CALL TO ORDER

Mayor DeForest called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

1. INVOCATION AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Kyle Roehrig gave the invocation and Mayor DeForest led the pledges to the US and Texas flags.

2. CONSENT AGENDA

MOTION: Alderperson Johnson made the motion to approve the consent agenda as presented. Alderperson Brigham seconded the motion.

VOTE: Motion carried unanimously 5-0.

3. DEPARTMENT HEAD REPORTS

a. POLICE

Mayor DeForest read the Police Report for December 2023 with 87 calls for service, 88 traffic stops, 4 reports written, and 5 arrests. News from the Chief was that all golf carts and UTV drivers must hold a valid driver's license and be registered with City Hall. There will be zero tolerance for glass containers by the docks as there are signs placed warning of the violation. The first annual Blue Stanta Project was completed successfully. Chief Carisalez wrote that she wanted to thank everyone who helped with the event in any way.

b. MUNICIPAL COURT

Mayor DeForest read the Municipal Court report for December 2023 with 46 new cases, 23 closed cases, 112 current cases, and \$2,016 total fines collected for the month.

c. PUBLIC SAFETY

Alderperson Brigham did not have a report for Public Safety for December 2023.

d. PERMITS

Mayor DeForest read the Permit Report for December 2023 with a total gross property valuation increase of \$154,900. Mayor DeForest also read the Permit Report for the 2023 calendar year with 27 building construction permit issued for a total tax valuation of \$1,973,753, 9 placement permits for manufactured housing issued for a total tax valuation of \$887,254, 16 repair/remodel permits issued for a total tax valuation of \$253,798, 24 placement permits issued for a total tax valuation of \$334,860, 16 RV placement permits issued with a total tax valuation of \$0,0 RV and manufactured home parks permits issued, 1 sign permit issued with a total tax valuation of \$2,000, 0 relocation permits issued, 4 fence permits issued with a total tax valuation of \$14,700, 1 fowl/livestock permit with a total tax valuation of \$0, 12 demolition permit issued with a total decrease of tax valuation of \$259,230. The City of Seadrift had a total increase of property valuation of \$3,207,135 for the 2023 calendar year.

e. CODE ENFORCEMENT

Mayor DeForest read the Code Enforcement Report for December 2023 with 1 letter sent out for the month.

f. HARBOR

Alderperson Hunt did not have a report for the Municipal Harbor for December 2023. Mayor DeForest commented that the EDA Project work was coming along.

g. PARKS AND RECREATION

Alderperson Johnson did not have a report for Parks and Recreation for December 2023. Alderperson Johnson thanked residents who had put up lights up on the highway. Alderperson Johnson also commented that the Chamber of Commerce had banners put up on Main Street.

Alderperson Reese read the Utility Report for December 2023 with 1 water tap and 1 sewer tap installed inside the City, and no water taps in Swan Point Landing installed for the month.
