finding directors are mentioned a little bit about when you are involved in this is something for your directors to look at to, when you're involved in your business, you'll find people that have a really good heart. And maybe those are the ones that you'd like to introduce them to your Managing Director, you know, he's a director who the managing director calling different, it's a different way of directing, but different level. But if you can introduce them, and see if there's a place there, because the managing director is expanding the CAC as much as possible, with a good people that they meet and train and get functioning at a high level for the director to really be of benefit to the community. So they're involved with a city can have two or three, maybe 20 of directors and you have mine have a couple of directors that are managing directors, managing your directors, and, and then in the city, you might have one person that's in charge. And then you might work collaboratively to have another city with one person in charge. And that's why I see the CAC is growing. So there's people that will be there, and again, it's there, they'll come out of the woodwork and find them and they'll find you and you'll find them. It'll be a great experience for everybody. Okay, can a CAC offer other services such as training, meetings, job placement, education, health, and wellness, etc? Those are really profound things to do in a CAC. Not all CAC is would do that. You might have one CAC in the city that is focusing on those kinds of trainings and meetings and job placement and education. What a tremendous opportunity to have a job placement organization that feeds you directors directly. Wouldn't that be fun? And coming up with education, health and wellness, all of those things are part of the CAC, they're all part of the projects that can happen. You know, we talk about projects, well, the best place to introduce your projects is in your CAC's because you'll have the help that you need to get it done. And it's just a byproduct of whatever the other stuff that they're doing. Where do you have a location, you want to building a new building, you can do this, you can do that. You got to have boots on the ground. You got to have boots out in the community. Finding people that are having some problems will be we've got a place over here at CAC Glendale CAC, over here, and they'll help you with your G education. Community College's learning centers, all kinds of things, job placement, once they don't learn their skills, and so forth. This is all part of supporting the community. So now I'm going to just going to make another statement along with Canada, ca c offer services, such as who's in charge, that would tell you what you can do and can't do. So Don puts these questions together and it's no reflection on him. But I'm trying to say you do not have anybody over you. You and your counselor are the ones who make the decisions. Now, you make the decision, your counselor is just there to counsel with you. And so, you're the one in charge. It's your stewardship, your dominion, your sovereignty. That's what you're creating. And that's where you can take back to God and say, Hey, this is what I've done. He says, Oh, good job, well done, thou good and faithful servant. Isn't that fun? So putting controls on the CAC necessary, I'm not sure where the control is, shall we attempt to satisfy every opportunity out there in a community? I say, why not? If it's something that can benefit the community, let's do it, let's work it out, I take a little effort might take some thought and some planning might take some money to get the building up or something like this. And then you might have a building over across town that wants to do the same thing. Well, you set up a CAC over there and away you go. I don't think that there's anything that you need to consider out of bounds as far as anything you want to do for the community. I could be wrong, but your counselor will help you with that sort of thing. They'll have a greater vision of what can take place for you. So you call him every day? What do you want to do today? Well, this thought was having in mind, well, let's sit down and talk about it. You were gonna do that yesterday and didn't get done. Is that true? Oh, yeah, that's true. I'm not picking at you. They're just saying pointing out things that are real. If you're offended by that sort of thing, then create a different relationship with them. But they're there to support you in the best way that they can. So there are no controls that I can see necessary

for a CAC and anything that will help a community is something that the CAC should be involved with. Unless it's like skydiving from Mount Everest, or so that's on the CAC program. You understand what I'm saying?
