There's a couple of things, perhaps we'll see what comes. But the Community Assistance Centers are designed to be the boots on the ground. That's where the beginning of humanitarian activities work, or are accomplished. And the CAC program was designed so that people could get out and do things for their community, one of the biggest things that we don't really understand if people are working real hard and having two or three jobs, then they're working out their job for somebody else. Just so they can have money. That's the way that the cabal has set up society. Now, we're coming along with all kinds of money distributed in a very systematic way. Yes, there will be I've, I've heard maybe 3%. But I don't even focus on that at all, I don't even care about those kinds of people and what they want to do with their money, I'm looking for the 97%, who are going to pick up the ball and run with it and create some very interesting and new aspects to a community. And the lady Janice, I think it was was was saying that there's going to be a different way of judging a person's value. I believe that that is true. Right now we are in lack consciousness. So those who have more than enough? What are they doing with it? Well, they're spending their money on cars and, and big homes and that sort of thing. And I'm not regretting that at all. But for those of us who see that, and say, that's not really what money is supposed to be, because those people I see are not happy. They're doing that so that they can create a better feel for themselves of being important to the community, because look at all of the money they're they're making. About what about the person who comes from their uniqueness, and create something that is usable in society. And they never concern themselves about the riches, they just want to serve? Well, those are the humanitarians. And that's the humanitarian heart that is going to bring about the changes. And that's why humanitarians are of such a great need in society. If you are a humanitarian and have that kind of a heart, you were phenomenal. And I commend you, and I wish that everything that we're doing can be that you can use up and used to be a success with serving other people. That's where it's all about. And so when I look at somebody with a car, and the nice thing, well, there's, it's okay. You can you can make, you can try and be Joneses, if you want to say in the neighborhood. So everybody can keep up with you, but you're gonna find this. It's a very shallow existence, especially when you get into service and coming from the heart, because those are the kinds of people that find the joy and the happiness. And not the people who are the Joneses. And I'm saying that but you know, disrespectful of people who are named Joseph has another point. It's a point is is keeping up with the Joneses idea is going to

go away because every every business can have everything that the Joneses have. And what a better way to live alive. So you don't have lack consciousness that's driving your forces and using lack consciousness as a judgment or determination of the value of other people. So in abundance, we're going to have a lot of money, a lot of money. And we'll show better ways of doing that as we get into the programs. I might just I might just say, when we were working out how much should we pay directors to become directors. And we were always using the concept of 10 cents a minute. So we thought well, 25 cents a minute would keep people up and busy. So they get out and get a job, because they're making more money out there than they are by just staying home. But when you add six crushed to it, that's 70 cents or 60 cents that's added to your 10 cents per minute. And that is really where the structure needs to be. When I say structure, you give the deal that you give the director 70 cents per minute, not 25%. Because they can make 70 cents to stay in a home. So if you give them 70, at least 70 et Cie, from my perspective with the director said, I'd like to have working for me, they will make money by signing people up by go to a business owner. And if the business owner is not a member already, then they get to sign them up and then do the contract. And so there's going to be a lot of money for our directors to to get the bonuses. And that will be very helpful for them. So, but the director is the one that's going to be moving everything, virtually everything as we go forth. With our programs, that director is going to be the main one. The others will have perhaps some things that would challenge as in a superiority sort of situation, I'm not looking for that. But real estate getting into that. And I'm sort of getting into what we were talking about with the bullet points here. But the point that I'm trying to make with all of the programs is that there is money. The underlying thing is to produce people who are moving into a higher dimension by raising their vibrations. It can be conscious, or it can be subconscious. But when they're doing things that support the movement forward, then those are the things and you may not know that that's something that's really helping you to move forward. The love that you share and the love that you create. When you're out doing your work her major points towards the ascension process. When you get into the higher realms, there's no lack. They're the ones that know if there's a problem, don't be calling us. Don't be emailing, I can't get into the will work out so that you can get a hold of the people who can help you. Now also remember that they are volunteers. They have full time jobs. They don't have time to answer, two or 300 emails. You overload the system that way. So do what you can figure it out, become tech savvy, become one who understands how to do things. Instead of saying, Well, I can't do this, people say, Well, I haven't. And I've been getting these emails for a long, long time now. And then all of a sudden, my names off the list, and I'm not getting anymore. Well, when you reach the end of the CAC, or excuse me, the Q and A's, there's no more emails coming to you. Except for the ones that Tracy wants to send out as far as information for for everybody. So once once they stopped this, because we have not had any more, the emails are over, you know, I'm sorry, the you're not taken off the list. That list is there. And it's going to be mailed out every

time we send something through. That's what Active Campaign does. And we pay him a nice hunk of money to do that. And we're getting up to where we're going to have to go into some more because our numbers are getting really high. We're willing to do that people respond to the call for donations, which by the way, many people have done and grateful for that. Okay. I said that stay home, do your CAC at home and then spread out when you get the money. Okay, okay, Don, let's go ahead.

