Hey, everyone, this is Tracy here, Ron can't be with us today. But this is our q&a with Francis and Ryan, who are the developers of the amazing CAC map. And let me just also add that this map is optional, because some people, you know, aren't ready to play this far. And I also want to say that, that you can have a CAC without putting it on the map, it just helps all of us. If we have like, we're looking for gaps, like places that are missing a CAC. So then we can have benefactors go and jump over there. So with that said, I have a lot of questions. We have 79, we're not gonna be able to probably get through all of them. But I will just go ahead and read the question and then turn it over to you guys to answer sound good. That's fine. Okay. So the first question is the CAC map currently located on the quantum computer. So the information as entered is already on a secure server, similar to an even better than the HTTPS.

R Ryan/Francis 01:10

I'll take this one but currently know it we don't have, I don't know anybody that does have access to the quantum computing system. If anybody is able to open that up to me, then I'd be happy to move it over there. But currently, everything that goes into the database is encrypted. It's it's exceeds HIPAA and PCI compliance standards. And, yeah, we're working on getting the SSL certificate so that many of you will not see that annoying morning in your browser. But yeah, as far as, as of right now, we're not on the quantum computing system. And, you know, I'm looking forward to moving that over as soon as we can, probably after RV. So that would be my guess. But that's hopefully that answers the question.

Yep. That is good. Second question from this person is we have only listed one CAC per LWS member. Now that the basic location information has been entered, may we quickly move to CAC map 2.0, please. So we can list in more than one city area or region. And in more than one country, perhaps at a date for those projects starts

on tickets online, we're not ready to move on to the next phase, which is where we open up to more than one CAC. The reason for that is that we're still getting new members coming on board. And we'd like to get a better picture of things as they happen. And if and when it does happen, I think Ron will be the person to make that decision as to you know how we open it up? Exactly.

Yes. And you guys don't want to spread yourself too thin. You know, I mean, at the beginning of this, it's going to be this whole new concept of stepping into a new reality and just practice closer to home. And once you get that well oiled machine going, then you know, you can expand from there without boundaries. Okay, next question. Will the local community have access to CAC locations? I

think that once once the once the RV has happened, and, you know, CAC has actually gone live and started to go live. That's the point at which the local communities would actually we would actually probably see that the CAC site being being sort of opened up to locations. But once again, that is something that that Ron will actually decide. And he will decide exactly when and how that will happen. I hope that answers that question.

Yeah, and I think that it also will be up to the person who sets it up. So the managing director will be the one who's going to start promoting it into the local community. And Ron's not going to probably have a say in that because you guys after the RV, you're sovereign like you are. It's your money, it's your projects. Everything is now on your shoulders. So I would think that that would be up to you. Okay, next question. Can the CAC be registered under a business name and as a nonprofit organization?

I believe you can use whatever name you want to register when you register your individual profile. By clicking the Register button, you can use your alias and then when you create a CAC, it's just a title So it can be whatever you prefer for right now. And as we, like we said, as after RV happens, we'll expand upon the functionality of this and provide an interface for you to add employees apply for grants and different things like that. So all of that will be managed in this information system. Cool.

That's awesome. Okay, can a single CAC be established between two benefactors working

That's awesome. Okay, can a single CAC be established between two benefactors working together in this part of the program?

Yeah, this is, and this is something we're looking into in the future. But right now, it's one CAC, one person like Tracee said at the beginning, this is really just to get us started to kind of say, Okay, here's a step in the right direction to get our, our collective consciousness in the how do I say this already happening phase instead of when will it happen? So, so to, I guess, the best answer that is yes, eventually, like I said, we'll open this up to where you can have a partner and and it will be create an additional user, create and assign a role to that user, and then you have a whole, you have a whole community within your CAC. But for right now, it's just let's get this get some points on the map. So we can see where densely populated CAC's will be versus where we might need to have some more, you know, it's mostly an informational tool at this point. So hopefully, that that helps answer that.

Yes, and here's the crazy thing, you guys is there somebody in my town, and I don't even know who the person is. So of course, I would like to work together and collaborate because many hands make light work. Just remember that this is not a competition. Many hands make light work, let's just partner together joined together. So we can, you know, get this thing going. But you guys like like Ryan just said, this map is not like this hard set firm map, this is just for us to get an idea of where we are like our little footprint. Okay, how do we gain access to the CAC maps I don't recall joining anywhere with LW s to have a password?

