In 1864, Maternity BVM Church in Bourbonnais Grove, IL needed new, stable leadership. The local Church leaders worked with a Canadian bishop to bring in a religious congregation with a reputation for raising

We took leadership of MBVM Church in 1865, our first permanent ministry in the US, and later founded St. Viator College next door. The Viatorians would spread, taking root in Chicago and its suburbs, too. We continue to lead this first parish today, for over 150 years and counting, now under pastor Fr. Jason Nesbit, CSV, and assisted by Fr. Moses Mesh, CSV.
