Toilet and shower for Ger district households in Mongolia ES#101

Current issues – No shower and modern toilet for the families who live in ger districts.

A **ger district** (Mongolian: гэр хороолол, *ger khoroolol*) is a form of residential district in Mongolian settlements. They usually consist of parcels with one or more detached houses or gers (hence the name), surrounded by two-meter high wooden fences. In other countries, gers are known as yurts.

Most ger districts are not connected to water supplies, so people get their drinking water from public wells. Since there is no sewer system, ger district parcels usually have a pit toilet.

For a warm shower or a bath, families need to go to a public bathhouse or ask to use a bath or shower from relatives and friends who live in an apartment. I live in a two-bedroom apartment in Ulaanbaatar. Every weekend our parents, and relatives about 5 to 7 people who live in ger districts come to our place to have a shower. We have four children, and it has been challenging for us. But we help them to get cleaned anyway.

Small settlements, like town centers, may consist almost exclusively of ger districts. Even in Mongolia's capital Ulaanbaatar, around 62% of the population live in such districts. I grew up in a small town where everyone lived in ger districts. Our town had less than ten buildings including school, childcare, medical center and shops. These buildings still do not have any toilets or bathrooms, so people had to use pit toilets. Children fear using the pit toilets because they might accidentally fall into the pit and some children lose their lives by falling into the pit.

Toilet and shower for ger district households in Mongolia

I am planning to help people who live in ger districts in Mongolia to replace the pit toilet with a modern toilet and install a shower.

There are a number of small businesses making a modern toilet and shower, the price is \$2000-5000 approx. which is too expensive for the families. We will implement this project in two steps.

1st step. We will choose 500 families and help them with funds to replace toilets and install showers.

In Ulaanbaatar, residential development has been expanding to the ger districts. Government plans to buy land and provide an apartment for people. Therefore, we will choose ger districts that are not located in the city development area or outside of Ulaanbaatar.

2nd step. We will expand our project to 2-3,000 families per year. We will replace toilets for schools and childcare centers in the small towns.

We also support businesses who are making the toilets and showers and who is installing them for households.

EMBROIDERY COMPANY OLGA COLLECTION DESIGNER ES#106

Business in the format of a garment factory. All the difference from the previous version is the scale of the company. When you start the factory, you will look for investors or raise your considerable capital, look for wholesale buyers and sell at retail outlets, dozens of employees will be subordinate to you. This is a complex business, and people come to it gradually, adjusting all business processes.

Own studio. This is a form of work in the service sector. In fact, you will carry out orders for fitting clothes and other textile products, their repair and tailoring of individual products. You will also need space, equipment, staff. Customers are attracted by the successful location of the point, for example, in a shopping center, advertising on social networks or on bulletin boards.

Computer embroidery to order. This business can be run from home. This service is sold both for individuals, for embroidery on personal items: T-shirts, wallets, bags, etc., as well as for commercial organizations that order branding of things, such as uniforms or some accessories

Machine knitting. Another subspecies of the clothing business, which allows you to make products to order, for example: gloves, socks, slippers, scarves, hats, and more.

As you can see, there are many options for activities in this niche, you can choose the most relevant for you and proceed to assess the competition in the market and develop a detailed business plan for the clothing business.

- Casual clothes for adults and children.
- Tracksuits.
- Overalls.
- Clothes for animals.
- Curtains, curtains, lambrequins.
- Slings.
- Bags.
- Stuffed Toys.
- Bed linen, tablecloths.

Room selection

The first organizational issue that you will face is the choice of premises for the sewing workshop. There are a number of requirements, based on which you can filter out inappropriate options.

