But the biggest problem is, is having those larger group meetings that can be effective. So And in reality, you know, I have not gone through this before. And so it may be that we'll we'll do things on a more of a local basis. We'll have to see about that. Because as desirable as it might be, sometimes just the numbers, even with just this chat, there's 200, and some odd and I'm not sure how many are on there today, but we're over probably over 200 and under 300, I don't know. But it makes it sometimes it's difficult for everybody to get a chance to get their questions answered, and so forth. So I'd like to see something. It's a desirable situation. But for now, I'm not sure how to accomplish that. The technology might be coming up, and it'll be a slam dunk two points for us. We'll see how that goes. But for right now, we don't have the funds for it. And it's it's not a difficult task, but there it is. So, but I think it's a good.

And if that's all you've set up, in your mind, and you get it done, what are you going to do for the other 98 years that you've got 1.25 quintillion per quarter Kamini? So the OG This is why I say they are not funding your projects, they're funding you. And you will find the projects that you want to do because he's a humanitarian. There's a lot of things about a humanitarian that others don't have. Money will not change us. Doesn't matter how much you give us. It's just more opportunities to serve. Now we're not void of the need for money. And we're not disregarding the abundance mentality that it can bring to us. But money is not the only thing in life that can be abundant, but about the abundance of love and care and concern for other people. Those are some of the really good values that we should have. If I give the money to humanitarians, this is what they liked it if I give the money to humanitarians, I know that they will continue to do things appropriately. We're not We didn't choose them. And then all of a sudden they get the money and say, Oh, good, now we got our money, we can build up a legacy for our family and live on top of the mountain or wherever you want to live. And and have everybody come and look at you and see how wonderful you are. That's not what humanitarians do. And yet there are those who are drawn to that, too, in the beginning, and then they'll find that their their desire for doing humanitarian work somehow goes out the window, and they look for things like how can I make myself look better for other people? Those are the kinds of things that humanitarians don't do that way and you're hiding behind some of that stuff. You're going to be shown like a beacon at night, when you go to your appointment. They'll see through all of the pretension, all of the stuff that you're really not that you think you are. Hopefully that will mean that we have a chance to change and then changing. That means that we get to accomplish what we're trying to accomplish as becoming humanitarians. That's the way I look at it. Well,

thank you, Ron in in two things about that, that just seem such to the point. For example, I think about this all the time is that, you know, the first step in this process, once redemption is completed is the ability to just get the RSS started and get that done. But like you said, eventually everybody will be on an RSS program. And then what's next? What do you do next? And then the other point of that is the words that you speak, I don't hear this at all, from any other so called person that's discussing redemption, or the process of redemption, and what it takes to be truly being humanitarian, you're the first one I've heard, say, you know, it's not really about the money, it when you really think about it. And I just think it's such a valid and strong point that no one else is speaking to. So I want to thank you for that. But I think it's really, really important to understand that we got to look beyond just the fact that we're going to be funding programs and processes. It's not just about the funding, it's it's doing the work of a humanitarian that kind of goes beyond all that. Would you agree?

I do. I have to agree. And, you know, one of the I'll just share one of the failures that I have made dealing with the Alliance so some people came to me with these larger bonds, and they wanted me to help them to get them redeemed. And and then we finally it was somebody from