We've covered everything up top. Great. Okay, roster. The CAC works with the implementing of contracts to small businesses. It provides contracts to pay wages to its employees. There's an opportunity to offering grants and trusts in support of certain business projects. And then there's a chance that a CAC can help assist with local governments to implement a plan for community growth. Yeah, comments for that?

Yeah, I do providing contracts to pay wages to its employees. Our basic what is the basic purpose of us contracting with them? These are small businesses that are serving their community. If you have a small business that's making For \$5,000, a month or even a week, and they start getting into the programs where we the RSS program where they're making 20,000, a week or a month, then it's, it's why do you want to stay open? So we're gonna go there and give them a reason to do that. We're going to give them a reason for keeping their business open. We're gonna give them a reason to go out and start finding and paying people a very high wage that they hadn't been used to before, even the ones that are already there with you. Because the contract is for you. Yes, but it's contract, in addition is the contracts for your labor. And we can pay them, we can pay them very nicely. And do you care how much we pay them, or we'd like your best, what best amount that you feel comfortable paying them. And then perhaps double that, because we have the money, where it's no shortage, so let's just use it. That's what I look at. As far as the employees, business owners and their employees, let's pay them well, so that they can continue to service the community. Okay, offering grants in

support of business business projects, what is a grant, maybe there's a definition here that some people are a name that does, some people don't know, a grant is we grant you certain amount of money for certain projects or certain things you need. You may get a grant for a new a new truck or a new lift in your, in your garage, you may get a grant for remodeling your restaurant, those are the kinds of things that can happen with a grant. A grant is given to them, and yet we want them to use it proficiently. In other words, you don't just say, I'm going to give you \$10,000. And you're going to do your well, it may be a \$30,000 job. Well, let's go in and we'll find the people that will do the work, Not we but they will go and find the work and and and then they'll work out their estimate of what it's going to be. Do you give them their whole estimate right away? No, you give them maybe half or a third in the beginning. And and when they get halfway through it, then you give them another third. And then when they get finished, and you give them the last third. Those are the ways that you service contracts. That's the way that the grant should should work. If you don't do it that way, then you're going to find that people will spend the money on other things besides the grant for what they're trying to do. They may take a trip to Hawaii, who knows. So you do things appropriately. Now, I don't mind them going to Disneyland, or Hawaii, they're not spending the grant money on that I have no problems with that at all. But the grant mainly needs to be for the grant or for the things for the grant. So that's a good thing to understand. offering grants in support of business projects, and remodeling, or a new new delivery truck or things of that nature are things that are really going to help them Don't skip, you're becoming you're going to have directors, your directors should be thinking, how can I serve the the what can I come in and help you with? What what do I see you got worn out benches, let's get these benches fixed back up, let's get your tables, nicely decorated, let's let's you know put some paintings and things like this on the walls that are enjoyable to look at. And add to the atmosphere of where you're going to have your people come to eat. Those are the kinds of things that you get into the business and how not just to I will see a way to get another employee and you're there to help them. And that's if you need more assistant directors than get more assistant directors. Because we those are the kinds of things where people really get to know who we are at what the CAC program is really designed to do. And they'll they'll love you. They'll be grateful for the amount of money that you're helping them with because they can't do it themselves. They don't have that kind of money for their. So you're the ones with the money so do the things that they can't do. Give them grants, give them whatever. And if it's something that needs to be consistently given over a A period of time then put them on a zoom benefactor. And just write out how much you want to pay them on a monthly basis or, and you figure that out on how much it takes per minute for the download. You'll find a lot of really fun things to do with them. Okay, working with local governments to help implement a plan for committed growth. Now, there is a two edged sword staring you in the face with this. Number one, when we get our buddy, no, sorry, NESARA will be the law of the land. You cannot tax people, you can only tax the purchase, or the sales tax on things that are within the parameters of the sale tag essential items, they're not going to get tax on a house anymore, or land. Because that's income tax for them. And just because you have a piece of land does not say they taxed you because they own the land, the government owns the land. That's the Cabal. People who build roads and things like this, they tax the people build the roads and steal whatever's left and and say, Well, we're doing a really good job. Look at all the roads, we don't know one building of their building of that road over there would take maybe 30 days of taxing and they get a year of taxing and where does the rest of money go? It surely doesn't go for anything we're doing. Okay, so how do we deal with government? We have a problem. We have the money. They want our money. This is where grants come in. You get so much inherent so much there's so much there and then at the end, the contractor gets the rest of it and you don't get a part of it. Government. If you don't like it, then go get another job. So money does everything. I'm sorry, I was getting another call. While you were

because the government decides that they want to be rich, and you get to be poor, and you'll have to accept bribes on a very minor basis. And yet, that's what's that's where we're going. So let's not do that anymore and create a postal service. That is a service.