- Room area. Here you need to look at the business goals. For example, for a small studio there will be enough space from 10 sq.m. For a workshop, you need to look for options from 80 sq.m., and for a full-fledged factory, over 250 sq.m.
- Accommodation will also depend on the format of the work. For the factory and workshop, it is not important, but for the atelier it is desirable to be located in passable places, for example, in the shopping center, where customers will contact, for example, to shorten trousers or adjust the size.
- The room must have the following communications: electricity, heating, plumbing, sewerage, ventilation and fire safety systems.
- Usually the room is divided into zones: a hall, a working area, a fitting room, a bathroom.
 - Your task is to find the most cost-effective premises in order to reduce the monthly costs of your business, and speed up the process of return on investment.
 - Equipment for work
 - A small tailoring business from various fabrics involves the purchase of a set of equipment necessary for the work. So, the budget for this item of expenditure will depend on the level of the same sewing machines (amateur or industrial), the manufacturer's company and the availability of different functions in the machines themselves.
- Sewing machines. There are several types, each with its own purpose. Straight stitch - designed to work with both light and heavy fabrics. Hemming - used to finish the bottom and edges of the product, creates a blind seam. Flat- seam - for processing the bottom, neck and sleeves of various knitted items. Loop - for sewing loops on various products.
- Overlock . It is used for overcasting sections of textile materials.
- Furrier machine. For work with fur products.
- Table for cutting materials.
- Dummy.
- Rack with hangers for products.
- Tables and chairs for masters.
- A set of scissors, patterns, rulers.
- Dressing room. Will be used by your customers when trying on products.
- Iron with ironing board.

Cabinets and racks for storing fabrics, threads and other consumables.



Their consumables you will need:

- Fabrics.
- Cuffs.
- Threads of various sizes and colors.
- Buttons locks and other accessories for products.
- Chalk and pencils.

Finding suppliers of fabrics and accessories is a responsible step in the clothing business, and you need to be very meticulous about it so as not to lose your money on the same fabrics that you will not be able to use in your products later.

Staff

- If you work in the format of a small workshop, then it makes no sense to hire staff and it is better to work on your own. Only after you receive more orders than you can handle, can you think about finding a seamstress who will work with you. This should be an experienced master who will come and work right away, teaching from scratch is not profitable, often such students leave as soon as they gain skills and either look for a better job, or immediately start taking orders from home and work for themselves.
- All work related to clients, you must carry out independently. This is advertising, receiving calls and service in the workshop. Otherwise, your seamstress can lure the client and fulfill orders for her outside of your workshop.
- The salary of the master on average can be \$300 \$400 in the regions. In large cities, the level of salaries will be higher. It is better to tie earnings to a percentage of the work performed in order to motivate an employee to work and make a profit for your company.
- Accounting can be outsourced, as well as connect a sewing workshop to a security company on the remote control.

Search for markets for goods or services

Before you open a sewing business, it is important to think over in advance all the channels for finding customers for your product or service. This is important, given the presence of competition, in addition, advertising costs will need to be included in the business plan as an expense item.

Here are the main working approaches to finding clients in this niche.

- Own website + contextual advertising + search engine promotion of the resource.
 You should have a product catalog, or a list of services with a portfolio of work, so that customers can find you through Google
- Boards of announcements. They work especially well for advertising services for repair, fitting or tailoring. You can also sell ready-made fabric products. There is also paid accommodation here.
- Marketplaces for wholesalers on the Internet.
- Social networks. Create groups or pages and post photos of work, customer reviews, price lists and other information. With the help of paid advertising, you can get new subscribers who may become your customers in the future.
- Direct calls for buyers. Usually these are either clothing stores, or in the case of tailoring firms.
- Advertising in print media.





These are the main costs, they will differ from the specifics of running a sewing business. For example, if you work from home on your own, then the rent and wage points go away, and the amount of start-up capital will be much less. The same applies to rent in various regions of the country.

- Atelier and shop
- Repair shop
- Narrow-profile atelier

Master of all trades - atelier for tailoring versatile clothing

- We sew at home

It is often those who have worked professionally in this field, for example, seamstresses or cutters, who often decide to open their own sewing business. In fact, such experience alone is not enough to organize a profitable business.

When planning the opening of a sewing studio, you need to clearly think over the strategy of its activities, find a suitable working space, and hire the necessary qualified employees. One of the key issues is to work out real ways to attract customers. Therefore, it is imperative to draw up a detailed business plan with careful planning of expected income, required expenses and taking into account all possible risks. The business plan should determine the payback period of the studio and the amount of expected profit from its activities.