Well, the the user needs to go on into a web browser and enter the web address, which is a CAC's dot solutions. And if you entered the wrong address, it will take you to a GoDaddy page. So you know you've got the wrong address in that case. And typically, that happens when you enter CAC dot solutions. So once they get onto that web page, they then have to register and and create an account. And once they've done that, then they can create their own CAC's. As as possible. Well, I don't want to see. So I think that answers that one.

I have additional sites in mind in a neighboring town. And in a neighboring state, the forum only allows me to register my town in the neighboring sites, their rule, which is my focus. Okay, I just want to say that we've pretty much answered that right now you guys are just one, that's it. But that's not going to be the limit for sure. It's just that at the moment, and we'll set a date when you guys can answer or to add more. But for now, it's just that are we to be establishing CAC at this moment in time? Now, the

answer to that is no. Because, you know, really everything that we're doing at this point in time is just preparing. And that is, you know, doing the groundwork to actually, you know, trying to find, you know, managing directors etc plan what's going to go into your, your CAC. And so the and also plan the location of where you're going to have your CAC, so that you're not actually establishing it right now. I think that will happen once the RV happens, and you get your funding. Right.

And like we said earlier, you want to set it up close to home, so that you can have ease of access, like how are you going to say so I'm in California, how am I going to say, Oh, well I really want to start one in the Caribbean because I want to go visit there. Well, it's a lot easier to do it right near you. And so you guys just don't worry you'll be able to go where you want to go as soon as you are ready. But most of these things like we don't have money right now. So how are we going to establish the CAC but what I will add to that is people have put their home addresses in it. And or they've said, Well, I don't have an address. I don't know where I'm going to do this. So just speculate, I picked a building in my town that I thought would make a great option. And so I use that address. So please don't use your home address. Okay, would we be using our own computers for this startup?

I would think that after the RV, we can have as many computers as you want. But yeah, well, actually that I mean, that's my guess is you would probably have to go buy your own supplies, but I don't think that would be a problem.

Yes. Is there an actual starting date for signing out member businesses?

When with we're not at that point is yet so you know, the actual starting date, you know, would be would happen once the CAC is actually live and accepting members of the public. So at that point, you would actually have something you would go into your your CAC, you would edit the location to reflect the correct address, and then you would then have you would change the status to active in which case it would, it would go green. And that means you're live and you're actually starting to sign businesses up?

Yes, it seemed like an address was required. So I put in the address of the place for sale that I'd like to buy. Good idea. When I tried to remove it. I couldn't get back in the site didn't recognize my email and password. I'll answer this. I think I already emailed you. But please you guys, if this happens, and you get locked out, just go to Password Reset under the login tab. Questions

for Ryan and Francis. What are your computer and technical credentials? What companies have you worked for in the past? How did you discover LWS? are you humanitarians? Did the White Hats, military alliance or TLS? send you to Ron, what are the names of the computer software protocols you would implement that would link CAC solutions to the QC and the RSS platform?

