But I see but I don't know, in the NDA, if this would be might be violating the NDA is because accounting firms need are checking the backgrounds of the particular company or even a non stop organization like a CAC that say, who are the directors, the names specifically will be in there, and they will not issue the financial reports they will not sign it, they do not confirm the identities of the individual in the party in a particular organization.

well, as far as they're concerned, those are things that you just don't, the NDAs is here to help us. Now, that person might have a chatty mouth and talk around the neighborhood. And I saw that guide figure, or that ride at ladies figure. And she is well, let me tell you, that creates a

that guy's figure, or that girls or ladies figure. And she is well, let me tell you, that creates a target, that's why they do the NDA, you only give them the amount of information that they need to function at the level that you want them to function. So when I'm talking about the county, and I'm not talking about somebody that's going to be managed here, amount of money, and so forth, the the accounting process is where's the money being spent? Now, then we'll get to a chance to you know, if there's just one of them there, and they've had other people working for them. The left hand doesn't know what the right hand. So there's no totals that are involved, except for perhaps somebody that's in charge. And, but you're in control of that. So if I have a CAC, and I've got four or five directors in that town, and each one of them, I've given an account, in the quantum financial system, and I supply them money, in that way, I would like them to also be involved with an accounting firm, so I can see how they spend the money. And that's the thing that I'm interested in, because as a manager, I can see how well they're doing, by the number of people that they have had contracts with, I can see how they're growing by the number of new people that come in. And their request for assistant directors. The assist for assistant the question or the asking for assistance, I think is a very good indication that they are assessing what they're trying to accomplish. And they know that they need some new people. And I think that that's wonderful. But they're, they're not out there all the time on their own. Because somebody that you have in charge of that CAC, if it's not you, we'll be talking with him on at least weekly pieces, and solving problems and seeing if there are any problems. So that's it, that's a functional meeting that you need to have, at the levels that you can, you know, until I get big enough, I'm going to have counsel meetings with my directors, and I'll have three or four initially, and we'll go through some problems. And as we solve those problems, then I will feel more comfortable moving off into expanding into greater areas. But I'm only going to you know people are arguing now or concern now oh, I can only do it in one place. That's the CAC on the CAC man. Well, you don't even have any money yet. You don't know where you're gonna go and how many CAC Do you know how to handle? Can you handle one? Can you manage one? And so people are really kind of not being realistic and they may be the CEO type. I don't know. And I don't mean to be critical of those kinds of people, but most people have never done a CAC before. And so you may have some skills to do that. But there's, there's, there's things that will happen in that CAC that you've never had before happen before you're giving money away. And there's going to be people that want that money, when you give it to them in such a way that they feel responsible, and not, that there's some kind of a gift here that they can just receive, and then go out and do nothing. So when you get involved in a management situation, the accounting procedures, or ways that you can, and you get those reports that are happening, that's your way of managing your people and seeing how well they're performing. And if there's somebody that's not performing well enough, or you think that they could do better, then you call him in and say, you know, we've got some reports here and feels to me like there's more that you can be doing, is there some help that I can give you? Or do you feel like you're maxed out? Do you need more assistance? Do you need more guidance from me? Is there something that I can help you with? Others are picking up the ball and running with it a little bit faster than you are. And it's not a criticism and nor is it a comparison, except for management. So you have that counsel with them you have sit down and talk with them. We don't fire anybody, unless they're dishonest. So we always work with people. And the skill levels that they bring will either accelerate them faster than others or not, it doesn't matter, as long as they're doing their job and doing it well. And if they need some help, and you give it to them. We're not in it to make money. We're in it to get service done for the community. Does that help?

If it resonates with them, and they have the calling, we'll see how much they get involved in the educational portions of it. Because that's where their efforts have to be shown. You know, I learned how to fly a t 38. I flew formation, where the slightest movement of the stick is too much. If you think about it, and just allow it to take place, instead of thinking, you can maneuver your, your stick to be able to stay in formation goes for the acceleration and the controls there to that cannot be taught, you have to go there and get that information and become a part of it, it has to be a part of you. It took me a year to the point where when I went out on a solo run, I can feel the wind going over the wings, I could feel it. I was one with that airplane. And it did everything that I wanted it to do. Because we have our one together, they in that plane response. And that's the way that we can work into our humanitarian activities. By knowing everything we need to know. And then the magic takes place is the performance of everything you know, that's manifesting as you do your work. Those are the ways that we prepare. So as a managing director. We're asking to stretch to stretch as large as you can be. Because you may not have been stretched far enough to complete what you need to do. So there's no limitations on you stretch until it's not going to hurt. It's just stretching your mind and your ideas and your thoughts. And when you are in that position, you're looking for it now in training for now. But when you are in that position as a managing director, the magic is going to happen in your life. I guarantee that this is changing. But there's a spiritual component to it. That is part of your calling to be prepared to be a humanitarian that is fully functioning in a way that the alliance is pleased. Now my one of the things that I want to be sure that I do as far as the overseer of loved one society is to do everything that I know to please my Father in heaven. This is his plan. Your tears work. Cheers, glory. Everything that I'm doing is designed to manifest what job what God wants me to do. And I put everything I have into that for that purpose. We as humanitarians are expected to be that way. And beyond anything like that, we can become it. There's no reason for us not to. You're wanting to get a director or directors, just ask for it. Just ask for it and know that in the asking. You will receive what you're asking for. Because your heart helped you to come up with the things that you're asking. Now in your mind, maybe your mind did all the routes taken everything that might be, but it is your heart that will tell you to do things. It is your heart that is reaching out to the essence of those who are going to be involved with you. To become one, your heart knows their heart. You don't know them, but your heart death. zeros here, not money, they're zeros. So don't confuse me with money and zeros. Because I know that zeros are just accumulating over there and more zeros I've got, then the more work I can get done. Don't look at it as money. That distorts the whole thing. Unless of course, you're looking for money. And then when you're looking for money, it's a good chance you won't get it. It'll soon as to see the truth. That could lead us to funding funding a continuation of other projects when the humanitarians come looking for us. Not all humanitarians are going to receive the funds. Only those who have a calling to receive the funds. That's the point of the spear. And I had to start taking care of him when he turned 18, we just had parents had to wait till their children are 18 in our state before they could start working with their child, it used to be at birth, but they changed that. So it was just a revolving door of workers coming in just so I could keep my full time job. And it just got to a point where I couldn't do any more. And so when he turned 18,

that took over with that, with all that being said, that's just about backstory. I am one of the many parents who struggle in his state based on the innovations waiver. And I know when children, like my son had the ability to eventually use the med beds. And I know it's going to be based on medical necessity, correct? For scarce first, and I know the parents are going to need counselling services when their child goes through the transition, I'm not assuming that all disabilities can be healed in the med beds. Correct?