 Before you open a tailoring workshop, you should clearly define the set of services that it will provide. Perhaps it will be the creation of designer clothes and its sale, or a highly specialized direction. For example, sewing wedding dresses, making overalls or a simple repair shop. The main thing is to decide on your niche, since the business plan should contain real calculations for a specific project. The costs of organizing a multi-profile garment production are much higher than when creating a small clothing repair workshop. Also, each clothing business puts forward very different requirements for premises, equipment and personnel.



WHICH STUDIO CAN BE OPENED

To open, you can choose the following types of sewing:



- A small atelier for the repair of clothes;
- Tailoring of narrow-profile clothes;
- Tailoring by individual order of diverse clothing;
- Tailoring of designer clothes for subsequent sale;
- Opening a franchising studio .

A clothing repair shop is the simplest and least expensive investment option. It is much more difficult to create a salon-type atelier.



Atelier and shop

This is a union of 2 different directions - sales and tailoring. You can trade clothes made in the atelier, sell sewing accessories and at the same time provide tailoring services.

Another option is to buy ready-made clothes in bulk and sell them in the store. This is a good way to attract additional customers and increase business profitability. However, free funds are needed for the purchase of goods and an increase in the cost of remuneration of sellers.

Repair shop

You can't make big money here. However, much less investment is needed to get started. Over time, you can develop and expand this business.

Narrow-profile atelier

For this kind of activity, the correct location and the presence of an extensive client base are important. For example, sewing wedding dresses will be successful if the atelier is located near the registry office or a salon for organizing special events. And it is most reasonable to sew overalls in industrial zones near numerous factories that need such a service.

It is worth buying only specialized sewing equipment - this will reduce start-up costs.

MASTER OF ALL TRADES - STUDIO FOR TAILORING OF DIFFERENT CLOTHES

This is the most expensive type of garment business to enter. The purchase of a wide range of equipment requires significant costs. Competent selection of personnel is one of the key points. It is necessary to find high-class professionals with practical experience. You can hire generalists, another option is to form a team of experts in their field. With proper organization and proper planning, this option atelier will pay off the fastest.

WE SEW AT HOME



A home business allows you to save on rent, because all the equipment will be installed at home. However, this method of organization is only suitable for a small workshop.

BUYING A FRANCHISE

Starting a sewing business in this way is a costly undertaking. The cost of the first installment can reach 1 million hryvnia. Pluses - work under the wing of a well-known brand, which itself is engaged in advertising and attracts customers. The main thing is to meet the requirements. This method pays off within a few years.

HOW TO ANALYZE AND CORRECTLY DESCRIPTION THE SALES MARKETS

The success of the implementation of the business plan depends on a competent and carefully conducted analysis of the clothing market, a sober assessment of the capabilities of competitors and the correct calculation of the number of potential customers. It is necessary not only to study someone else's successful and unsuccessful experience, but also to develop a plan in case of unforeseen situations, crises and unfair competition.



DETERMINING THE TARGET AUDIENCE

Location significantly affects the number of customers and their requests. The sleeping areas of large cities are more in need of a small repair shop than a large and respectable salon-studio. It is preferable to place it in the central part.

Only a balanced analysis and a reasonable approach will bring success to any business. There are no trifles here - you should take into account the availability of convenient transport interchanges, parking spaces near the studio. The client will become yours only if he will be comfortable and hassle -free visiting the institution.

WHAT ARE YOU BETTER THAN OTHERS?

Of course, the ideal option is when there are no competitors nearby. But sometimes their presence allows you to perfectly develop your business. The client must understand that contacting your studio is beneficial for him, that here he can receive a greater range of services or a higher quality of service. Studying the mistakes and achievements of competitors allows you to organize your work in such a way as not to repeat their mistakes and improve your level. Find exactly your differences and advantages for business - tell about them in advertising, on the outside of the atelier, in leaflets and business cards.