Sounds like a job interview? That's right. Do you want to go first? Francis? Oh, yes. Well, I've actually worked. I've been in the IT business for about a good 25 plus years. And I've worked for companies like IBM and Oracle. And I worked as a as a technical consultant for them. And in my last role, I actually looked after the IT infrastructure for a manufacturing company. So how did I discover LWS? Well, I think, just like everybody else, you know, you just get get led to it. And I can't even remember how I got to it. But somehow through telegram and Facebook or emails, I just managed to stumble across it. And and yes, Mr. Humanitarian? I guess I am, because I don't know how to answer that question. You know, what, what? What qualifies you to be a humanitarian? I don't really know. I guess we're all here for a reason. If we if we're in Ron's group. And I would say that, that, if that's the criteria that then yes. Did the White Hats military or RTLs send you to run? Know, what? What are the names of the computer software protocols you would implement that would link CAC solutions to the QC and the RSS platform? We don't know. Well, actually, we have no idea what what the actual software protocols would be, basically, because we haven't even even gotten that far with with the connection to the alliance, as far as that is concerned. But maybe Ryan can actually answer a little bit more if he if he knows. So over to you want. Cool. So what are my computer and technical credentials? So basically, when it comes to software, engineering, I pretty much done everything. websites, mobile app, IoT, and now a lot of machine learning that I've been doing at my current job. I'm currently working on a on a mobile application that interfaces appliances with phones and smartwatches and things like that. It all kind of started with tinkering and just, you know, having that engineering background I guess from college So what companies have I worked for in the past? I've worked for medical companies, government contractors, when I first started out about 15 years ago cannabis companies, again, more medical companies now I work for appliance manufacturing company. So kind of all over the place. How did I discover LW s. So I was part of a, another group that had talked about the Golden Age and doing good for humanity. However, after listening to a few calls, everything, it just didn't feel right. It was more about basically, it sounded like a cabal 2.0, just with different people involved. So I, I had to share these feelings with another member of that group who I think extremely highly of her she has one of the purest hearts I've ever I've ever encountered. And we just didn't did it didn't resonate with us. And she had mentioned the LWS organization. And before that I had kind of started to saying, you know, we don't need and I had said to her, we don't need an organization, we can do this, you know, with limited funding, even going out and being the reason that somebody smiles every day is kind of a humanitarian act. So, you know, we kind of have a few things in my community that you know, we try to we try to do, but it's tough, it is tough without the funding and having to work in nine to five, I'm actually at work right now. So it's, it is tough. But that's that's kind of how I came across this. She She introduced me to it. And then am I humanitarian? Yes, I believe without, without a doubt in my heart that this is why I'm here in this lifetime. So the white hats military alliance with TLS, send you to Ron No. This was strictly a lead by my heart type of a thing. So one of the names of the computer software protocol, oh, this is what Francis said I could. So yeah, we really don't know what the quantum computer quantum computing platform is going to require. My guess based on my technical skills is that it's going to be something to do with Blockchain of which I have tinkered around with. And, you know, as soon as we get the go ahead on Hey, this is how we're going to

implement this into RSS platforms and things like that, then we will go ahead and do that. And we may be even tasked with building the RSS platform. So once we get to go ahead and r&b happens, then I fully intend to hire a software engineering team and build out these systems that are accustomed for everything we want to do. So I think I covered everything. Yep. That's all the questions.

I would like to have a CAC and Centerton, Arkansas, how do I go about submitting my request? Well, once you're at that website, what is the tab they go to register?

R Ryan/Francis 18:05

Yes, that's right. They need to register first, and then create an account and then login. And then they will have the click on the button that says Create a CAC. And it's a spring straightforward after that.

T Tracee 18:23

I am in New Zealand and it won't let me open it any ideas?

R Ryan/Francis 18:31

Brantas didn't you solve a similar issue for somebody who was using a specialized router? Yes, yes, I did. Well, there could be two two reasons why this particular person is having issues. One is that if they if they click on the link upstairs, you know, it'll it might come take them to a page that says it's not secure. And the reason for that is because we haven't actually installed something called an SSL certificate. So that's why some some web browsers will complain about that. And that's, that's nothing to worry about. You can just bypass that and just go straight ahead. Or you can wait until you know we've installed the SSL certificate. The the the other reason of the other reason that people are not getting onto the website, we have one particular person's was using a pocket router from Huawei. And if anybody knows about Huawei, they're actually owned by the the CCP, the Chinese Communist Party, and it's a spying device and it redirects your pages on to somewhere else. And so if you're using something like that, you may have some issues basically, but those are the only two two reasons that I could see why why somebody would not get on to the website.

