CITY OF SEADRIFT NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING POTENTIALLY DEFUNDING MUNICIPAL POLICE AND/OR ABOLISHING THE MUNICIPAL POLICE DEPARTMENT

The City of Seadrift will hold a public hearing on Tuesday April 4, 2023 beginning at 6:00PM in City Hall at 501 S. Main Street. The purpose of the Public Hearing is to seek public input and gauge the consensus on whether or not to defund the municipal police and/or abolish the municipal police department regarding numerous complainants suggesting that the city should defund and/or abolish the municipal police department and turn over the enforcement of law within the city to county and state law enforcement agencies.

Speakers will be required to sign up to speak and will be allowed to speak A MAXIMUM OF 3 MINUTES – whether FOR or AGAINST the suggested defunding and/or abolishment of municipal police. Elected Public Officials whether City, County, State or Federal will be given priority to speak within the 3-minute allowance.

Individuals living within the City Limits and those that operate businesses within the City Limits and those that may have second homes within the City Limits but do not live in the City will also be given priority to speak in lieu of those living and operating businesses outside the City Limits. ONLY IF time permits those living outside the City Limits or operating businesses outside the city limits MAY be given an opportunity to speak FOR or AGAINST the defunding and/or abolishment.

The FOR and AGAINST comments will be considered by City Council at a future date for any further action – There will be no action taken in the Regular Council Meeting that will follow this Public Hearing. The Public Hearing will be conducted in English.

The City of Seadrift will provide reasonable accommodation for persons attending the public hearing. Requests from persons needing special accommodation such as for language interpreters, or requests for other special communication needs should be made at least 48 hours before the public hearing, not including Saturday/Sunday. 6. STUCTURAL SAFETY ISSUES

John McNeely was in attendance to discuss his neighbor's fence on Bay Avenue. He provided City Council pictures of the fencing made of plywood. Mr. McNeely stated that after high winds, the fence fell over onto his property due to improper anchoring. Currently, the City's building codes do not require permitting for fencing that is under 6-feet tall. Mr. McNeely asked if Council could adopt something to prevent this from happening in the future.

MOTION: Alderperson Hunt made the motion to require permits for privacy fencing and that fencing up to 6-feet tall must have a post depth of 2-feet; fencing over 6-feet tall must have a post depth of 3-feet; and privacy fencing must be of common residential fencing materials. Alderperson Brigham seconded the motion.