THERE IS NO ADVERTISING



What a high-quality and timely advertising company can do, there is no need to explain. Any marketing moves are good if they contribute to the success of the business. From leaflets and ads in newspapers to promotion in social networks and on the Internet. By the way, a bright and stylish sign has never been superfluous.

HOW TO OPEN YOUR BUSINESS

After determining the direction of activity and the type of atelier, it's time to start organizational issues. Starting costs according to average calculations will be from 120 to 250 thousand hryvnias. Of course, the final figure may change under the influence of many circumstances, but even with the most optimistic scenario, it will not be possible to open a clothing business for less than 80 thousand hryvnias. It is important to consider that the profit will appear later, and the costs will start from the first day. It is necessary not to forget about this when calculating.

HOW TO DOCUMENTS



There are two options for the official start of activity - to register as a private entrepreneur or open a legal entity. In the case of one owner, the registration of a state of emergency is easier in registration and in the further payment of taxes. To pay salaries, employees need to register with the Pension Fund. You also need to open a bank account. You can entrust the execution of documents to lawyers, but this will at least double the costs. Registration costs will range from 2000 to 6000 hryvnia.

HOW TO FIND A ROOM

To choose the necessary room, it is worth deciding not only on its area, but also on the location. Passage places with a large crowd of people are preferable to quiet and calm lanes. The repair shop is ideally placed in a shopping mall or market. Such services are in great demand here - many people need to fit new clothes or fix old ones. The disadvantage of such a lease can be a considerable price. Larger studios can rent a larger room in a passageway near a multi-storey building or on the ground floor. Price for 1 sq.m. the rent here will be much lower.

WHAT SHOULD BE IN THE STUDIO ROOM

The premises for placing a garment business object in it must meet the minimum requirements:

- There is a bathroom;
- Conducted electricity of the required power;
- Useful area not less than 10 sq.m;
- Providing uninterrupted heating in winter and air conditioning in summer.

WHAT EQUIPMENT YOU WILL NEED AND WHERE TO BUY

The cost of purchasing sewing equipment should be accurately calculated in the business plan, because it is one of the main items of expenditure. It is better to contact a specialized trading company to buy everything you need in one place and save money.



Need to purchase:

- Sewing machine for basic operations -
- or hemming
- Overlock -
- Cutting knives -
- Professional steam iron -
- Ironing boards -

It is necessary to provide the studio with consumables . You will also need to equip a fitting room with a mirror, take care of providing adequate lighting and fire protection equipment.

RECRUITMENT

For a repair shop, it is enough to hire one employee to help you.



However, for the work of the atelier, it is required to attract professional craftsmen - you will need a cutter and a seamstress. An experienced accountant is needed to maintain financial documents. The right staff will help your business grow and succeed. To assess the professional skills of the applicant, it is worth offering him to complete a practical task - this way you can quickly and accurately identify a good specialist.

STAGES AND TERMS OF PROJECT IMPLEMENTATION

First you need to develop a well-thought-out business plan, then find a premise and register a business.

Drawing up a financial plan

The financial plan should contain calculations of start-up investments and fixed costs. To calculate the payback period of the studio, you need:

- 1. Take into account all initial costs for registration, rental of premises, purchase of sewing equipment and consumables, advertising, etc. On average, at least 120 thousand hryvnias will come out.
- Determine the average monthly income. The planned daily income is calculated
 as follows the average cost of the service is multiplied by the number of orders.
 The result is multiplied by the number of working days in a month. After
 deducting taxes and social contributions, the average monthly income is
 obtained.
- 3. Divide the sum of the total start-up costs by the average monthly income. This will turn out the period for which the studio will pay off. Usually it is from six months to 10 months. The situation is worse if the payback period is more than 1 year.

ACCOUNTING FOR REGULAR PAYMENTS Regardless of the profitability of the business, you will have to pay monthly:



- For renting a room;
- For the consumption of electricity and other utilities;
- For advertising;
- Wages:
- Social contributions and taxes;
- For the purchase of new consumables.

HOW LONG DOES IT POSSIBLE TO START WORK

In reality, taking into account all the necessary actions, the average launch time for such a project is six months from the moment the business is registered. This is important to consider when drawing up a business plan.

