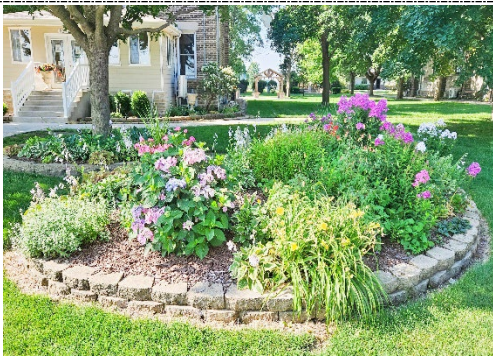


A Prayer For The Week...
