A Prayer For The Week

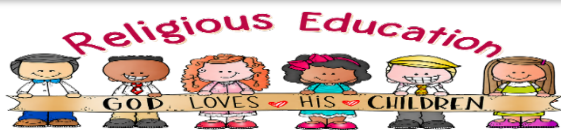


Heavenly Father,

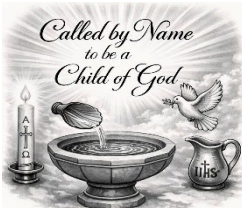
