The other information about the programs is yes, it's important. And it's and I'm not trying to diminish

them. But the appointment preparation is the most important thing now. Because if we have a limited amount of time, then the preparations are the thing that are going to get us the money, we need to become the humanitarians that we want to become. And you can disregard your preparations and focus on some of the other stuff, and then you haven't, then you go to your appointment and you don't have the funds because you haven't prepared for it. So that's what I say to people prepare to do the preparations first for your appointment, and then dive into the rest of it and become familiar with everything. You know, I was a pilot and flew t 38. I went through pilot training in a t 38. There was a one thing that I was not taught in the classroom that was not necessary for me to understand. And when I got up in that airplane, it's not so expensive, but boy, it goes fast. And I had to have everything on the tip in my mind and had to have the recall just perfectly so that I could perform at a high very high level in functioning as a pilot. Now, we're going to be doing things similar and it's not just pilots, it's there's so many different areas of our lives. It's the jargon, you get into the jargon with the people that you're working with. And somebody outside that doesn't really understand what you're talking about. So you really get involved to the point where you become what you're trying to accomplish. And when I became when I was going as a sole student going up and I was but towards the end of my training, I got so good that I can almost feel the air going over the wing. Use of the aircraft as I was moving. And I could, I could almost feel it in the stick as I moved to about and did the things that I was doing. And I became one with that aircraft. Not always. But I did become one with that aircraft two or three different times. And the more time that I'd spend would spend in it, the more I would that was capable of doing on a more permanent basis. But I, you know, it's a year and then you're finished. I got into helicopters after that in the National Guard. So. But what I'm trying to say is that everything you learn about love won society can be used to become a better humanitarian. And you'll find that if you're ready for it, people can start asking you questions. And you'll be surprised at how well you can answer the questions because you already know what it's about. And that's where you want to be. So when it comes time to train your, your directors, when it comes time to set up your program, the more you know, the easier it will be and the more functionality you will have as a humanitarian as a zim benefactor or managing director as you get into the program. So don't let anything go by and say, Well, I don't need to know that. Because you're probably going to need to know that information as you get into it. So it's just a word to the wise, prepare in every way that you possibly can to be the best that you can be. Okay, alliances appointment information. The most important thing to understand is that there will be an alliance agent there who perhaps is somebody that you know, that's resurrected, or came back for to help you. And this other gentleman's father, bye, bye, he's asking for somebody like that. And that might be true, that might be the way it's going to work out, I would be very surprised, I would not be surprised if it was somebody that you already knew, that you already had built a lot of confidence with. And that knows you, and you know them. And it just starts out so much better that way, rather than the awesomeness of being introduced to an angel and that dilaton. And you will feel comfortable, you will feel enlightened, you will feel the love, you feel all of these things, and it'll bring you to tears to a little bit. And you'll have a territory in your eye. And is that not just appropriate. So let that all take place. It'll be just perfect for you. So we have two more little sections here. How about if we go through those, we've only got about another 10 minutes left? And then see if we have a question or two at the end. Okay, purchase Zim bonds, where to buy Zim bonds, how much sim is needed? And do I also need to buy currency?

Oh, those are really good questions. First of all, where to buy Zim bonds. Here's the problem with Zim. The ones that they say are certified and their 2008 Double A series bonds that you pay the 250 to \$300 for and it's risen that high because people are buying them all over the place thinking that they're humanitarian, thinking that they'll get redeemed and get all of these this money. That's why the price has gone up. So high. Zim bonds, they printed hundreds and

hundreds of 1000s of these. I know one, one person who has a box of 40,100 T note. They sell and buy the box loads. And the point that I'm trying to say is that there's a lot of but the price has gone up. If you get into the the gold bonds and the silver bonds that you can find on eBay. You can get those for real dirt cheap 2100 T notes for \$17. I think it's \$16 Plus, then 99 cents for delivery. That's out of California. There's another one that's only 10 \$15. There's some of the higher values, face values of Zim that Like a bicentennial, send tilian that you can buy for \$3.25 and 99 cents for delivery out of Duluth, Georgia. Okay, if that's available, you buy one of those and, and ask for 500,000 or a million dollars for that. And you're going to be on the list of the alliance will could use to call for people who have prepared themselves to do some of the greater work. Because that's could be a tremendous amount of money, but just one bond. So you can buy a whole bunch of 100 T notes for just one of these. And you're set. So if you were to want those higher face value I can send, if you email me, I will send you the links. I don't do any fraternizing with you or anything, I just send you the information. So it doesn't take me very long at all. Do I need to buy currency? No. Currency is a symbol of water in the ocean, compared to the Zim. So once you have the Zim, then you don't need the currencies. A lot of people think that they'd like to redeem, exchange the currencies, and have some personal funds and use that for them. That's what they won't do that by the idea of personal funds. You know, for me, the dog that I have is just going into the domain, mother lode, we didn't talk about that. I've got just a second here, I'm going to talk about it.