Italy who was a, an Arab from Egypt. And it seemed like a fairly nice person and I was trying to calm to date him and help him to realize that he's got some really valuable things there for humanitarian work. I was thinking he was a humanitarian, but in reality was part of the whatever they are over there. And and I had had misjudged him. And his family had all of these big bonds and, and between them, they had probably a couple of 100 of these larger bonds. We're talking about the centennial son sent in 10, trillions, excuse me, and higher the 100 quintillion notes and error bonds and that sort of stuff. Well, eventually, I just, I had to just simply pull away because I was told that I have made a bad judgment, I have made an error in judging this person, and for Did that hurt. But we can do that. Because we're we're getting out of our line. I'm not here to help people really with getting funds. It sounds like that. But that's without the funds, you're not a humanitarian, you can't do things that you can do with the with the fence. And so I'm here to promote getting the higher funds, but once you get the funds is what you do with them that proves your entity as the humanitarian. And so where do you focus? What is your focus? Right now we're focusing on getting the money, when we get the money, our focus will change. The RSS program will just simply function. And we won't have much to do with it. Our CAC programs are the things that are really going to require our time here some people what am I I'm not sure how they're to promote the RSS program and what should I do? And I've been thinking about all of these different ways to do it. And why do you do that? Our program is designed for a million people to be signing up at the same time. And that's not going to happen from 11,000 zim benefactors. Now it goes out and spreads like wildfire, because that's the way it's supposed to go. Our job is to focus on the other things that the RSS program beneficiary program will take care of itself, through the referral program that's designed that way. So we don't have to worry about that. And as directors, all of my directors, if they sign somebody up, they get the point for their bonus programs their beneficiary program. So there's, there's things that can happen. But the focus of what we're trying to do is to stay in alignment with the heavens, as long as we're in alignment with the heavens will get the job done. If we go outside of that, then I tried to help these people and they weren't the right ones. And I was my job is to help people. So that's what I was trying to do. That's what I perceive. Other people I've helped humanitarians and it's been really grateful that and, and worked out really good. So

Well, we can break it up into small segments and discuss those but yes, it's the overall direction that we're traveling, that is going to help us to become successful and what we're accomplishing and how we respond to the different colonies that we get. Some people are going to want to spend their energies on healthy stuff, and promoting those kinds of things and maybe even putting up med beds and, and that sort of thing. But once it's established and it works on its own, and how are you going to run it? How are you going to make it bigger and all you can those are the projects that that can once it's finished once a clink has happened going

on and going I guess you'd go to the next clinic and set that up and or you go to the next farming and get up their their ability to do to do organic gardening or farming, gardening but farming him products and all that sort of stuff. So there's a lot that we can work on. I look at 6000 patents that have been put aside because they mess up the the economy the way the Cabal has done it. And if you don't believe that's a true truism, I'm here to tell you that and it is, there are some people who created a flying, you call it a spaceship. And they went through, they build it, and it was under the auspices of Tesla, and but some of the people who, who trained with him built it. And it was used, and then they decided they'd like to go to and sell it to somebody and the people that it was confiscated, the whole process was confiscated, and told that they're never to do that, again. But the projects are things that can can be completed, and then you move on to something else. And you don't have to sit there and only do one project at a time, you can do many at a time. And those who have a lot of money can do more projects. It can get involved in, you know, technology, you build the prototype, and then you figure out how to manufacture it, then you have to manufacture it, and then you have to figure out how to how to distribute it. All of those things take money. Well, that's an opportunity that we have, because we have the money. And sometimes there's things that we're going to put money and that will go obsolete in a couple of two or three years, does that matter? No, it's a step at a time. We said, well, I wasted all my money on that. Knowing I did kinda, I'd have an idea that it's not going to be of any value, because some new technologies can come around. And so you start kicking yourself around because you're wasting, you didn't waste money, you had money to spend on it, you did and then you move to the next level. That's the way things are gonna happen for us. So if you if you get to 200, or the 12 million or 11 million, whatever, for 118. Now that you're going to do humanitarian work in your neighborhood, you're going to build wheelchair ramps and all that sort of thing for people. But that's about the end. I watch your money's gone, where you're going to do. There's no continuous source of that money. So you're going to be skimpy and save and try and create for yourself. The Cabal does things like that the alliance does structured payout for hundreds of years. So which would you rather have? And those are the kinds of things that we're looking at. I'm rambling on here, but

And I have my family members in the force, police force, that are very well known in the town, and they work in the courthouse. These are projects that I there in my mind, I know I'm going to accomplish them. It's you're right, you're absolutely right. It's thinking about the project is not just about the money, you get the money and think of all the things you can do with the abundance of money there is to continue doing it for hundreds of years. You see 100 years, and I think we should I'm doing more than 100 years. And the money is staggering of what we're getting if they give it to