In order for a business to become successful, it is important to do your job professionally, to treat the problems and concerns of customers with understanding. A high level of service almost always helps to achieve the planned result.

New Firefighting Service For Vietnam ES#107

On behalf of the people of Vietnam I am writing to seek support from The Alliance for a complete overhaul of the national firefighting service as it is grossly inadequate and mismanaged at present due to antiquated equipment and insufficient funding.

New Ambulance Service For Vietnam

ambulance service. The war ended many decades ago but the vast majority of people are still living in an impoverished state from the willful neglect of the government. The populations' health is of little importance to the regime.

The rapid increases in the population of the major cities and the country, insufficient number of ambulances, shoestring budget, inadequate staffing and training, have had a detrimental impact on the health of the people.

Problem: Michigan has 4 of the 5 Great Lakes which account for 1/5th of the world's surface freshwater supply! On each of these lakes are many recreational resources such as boat launches, marinas, fisheries, boat rentals, canoeing & tubing liveries, fishing charter boats, cruises, sailboat charters, and ferries. https://www.michigan.org/ferry-services. Many of these facilities and services rely on state funding (which may dwindle or be eliminated) and low user fees.

Solution: Provide RSS, BOCA, ECS for owners and staff that run the marinas, boat launches, boat rentals, etc. Provide Grants to restore/upgrade/rebuild/create/maintain facilities and equipment.

Problem: My husband and I love to travel and usually it is in nature and with a camper. We heavily utilize the Rest Areas on our trips. Many rest areas are very old and run down. They tend to provide only junk food, if they have vending machines at all. Some provide information and tourist brochures for the local areas or state. Some provide historical information with a museum. Many are also 'home' for truckers on the road as a place for them to stop their truck and get their required rest.

Solution: Provide RSS, ECS for staff that clean Rest Area facilities and share local information. Provide grants to restore/upgrade/rebuild rest areas to be more welcoming and modern, and offer healthier choices for snacks and food. I also feel that Rest Areas could provide shower services for the truckers (to be investigated). It would be nice to get small restaurants with healthy food to be onside, to have indoor seating when the weather is inclement. Some rest areas have local artisan artistry for sale. It would be fun to add a local gift shop flare to the rest areas. And where appropriate, add more historical displays at all rest areas, not just welcome centers.



Providing fresh water to indigenous peoples in the Solomon Islands ES#112

Background and Problem:

According to Wikipedia - accessed on the Internet on September 26, 2022, these are some of the basic facts about the Solomon Islands:

- It is a sovereign country a Constitutional Monarchy with a parliamentary system of government. (King Charles III was head of state at the time of this writing -October 7, 2022).
- The Solomons consists of six major islands, and over 900 smaller and very remote islands - located in Oceania.
- The islands have a land area of 11,000 square miles.
- As of 2020, the population was 686,884.
- Of the 686,884 islanders, only 159,686 (23%) live in what are called urban areas; a vast majority 77% live in remote areas (527,198), mostly small villages on widely scattered small islands.

Land generally is still held on a family or village basis. Land may be handed down from a mother to a daughter (matriarchal); while rights to fishing areas are handed down from father to son (patriarchal), or according to local custom.

These islands lack even basic electricity. Islanders live a very primitive subsistence lifestyle, using dugout canoes for fishing.

There are many Human rights concerns and issues with regard to education, water, sanitation, gender equality, and domestic violence.

Scarcity of fresh water sources and lack of sanitation has been a constant challenge facing Solomon Islanders. An estimated 70% of Solomon Island schools have no access to safe and clean water for drinking, washing and relieving of waste. Lack of safe drinking water in school-age children results in a level of high risk for cholera and typhoid.

Possible Solutions:

Use of some form of desalination of ocean water and/or:

Use of new and developing technologies that extract drinkable water from the air.

Outcome(s):

- Clean drinking water
- Up to each island and their Chief, if they want fresh water basins for washing;
- Fresh water shower(s).
- Reduction in cholera, typhoid and other diseases associated with lack of hygiene.