Okay. The constant focus on yourself that sometimes that would mean Oh, I get to be selfish. No, no. If you don't have the humanitarian part, or you do have it and you want to develop it more, then you focus on yourself. You focus on the things that you want. Not, not things that other people want, or other people say, or other people are searching for. I don't listen to a whole lot of stuff, I have my favorites. But I can spend a lot of time on those and then not getting anything done. So I focus on the things that are important to me. And so that's the best way for you to go. Telegram chat room, I think is really good. It's just it's, it's, it should be fun to go there and just read what's going on. And I, if I do, I spend hours in there. And just to kind of get a flavor for who people are and what they're doing. And then we have the voice chats every week. So but on the contents, focus for yourself. I think that that's important. So that's, that's where I come from. So final comments and things like that. Your gym is is something that you can determine in your your heart will help you to know how much zim you need to have and what rate to ask. And it's important for you to get into that to the point where you really understand what your focus is when you have your appointment. Once that's taken care of then you're set for a long time. Please understand that the all funds, all funds are redemption funds go into the structured payout system. And there's people who say, Well, I'm going to do as Jim for this and I'm going to do Zim for that I'm going to they're all going into the same structured payout. What you do then with the money is up to you. But the structured payout, if you don't understand what that is, if you don't understand what that is. You're being derelict in your responsibilities. That's like saying, well I need fuel in the aircraft. You always look and see if you got enough fuel. And before you take off your check and see if you've got a full tank

because somebody forgot to take you out. That's essential for you. Because those of the funds that you will have for the next 100 years. At the appointment, they will give you your first tranche that first tranche would be 1.25 quintillion, if you're taking a quarterly basis. If it's an annual basis, you'll be getting five quintillion dollars out of the appointment into your quantum financial system account. Keep in mind that it's going to be in a structured payout system from the structure payout system. So if you don't understand that, then you don't, you're gonna have a hard time understanding why you're gonna get money for 100 years, and 10%, it's not an it's not an interest rate brothers and sisters, it's not an instrument, an interest rate, it determines how much you're going to get out of your primary principal for the every year for the rest of the 100 years or the term that you have set aside. So okay, I'm open for some questions. It looks like I've spent it all just gathering or rambling on, but those things were important. Are there some final questions? But I'm wondering if you do a CAC, should it be big enough to have functionality for the town and people? Should it be all encompassed? Or could it be possibly come part? mentalized?

That's an excellent question. And I would say it has to do with the individual location. You have a community that is a small geographical area, and you have a director over that and is basically responsible for that community, and chooses other people to help him with what he needs to do. That community may be a few blocks long or wide, or whatever. It may be a geographical area that people have come together and decide they'd like to have a little city or, or whatever. And they incorporate and that can be one of your CAC's. And then if it's in a city, there could be one place where you can have four or five CAC types of people that are functioning out of that office. And if it's big enough, then you have some, some facilities that can be helpful for other activities in the community. We want to be involved in the communities we want to be involved in anything that has to do with communities, because we're we're coming into money, whether it's been shortened anyway, because of the way that the government's are run. They're going to be trimmed down in size very small. And we're the ones who will pick up some of those things that that need to take place. And so the more that we're involved in the communities, and the more that they can rely on us, and we respond to their needs. I think that's a great thing as service to that community. That's the way the last thing so

yes, you're probably smoking thinking small. And how many of us have had an idea to start thinking big? Well, I had a train set that I laid out, you know, 30 or 40 hours later, it was nothing that I thought I would be able to do. But you just do a little here and a little bit Oh, they'll do this. We can do this. We could do this. Oh wow. We could do this. We could put some mountains over here and they have gold that tunnel around the air and all that sort of stuff. That's that's the way that you build it. And you just add to it and then to it, and do things that make sense, have a reason, it's got to be reasonable. And and then don't be afraid to do things, if it doesn't work out the way that you want it to. Or if you find a different way that might be better, then you're not going to make mistakes that you can work around. Just understand that and of course, you have a counselor that will help you so that you won't make mistakes that you can't work around. But it doesn't matter how much money you put into something, that's not the important thing, it's a time and the effort that you put into it to make it usable for other people. So

But in that building, I was thinking of having different facets, is kind of like a welcome center, let them know what we do. And then also a small thing for training. And then I thought maybe adding the financial center would be complimentary to to where if they need a car or a home, they can get information about it at that time. Because I think my personal opinion is that we'll be doing the RSS, they'll have money immediately. But if someone wants a home, they will have to plan on saving some money that 5% to put down on a home. So in some cases, it won't be instantaneous, you know, get your income get a home at the same time, you know, case by case. And so I would suggest, generally speaking, this isn't what you have to do. Generally speaking, I would go in because I understand what I'm doing with the zoom. And I'll get the higher rates higher than what they work because they they're not familiar with the amount of money that I'm asking for a rate. And so I've learned how to do that. If they haven't, then they'll go, they'll take that same exam. And it's getting instead of getting \$500,000. For it, they may be happy just to get a couple of trillion dollars for \$1 per zoom.
