Picnic will kick off at the **OUTDOOR**

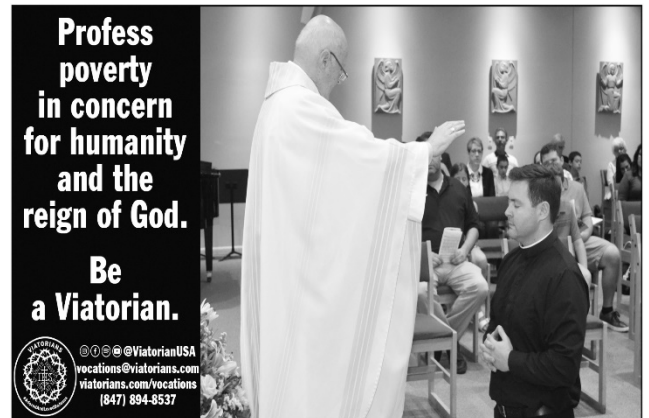