T Tracee 20:01

Okay, next question. Can we just divide up the town and surrounding area between us and utilize the same CAC office? Yes, you can. I have many potential directors in adjoining state. Can I add these potential CAC directors to my team? Even though my office is an iOS city? Yes, you can. Yeah. I'm just trying to go through these quickly because you guys are not going to have enough time to answer every single one of them. I'm very confused regards to the CAC. I have watched a bit short video, and I'm still very unclear as to whether I need to create a CAC

near where I live. Or if I get on that map and somehow choose a location already created by someone else near me. No, you want to create a CSV near where you live. And if there's others in your area, then you can team up with them later. We have a group of 12, or more humanitarians that meet together for support learning because we love hanging out. Together, we live in New Zealand. See, this is where I have to wrap these things. Hold on, let me see if I can figure this out. Because you guys know how to wrap it. Yeah, if you go into home, we have a group of CAC, or a group of 12, or more humanitarians that meet together learning and hanging out we live in New Zealand and a group of provincial cities that are close in proximity to each other. Can we work collaboratively in one or two buildings to start with, and utilize our combined skills rather than each setting up individual CAC's? Yes, you can do that you can start that way. And then later on, as you guys get a really good oiled machine, you can spread out a little if you choose. I placed my first AC on the map in deep southern Georgia and understand the importance of getting my first one up and functioning. However, I have a son and daughter in law that are interested in becoming assistant managing directors in Savannah, Georgia. Is it possible to list it as my number two CAC I also have someone lined up to start my third in Lawrence, Kansas? If not possible? Is there a projected timeline as to when these could be listed? Currently, there isn't one in either city?

I think they answered this question earlier than we run. And that is that we will lift the restriction of one CAC per person at some stage, but that will depend on when one feels that we're ready for it. Okay.

That was a quick answer. So let me just read this whole thing. I was very surprised I went onto the map and someone had already selected a location in my city within a couple miles of my house. That happened to me too, by the way, so don't sweat it, it doesn't matter. I selected another convenient location, but it put me in a different city after sleeping on it. I went back into the map and edited my previously selected location. My thinking was I didn't want to infringe on someone living in that city who possibly had not gone onto the map yet. Since none of us know whether or not we will be vetted as benefactors or if locations are being selected by individuals actually residing within a city or they're reserving a location based on where they desire to have their CAC, should there be multiple CAC's within a city? If so, should they then be coordinated and offer the same services? Or do you think once a benefactor has pinned to CAC, city location, and another benefactor wants the same city, it would be possible to set up a waiting list? Some studies are very large, some small some divided by geographical features. Okay, that's enough. What do you think?

And if you see somebody close to you, like I just like Tracy, as mentioned, I've seen people near me that, you know, it's amazing, you know, you look at the map, and you see how much help there is out there. So I think that if there is somebody close to you, collaboration would be the next next best thing, because I think, as you pointed out, Tracee that, you know, your hometown, you know, close to you. So doing that will be easier and get your feet wet. You know, running an operation like this, it's going to take, you know, a lot of skills that people don't even realize they're going to need yet. So that will help. And then you'll have the people around you that, you know, even though and you're going to run into this, I'm sure. Even though you're you're humanitarians and out there helping people, they're still going to complain about things. And so you're gonna run into having to deal with that. So it's, I just think that collaboration would be the best option. As far as that goes instead of you know, Well, somebody here already, I need to go somewhere else. And you can but I would say collaborate with them and, and figure things. That's the beauty of all this, there's really anything you want to do, you know. So it's, it's very exciting.

So I would like to eat message that person say, Hey, I'm here to let's meet up and talk, you know, I mean, and just to have somebody that's a friend on this journey together is wonderful.

Well, that's an interesting point that, you know, we have been implementing slash slowly testing an instant message system that we don't quite have a timeline for, because I have about three hours a week to work on this project. So it's, it's slowly coming along. But yeah, there will be the ability probably, I would say it's about a month off around that timeframe, where you'll be able to instant message people back and forth to kind of start collaborating.

Yes. And if the RV happens within the next month, before Ryan actually gets to do that, then he'll be able to quit his job and have more than three hours. party with you, Ryan?

Just to add to that, I mean, we have been discussing that. And we might have been able to do it a bit earlier, but we didn't anticipate that so many people would have problems with trying to get access to the map, etc, and have some of these questions and issues with it. So when we're trying to deal with that first, and then we'll look at the collaboration at a later point.

Okay, um, next question. Thank you for your dedication. I put my CAC into the map that the latitude and longitude, latitude and longitude is wrong. I've tried to edit but it's not possible to edit these details. Can you have them with us?

