HOW TO FIND YOUR FATHER

INTRODUCTION

Here are steps to find the spiritual father God wants for you.

I. STEP ONE – PRAY FOR GOD'S GUIDANCE.

A. Allow <u>God</u> to link you more than trying to link yourself!

- 1. Don't let your <u>desire</u> for a spiritual father interfere with God's leading you to one.
- 2. Head logic and <u>manipulation</u> are enemies to be held in check in this important spiritual development.

B. Allow time to work for you!

- 1. <u>Impatience</u> could cause you to link with the wrong person... at the wrong time... in the wrong place.
 - Being in the ministry and influence of the wrong <u>person</u> will cause you to pursue the wrong <u>opportunities</u>... develop wrong values...
 - Allow God to find the <u>right</u> person to speak into your life.
- 2. You will know when the Lord brings you together.

II. SILENCE THE VOICE OF "QUALIFICATION."

A. God does not call the qualified — He qualifies the called!

- 1. Don't allow the enemy to steal your future based on what you believe you are <u>capable</u> of.
- 2. God will never call you to do what <u>YOU</u> can do!
 - He will call you to do what <u>HE</u> can do through you!
 - Zechariah 4:6

"Not by might, nor by power, but by My Spirit saith the Lord of Hosts."

B. The goal of spiritual sonship is not <u>performance</u>; it is spiritual development and maturity.

- 1. You don't copy a spiritual father's <u>techniques</u>; you incarnate his principles, values, and soul.
- 2. Philippians 2:20-22
 - For I have no one like-minded, who will sincerely care for your state. For all seek their own, not the things which are of Christ Jesus. But you know his proven character, that as a son with his father he served with me in the gospel. (NKJV)

III. WHEN YOU HAVE FOUND HIM, HOW DO YOU MAINTAIN THE FATHER-SON RELATIONSHIP?

A. First — keep <u>pursuing</u>.

- 1. Pursuing is <u>permanent</u> not momentary.
 - Your level of pursuit will determine your level of <u>credibility</u> and...
 - Your level of credibility will determine your level of promotion.
- 2. Your relationship with a spiritual father will require <u>you</u> to go to where he is not wait for him to come to where you are.
 - Fathers don't chase sons!
 - Sons chase fathers to get the mantle they carry.
 - You don't chase "just when it's <u>convenient</u>."

B. Second — keep <u>learning</u>.

- 1. The quality of the father's teaching is determined by the son's questions!
 - Don't be afraid to ask about or question what you don't understand.
 - Don't impress him with your <u>answers</u> but with your <u>questions!</u>

- 2. During my Ph.D. oral exam...
 - I tried to impress them with answers...
 - My advisor said to me, "STOP!" He took me to the restroom and advised me.
 - "Don't you know the three magic words?"
 - "I don't know! Please help me!"
- 3. Jesus during his Bar mitzvah
 - He was asking the rabbis <u>questions!</u>
- 4. The best, smartest sons are more concerned with <u>sustaining</u> success than they are with <u>achieving</u> success!
 - Success is harder to <u>keep</u> than it is to <u>reap!</u>

C. Third — keep serving.

- 1. Remember the Father God joins you to never <u>stop</u> serving your father.
- 2. Ministering to him keeps you positioned in the flow of God's <u>favor!</u>
- 3. Before you can be a great successor, you must become a great <u>server!</u>

D. Finally — keep sowing.

- 1. The more consistently you sow into the <u>soil</u> of your father, the more richly you will reap the <u>mantle</u> of your father.
- 2. When God gives you a spiritual father, He did not give you just a <u>teacher/mentor</u>.
 - He gave you someone with a <u>mantle</u> ministry you could sow seed into and reap your own harvest/<u>increase</u>.
- 3. Your "spiritual father's soil" is the most <u>fertile</u> soil you will ever sow into.
 - The more <u>successful</u> you become, the more you need a spiritual father in order to handle that success.

CONCLUSION: HOW TO FIND YOUR SPIRITUAL FATHER

- 1. Pray for God's guidance.
- 2. Silence the voice of "qualification!"
- 3. Once you have found him, maintain/maximize the relationship.
