Inclusive Cup



At each fixture, the inclusive cup will be awarded For each category:

- Juniors
- Youth

Each winner will receive a certificate that they can keep and the team with the most wins at the end of each season will have the trophy engraved and they can show off that trophy for the remainder of that season (it is returned annually)

Kit Requirements: What is the best thing to bring

- Playing Kit shirt, shorts/joggers and socks (an under layer would be ideal for the winter months)
- Boots
 - Grass: Football boots
 - 3G: Football boots with moulded studs (NO metal studs)
 - Sand Based Astro Turf: Astro's ONLY
 - Indoor: Trainers or Futsal's ONLY
- Shin pads covered by long football socks
- Goalkeepers must wear gloves
- No jewellery rings/bracelets/necklaces
- No sunglasses
- No jackets around the waist

The following pages covers the League's Code of Conduct, for players, parents and coaches


This needs to be:

Players code of conduct (all ages):

Play your part and support The FA's Code of Respect:

When playing football, I will:

- Always play my best for the benefit of the team, even if we are losing or the other team is stronger
- Play fairly and be friendly I will not cheat, complain or waste time
- Play by the rules and respect the Referee
- Never be rude to my team mates, the other team, the referee, spectators or my coach/team manager
- Shake hands with the other team win or lose
- Listen carefully to what my coach tells me
- Understand that a coach has to do what's best for the team
- Talk to someone I trust or the club welfare officer if I'm unhappy about anything at my club
- Encourage my team mates
- Respect the facilities at each of the venues

I understand that if I do not follow the Code, I may:

- Be asked to apologise to whoever I've upset
- Receive a formal warning
- Be dropped, substituted or suspended from training or Not be selected for the team

I understand that if I do not follow this code, action will be taken.







Parents code of conduct:

This league is supporting The FA's Respect Programme to ensure football can be enjoyed by everyone in a safe and positive environment.

Please play your part and observe The FA's Respect Code of Conduct for spectators and parents/carers at all times

- Have fun; it's what we're all here for!
- Celebrate effort and good play from both sides
- Always respect the Referee and coaches and encourage players to do the same
- Stay behind the touchline and within the Designated Spectators' Area (where provided)
- When players make mistakes, offer them encouragement to try again next time
- Never engage in, or tolerate offensive, insulting or abusive language or behaviour

I understand that if I do not follow the Code, I may be:

- Issued with a verbal warning or asked to leave
- Required to meet with the club committee, league or CFA Welfare Officer
- Obliged to undertake an FA education course
- Requested not to attend future games, be suspended or have my membership removed
- Required to leave the club along with any dependents and/or issued a fine

I understand that breaches of the code may result in action being taken by my county FA and/or The FA







Coaches code of conduct:

Play your part and support The FA's Code of Respect: On and off the field, I will:

- Always show respect to everyone involved in the game
- Stick to the rules and celebrate the spirit of the game
- Encourage fair play and high standards of behaviour
- Always respect the Referee and encourage players to do the same
- Never enter the field of play without the referee's permission
- Never engage in, or tolerate offensive, insulting or abusive behaviour
- Be aware of the potential impact of bad language on others
- Be gracious in victory and defeat
- Respect the facilities home and away

When working with players, I will:

- Place the well-being, safety and enjoyment of each player above everything
- Never tolerate any form of bullying
- Ensure all activities are suited for the players' ability and age
- Work with others (e.g. officials, doctors, welfare officers, physiotherapists) for each player's best interests I understand that if I do not follow the Code, I may be:
- Required to meet with the club or league Welfare officer or your CFA Designated Safeguarding Officer (DSO).
- Suspended by the club from attending matches
- Suspended or fined by the County FA
- Required to leave, lose my position and/or have my license withdrawn

I understand that breaches of the code may result in action being taken by my county FA and/or The FA