I can take this. This is probably going to cover a lot of people's questions. The map issue, so I guess I'll back up one option. We chose map box because it's free. And it's not Google. And we all know about Google Plus Google charges, it would have cost us a lot of money to do this with Google. And we don't feel appropriate asking for donations to do this. So we went with matte box, which is an alternative that is free, up until a certain point which we won't reach that point. The problem is that it appears it's having problem with heavy datasets. And we have, I think 1600 CAC's. And it is very strange that that it's randomly choosing CAC's to to omit from the map. And I've actually I have a question into their support. So hopefully I hear back this week on what are the best practices to mitigate that. So don't worry, you're everybody that says that has reached out that has said my thing, my CAC has disappeared, it's still in the database, it's not going anywhere. It's just the map is being very finicky. On which one, it's showing which ones it's omitting and showing. And as far as updating your latitude and longitude manually. That's definitely an option we can look into right now currently, when you type your address in, it's sent to map box, and they geocode it and return latitude and longitude that stored in the database. And that's what is plotting the point on the map. So if you see things are not plotting correctly, then it's the map box API. And like I said, we have we have support questions into them. So as soon as we hear from that, we'll be able to fix that and get everybody plotted on the map. So apologies for that. But we didn't want to go with Google. And I don't think anybody here would have wanted to use a Google product.

Correct. Actually, however, with that said, I'm curious as to because of Trump's executive orders, I can't remember if it's 1-381A or 1384A wonder who actually owns Google right now. Like if the white hats have absorbed all of those traders assets, you know what I mean? True.

So that's a good point. The other aspect of that is we would be charged and I think it would have been about \$100 for the last month that we would have had to have asked for donations for or one of us would have had to pay.

Yeah, so it's good. Look, it's good for now. Okay. I think we're close anyway. So, okay, well there become a way when we have our money where we can edit our CAC contact details, like a phone or website. Absolutely,

The street address is shown and on Mapquest anyone can find the city by looking at the map, many of our email addresses have an indication of our names, how much of our personal information are we willing to disclose or have to disclose? Cuz that's up to you?

Yeah, it really is. We, like I said, the data that's in the database is encrypted. But yeah, it's whatever you want. I mean, you can use a fake name. And an alias title for your CAC, you can guess what you can do is if we decide to open up filling out latitude and longitude, manually, then I can program it to where you don't need to enter an address, you can just enter the coordinates and we can go that way. But yeah, it's really I mean, we're going to kind of gauge that on feedback and, and make decisions from there. So.

Right. And, like, like we said earlier, everybody has their own choice, but your email address is not shown on the map. It's only used when we register so that they have a way to contact you if necessary, like I can't even see anybody's email addresses. So as for now, your privacy is still you know, 100% there. Okay, are these potential CAC centers equivalent or potential sites for redemption centers? No. Nothing to do with redemption centers? Will the map be used for benefactors to contact each other? I guess

My question is could we possibly be allowed to have one or two more proposed Tacs on the map providing they are in a neighboring village or town perhaps they could be colored differently on the map to show that although advertise now they will be functional after the main one. Otherwise I'm thinking of naming my CSD differently to incorporate the neighboring village until they have their own

address and I'm not sure what to do. I think I emailed them back and said to reset your password using the login page okay, I just want to confirm with my husband and I both been benefactors is our planning to open our first CAC together the CAC is under My Account and our thinking is that he doesn't duplicate the same location. Is that correct? Yes, that is correct. Okay, I filled out the information for the CAC we are setting up in St Martin in the Caribbean when it first was entered, it was pinned in the correct place on the island of St. Maarten. It was the correct longitude and latitude. I saw that I made a spelling error went back into the system and fix the spelling error, then it changed the longitude longitude to somewhere else in the US. And he helped her ideas there.

Sounds like a Mapbox went into the system fix the spelling. Yeah, if you don't change the address, any parts of the address, then it doesn't. It's not programmed to recalculate latitude longitude. So just changing a spelling error unless it was in your address, then that was not recalculated. So it's just not box being finicky. And I have no idea as to why it's choosing the ones that it's choosing to display and not display. So hopefully this week, we'll have more light shed on that.

That's already very doable without going on any map. Not to scare anybody, but this is 2022. So you'd be surprised at what is already known about you just walking up the street. So
