She stayed on with the FTPW Executive Board through 2013 even though her son's FTPW career ended in 2010. Marisa also served as Secretary for the MacAfee PTO from 2005 through 2010.

Marisa Gallagher is currently serving her 10<sup>th</sup> year as President of Franklin Athletics Booster Club (FABC). Back in 2013, she and a few other involved parents were asked to rejuvenate the booster club and become an active support system for the student-athletes, athletic teams, coaches and FHS Athletic Department. At that time, her son was a Sophomore at FHS and her daughter was in 7<sup>th</sup> grade at FMS. During her tenure as President, FABC has helped to increase school spirit by selling Warrior gear both in person and online. FABC has helped multiple teams raise money for their specific needs (i.e. Lady Warriors Basketball Championship rings, Track and Field Champions rings, Cheer Nationals Competition trip to Disney, among others). We have also been able to raise enough money to provide scholarships to some of our graduating seniors, as well as providing each senior student-athlete with a gift and a commemorative program at the end of their season. Marisa has promoted a culture of teamwork by collaborating with other parent groups to foster a partnership with the attitude of "we are all here for the kids". FABC has worked in partnership with FHS Project Graduation for the past 4 years to host The Franklin Food Truck Festival to raise money for both the student athletes and the graduating seniors. FABC has shared knowledge and skill sets with all other parent run organizations throughout the district. Overall, under Marisa's guidance, the Franklin Athletics Booster Club has grown and continues to grow each year. We strive for continuous improvement each and every day and are always looking for new and different fundraising ideas and how we can better support our teams and athletes.

# Franklin Reporter/ Bill Bowman/ PJ Parker



The Franklin Reporter & Advocate, currently celebrating its 10th year, was founded by Bill Bowman and PJ Parker in August 2013 as a News Website for Franklin Township. It has since grown into also providing township residents with Monthly Digest the newspaper, the daily Morning

Report email blast, plus regular community live streams and live virtual News Hour broadcasts.

Bill Bowman, FR&A Co-Publisher and Editor, is a graduate of Livingston College - Rutgers University, and has been a professional journalist since 1983. He's won numerous local, national and company awards, and his reporting has resulted in several laws passed at the state level, and has triggered two Congressional hearings. Bill is also the published author of two books.

PJ Parker, FR&A Co-Publisher and Advertising Director, is a graduate of New York University, tenured in newspapering in Somerset Press Newspapers and Forbes Newspapers as Major Accounts Director, with credits/awards for Campaign Development and Advertising Excellence. PJ is also an accomplished Jazz Vocalist with three albums acknowledged world-wide. Her original compositions have won international songwriting awards and have been featured in film, television, and streaming platforms. Her fourth album is slated for late Spring 2023 release.

## **Shannel Robinson**



Shanel Y. Robinson is currently serving her third year as Somerset County Commissioner Director and her second term as Somerset County Commissioner. She is the first African American woman to serve in either role, representing the roughly 345,361 residents of the County. Previously Shanel served as a Councilwoman and Deputy Mayor in Franklin Township, NJ. Her focus as an elected official is to be a servant leader for every individual, business, and community and to work

cooperatively to make Somerset County the best place to live, work and play anywhere.

In addition to Shanel's work as an elected official, Shanel is the Borough Administrator for the Borough of Roselle, NJ, & previously served as an information technology executive in the health care industry. She holds a bachelor's degree in Labor Studies and Employee Relations from Rutgers University, and received a ministry in Dance Theology from the Eagles International Training Institute in Frisco, Texas. Shanel is also a proud veteran of the United States Air Force Reserves, and a member of the Sigma Pi Sigma physics honor society.

Shanel is also a mother of three wonderful children, and the three most amazing grandchildren in the world.

# **Captain Sean Hebbon**



Captain Sean Hebbon is the Officer-in-Charge for the Franklin Township Police Department in Somerset County, New Jersey. He was promoted to the rank of Captain in October of 2020, having over 25 years in service with the department. Upon his swearing in he became the first African American in Franklin Township history to be promoted to the rank of Captain. In his leadership role, he proudly led he formation of the department's Community Relations Bureau, which focuses on pro-active police and community engagement. Officers within his command go beyond traditional protecting

and serving by taking on a role as mentor and community partner. As examples of this, his officers do activities such as lead Cooking with Cops classes for youth, teach classes in carpentry, hold self-defense classes for women and teach Citizen Police Academies to name a few. His goal is to forge a better relationship with the police department and community that they serve.

Additionally, Hebbon is the president of the Franklin Township Dr. Martin Luther King Community Foundation. As a long serving member of the foundation, he helped in raising over \$250,000 in scholarship money exclusively for Franklin Township students.
