What is a Certificate of Origin?

The Franklin Township Chamber of Commerce provides certificates of origin to its members. This document verifies that a manufacturer's goods are made in the United States or for goods that were not made in the United States. A certificate of origin is a document required by foreign governments that validates the country of origin of where the product was manufactured. The certificate of origin must be signed by the exporter and then signed by a locally designated agency such as the Franklin Township Chamber of Commerce in order to be acceptable and valid.

Businesses interested in having their certificates or origin signed by the Franklin Township Chamber of Commerce must complete the form and email it to our office with a return label. The business that is requesting the Certificate must release and hold harmless the Franklin Township Chamber of Commerce from any liability with regards to the goods. The form should include documentation regarding the goods (e.g. invoice) Documents must also indicate country of origin.

Certificates of Origin are stamped only during business hours. No appointment is necessary. We strongly suggest that you call the office at (732) 325-0873 if you have an emergent need to have a Certificate stamped.

There is no fee to a member to have a Certificate of Origin stamped. The fee for non members is \$50.00.
