RV'S: The following restrictions apply to RV's that are placed on individual lots in accordance with Manufactured Housing Ordinance, August 8, 2001 and clarified by ordinance RV-01 August 24, 2010 and by the Flood Control Ordinance August 1, 2006:

- Shall NOT be permanently attached to City Utilities FLEXIBLE HOSES ONLY!
- ⇒ IF placed in approved Manufactured Housing Parks, shall be subject to same installation requirements as Manufactured Housing for extended occupancy.
- ⇒ Shall not be occupied more than 30 days at a residence or other location for temporary lodging of guest or family, unless in an approved RV Park.
- Shall have current license registration and inspection certificates and kept road ready at all times.
- Shall be removed from the City Limits within 24 hours of an evacuation order issued due to approaching severe weather and high winds.
- ⇒ <u>Unoccupied</u> RV's may be parked at locations such as driveways, storage areas, and etc.
  - Shall not be parked or stored in any street or public right-of-way.
- ⇒ Winter Texans are allowed to occupy for a period of time, not to exceed 90 days.
  - If over 90 days, an extension may be granted on request at City Hall.
- Occupancy while an adjacent structure is under construction or repair is allowed, not to exceed 180 days.
  - Extensions over 180 days may be granted on request or on the extension of any building/repair permits.

## CITY OF SEADRIFT SERVICE AGREEMENT

- I. PURPOSE. The City of Seadrift is responsible for protecting the drinking water supply from contamination or pollution which could result from improper private water distribution system construction or configuration. The purpose of this service agreement is to notify each customer of the restrictions which are in place to provide this protection. The utility enforces these restrictions to ensure the public health and welfare. Each customer must sign this agreement before the City of Seadrift will begin service. In addition, when service of an existing connection has been suspended or terminated, the water system will not reestablish service unless it has signed copy of this agreement.
- II. RESTRICTIONS. The following unacceptable practices are prohibited by State regulations.
  - a. Not direct connection between the public drinking water supply and a potential source of contamination is permitted. Potential sources of contamination shall be isolated from the public water system by an air-gap or an appropriate backflow prevention device.
  - b. No cross-connection between the public drinking water supply and a private water system is permitted. These potential threats to the public drinking water supply shall be eliminated at the service connection by the installation of an air-gap or reduced pressure-zone backflow prevention device.
  - c. No connection which allows water to be returned to the public drinking water supply is permitted.
  - d. No pipe or pipe fitting which contains more than 8.0% lead may be used for the installation or repair of plumbing at any connection which provides water for human use.
  - e. No solder or flux which contains more than 0.2 % lead can be used for the installation or repair of plumbing at any connection which provides water for human use.

- III. SERVICE AGREEMENT. The following are the terms of the service agreement between the City of Seadrift and (name)
  - a. The Water System will maintain a copy of this agreement as long as the Customer and/or the premised is connected to the Water System.
  - b. The Customer shall allow his property to be inspected for possible cross connections and other potential contamination hazards. These inspections shall be conducted by the Water System or its designed agent prior to initiating new water service; when there is reason to believe that cross connections or other potential contamination hazards exist; or after any major changes to the private water distribution facilities. The inspections shall be conducted during the Water System's normal business hours.
  - c. The Water System shall notify the Customer in writing of any cross connection or other potential contamination hazard which has been identified during the initial inspection or the periodic reinspection.
  - d. The Customer shall immediately remove or adequately isolate any potential cross-connections or other potential contamination hazards on his premises.
  - e. The Customer shall, at his expense, properly install, test, and maintain any backflow prevention device required by the Water System. Copies of all testing and maintenance records shall be provided to the Water System.
- IV. ENFORCEMENT. If the Customer fails to comply with the Terms of Service Agreement, the Water System shall, at its option, either terminate service or the service connection. Any expenses associated with the enforcement of this agreement shall be billed to the Customer.
