God's Mercy

Psalm 37:1-2

Fret not thyself because of evildoers, neither be thou envious against the workers of iniquity.

For they shall soon be cut down like the grass and wither as the green herb.

Psalm 37:1-2 (KJV)

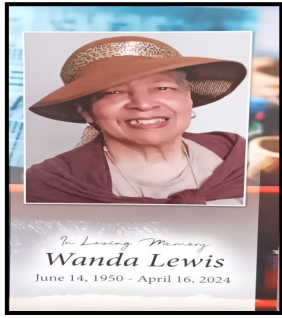