Great. Okay, well, I'm looking to just jump down into the middle of the bullets there and talk about examples of type of businesses and situations to approach For a CAC, and if you could just give your overall thoughts of what you think I know a lot of people send messages about wanting to know what is wrong, think about this and that and it's up to us obviously as as benefactors and managing directors to do our own and playing our own CAC's. But if you have comments regarding this, that would be awesome. So okay, so the first area would be talking about employment contracts that we could offer to farmers. How would that work? In your mind? Is there a signing bonus, a download for the contracts NRELS youth for land and buildings, how would that happen? Grants proceed production and soil preservation, and then the overall consideration of purchasing those goods and crops once they've been grown.

Ron Giles 50:48

Okay, the farmers are kind of in a in between the national economic stabilization system and ESS system, it's really dot solutions from what it's going to be. As far as the websites are concerned, that's pretty much where the love won industries will, will kind of let take the lead there. And so if you want to start working with farmers, then let's sign up for working with love won industries, Loveland industries, we'll be the ones that buys everything, and then sells it along the distribution channels, to where that's where we control, runaway inflation or any inflation, by the by the amount of money that we put into it, and the amount of money we take out from it, if we really need to do that. Sometimes we can just buy something and sell it for free. Because we can't make money, but that destroys the system. So we have distributors, we have all kinds of things that we have, as far as the economic stabilization program. And so we'll do that we'll do that appropriately. Now, what I'm proposing with the National Economic

Stabilization NDS is that when you approach a farmer, you go to the farmer, and you say this is we have a new program for this area. And, and it's a contractual basis where we, we will buy, let's say, we figure out how much product you have made of a certain kind and, and it'll be that driven with that product driven, let's go for the last five years of what you have made, or produced. And we'll say that that's going to be what we will pay ahead of time, in the spring of the year, so that you can get your, your seeds and preparations for ground and new equipment if it's necessary, and so forth. So we'll that's how we come in with the contractors. Now, as far as the farmers are concerned, we'll put all of his people that he wants on employment contracts. Now we have seasonal workers, how do we deal with that? Well, we'll work out the details for a one year, and that the downloads will be there, and we can work it out so that the director in that area can change that for the for the downloads for there's all kinds of ways to deal with that. But the workers are only there for a certain period of time for, for picking everything and, and then there's another time in the season when they're not there. Or they're not being they're not working. I feel personally I think their contribution to society is very prolific. They need we need them, we need them. So we can pay them all year round, even if they're not working. Okay, that's kind of an interesting thing. But for seasonal work, that's fine. I don't if I'm in charge of of that, if I was just director, I'll work out something that the farmer will want and something that the people will want. They may go back to Mexico and they still can draw money if that's okay. I don't care. I would like to work at that way. If there's problems with it, let's take a look at the problems. Okay, so that's the contractual obligation that I'm giving to not an obligation that I'm giving the opportunity that I'm giving to farmers, but there are people out there contract, those people know what they're doing. And he couldn't run his farm without them. So let's put him in a position where we appreciate what they're doing and pay them well for it. If we go into a contract with a farmer, if we want to go into a contract, and we buy all of his stuff at the first part of the year, it's going to change the way that he's going to do things. We talk about the bond account, everything that I do will be bonded. So that the farmer knows, every year he's going to get his money. And I'll work out of the a five or 10 year bond on that just like we're doing with large corporations. And we'll have money in a bank account for him personally, bank account, me and the quantum financial system, that is the bond. If he wants to draw from that and use it for certain things and then pay it back then that's money that he can use. If he wants to do that. Why do I concern myself with it? Because that's his bond. If he doesn't pay it back, Who's he going to screw nobody else but himself. Okay, so he's got the you got the farmer, he signs a contract, and I give him a signing bonus of \$1 per minute. And that can be according to the size of the of his farm, you know, a one or 2000 acre farm is going to be different than a 10 or 15, or 20,000 acre farm, I'll work out a bonus that's really good for him for signing the contract with us. And his laborers, oftentimes, you know, I worked on a farm, they were the driver, the tractor was, you know, 11 years old. And he did a great job. So, but he wasn't the son of the owner. So in a farming community, let's do things a little different. They don't have to be 18 years old to drive a tractor. They don't have to be this that the other, let's let's put them on contracts. The farmer can get the younger people that do a really good job, and they don't need a lot of money, but they just love to work. Well, we can pay them what the farmer feels that he's been paying them and keep them working. And give them a good substantial raise every time they every season, they start over again. So assigning the bonus will give the owner a the farmer, the owner, we give them a signing bonus. And then we work out how much he's going to have to get paid every year for seeds and things like that. And we always throw in some new equipment purchases, reconditioning or whatever. And we work it out so that the farmer is one of the highest paid individuals in the country as far as owning their own small business. Farmers are that they grow there. They don't stick their feet in the ground and grow but they grow in their abilities to give service to mankind. Let's not make it a problem every year where he has to put up his farm to borrow money so that he can make some money for that year. That's what we're

trying to avoid. His farm should never be involved in a loan where it could foreclose and he would have to give up his farm like these. It starts with a B and ends with a D did to these farmers. They have no heart. And we'll look what they did they they foreclosed on their properties and gave it to the the corporation farmers who worked for the dark side. That will never happen as far as as long as I am involved with love won society. If I find out about it, there's going to be heads rolling. You do not mess with a farmer in his land. And you do not mess with a home for people. That's the difference between us and the government or the financial situation the way it's been. Those things are sacred, sacred to me. And it They'll not be violated. Okay. And NRELS for land buildings can then happen. The NRELS is in a freedom situation, we've got some really good ideas how to gather it all up together is going to be different and not different, it can be the same, but it's going to come about because we'll have a consulting firm or a project team or something of this nature to go through the NRELS. It's a listing service, and how could that best suit the individuals, I've had my ideas, but I'd like to get some other ideas so that we can fine tune it and make it effective. And what we want to do with it, so the NRELS program is a little bit up in the air right now. Good ideas that can be used anywhere in the world, but we don't know if it can until we get there and we fine tune it to conform to the laws of the land as far as comp compensation for people getting involved in real estate. And so we'll work it all out as far as the NRELS is concerned, land buildings, commercial, commercial buildings, those things can have a parallel within our system. Let's see how that can be handled. Right now, I'm not sure about it, but we'll figure out something the best way we can. It's, it's waiting to happen. So we just have to do it. Okay, then there's grants for seed production, soil preservation, soil repair. I'd like to see every farmer get in a position where they're doing organic farming, we can do that camp, President Trump made it available for farmers to have happened and the states gave all kinds of laws and so forth. So you have to go ahead and do so many of you have a certain acre of farmed, then you can only have a certain percentage of the most acres in hemp. Hemp helps the soil. And the problem that they're trying to resolve is, is everybody went in and grew hemp to help their soil. And the huge things that are going to happening are going to happen with him. Well, you don't want to stop growing the other stuff. And don't talk to me about GMOs. Because those kinds of seeds will be burned. We're getting rid of that. We're getting for the whether they call them Ancient Seeds, or whatever hit heritage seeds or whatever it is that you can grow the old stuff instead of all of this GMO garbage. Where sugar these days, as sugar is going out of business, or going out of business, because we're using corn syrup, which is much less expensive to produce. And your body has no idea what corn or corn syrup, it had no idea when I say handsome, no corn syrup, high fructose corn syrup, your body doesn't know what that is. So it stores it as fat. Now I've said to myself, people eat or drink sugar free diet stuff. And so I see that all the fat people are drinking that stuff because it's doesn't taste that good. And that's true because it helps people to get fat because it gives them things that their body doesn't recognize as food, so that stores him. He was just growing more fat. It's just my own philosophy. But those kinds of things that will not persist as long as we are in charge and have the money to be in charge of the food production of this country or anywhere else we reside. We'll do the things that make nutritious food. And we'll stop doing the stuff that these companies use to make money and us having all kinds of diseases. The pharmaceuticals are just really happy about it. The food people just pour it with all kinds of pour their their garbage into our food and pretend like it's nutritious. You know, it's vitamin enhanced, they take everything out of it and throw in a few vitamins and say, it's really good food for you. We're going to change that. And countries, companies that don't want to change it, they will go out of business because they can't afford to do what we're going to do. They can't compete, we have the money. And those kinds of people may not be around anyway. I talk really big, but there's a way to do things with money that is for the best good of mankind. And those people who have gone the different way so that they can make more money and distribute that to us in a way that we get sick, is sickening way is a sickening way of living. Those people who do that to us, including the pharmaceuticals will not be part of our future. Why we'll put them out of business, just with our money. Money is power. And we have the power to change the way that these bad people have been doing to the things that these bad people have been doing to us. And we're going to be doing it for real good purpose. So that's where it's going to be. And if you don't like it, wait till we get some antigravity machines go live somewhere else, because we're going to do things in God's way of doing things. That's just what we have the money to do. purchase of goods and crops, I'd talked a little bit about that. We'll sit down on an annual basis and talk about what foods to grow, what crops to, that we would like. And we'll work out things so that mankind and society is served from the fields all the way to the grocery store. We're going to be involved with it. And we're going to make sure that things are done properly. Because we have the money, isn't that, you know, is that manipulation? I suppose it is. But that's manipulation to get rid of the bad people and the bad things that they're doing to us. Is that a good justification? Let's let God pay the judge. We're gonna do Okay, let's ask some question.
